

## **GREEK WORD STUDIES**

- 1. Go to Blue Letter Bible (<u>https://www.blueletterbible.org</u>).
- 2. Search for "Jhn 2:23" in the "ESV" version.
- 3. Next to Jhn 2:23, click "Tools."
- 4. Under the "Interlinear" tab, find "signs." The transliteration is "semeion." Click the speaker next to "semeion" to hear how the word is pronounced in Greek.
- 5. Click the Strong's number "G4592."
- 6. Scroll down and click on what interests you. We like:
  - a. "Vine's Expository Dictionary"
  - b. "Outline of Biblical Usage"
  - c. "Strong's Definitions"
  - d. "Thayer's Greek Lexicon"
  - e. "Concordance Results Using ESV."
- 7. You may want to create a list of your favourite verses on the topic of "sign."
- 8. To find another word, go to the very top of the page and type another biblical reference in the search box.
- 9. Follow the same approach for other words you would like to study.
