The Salvation of Israel through the Servant Yeshua.

Marriage is a union between a man and a woman, ordained by God. But God uses marriage symbolically to illustrate various truths:

- The bride and the bride groom (church and Jesus)
- The nation of Israel being married back to the land of Israel
- Israel the wife of God

Israel the wife of God

1. The marriage contract: The whole book of Deuteronomy is a marriage contract between God and Israel. 5:1-3, 6:10-15, 7:6-11, Eze 16:8
2. The great adultery: Jer 3:1-5 and 20, 31:32, Eze 16:15-34,
3. The separation: Isa 50:1,
4. The divorce: Jer 3:6-10
5. The punishment: Eze 16:35-43, 58-59, Hosea 2:6-13,
6. Marriage with restored blessing: Jer 31:31-34, Eze 16:60-63, Isa 62:4-5, Hosea 2:14-23

Clearly portrayed in the marriage relationship between Hosea and his wife, Gomer.

Isa 45:17. But Israel is saved by the LORD with everlasting salvation; you shall not be put to shame or confounded to all eternity.

Zech 12:10. “And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a spirit of grace and pleas for mercy, so that, when they look on me, on him whom they have pierced, they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for an only child, and weep bitterly over him, as one weeps over a firstborn.

Rev 1:7. Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen.

Jer 3:14. Return, O faithless children, declares the LORD; for I am married to you; I will take you, one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion.

Isa 43:15. I am the LORD, your Holy One, the Creator of Israel, your King.”

Issa 50:1. Thus says the LORD: “Where is your mother’s certificate of divorce, with which I sent her away? Or which of my creditors is it to whom I have sold you? Behold, for your iniquities you were sold, and for your transgressions your mother was sent away.

Isa 26:20. Come, my people, enter your chambers, and shut your doors behind you; hide yourselves for a little while until the fury has passed by.

Isa 49:10-13. They shall not hunger or thirst, neither scorching wind nor sun shall strike them, for he who has pity on them will lead them, and by springs of water will guide them. And I will make all my mountains a road, and my highways shall be raised up. Behold, these shall come from afar, and behold, these from the north and from the west, and these from the land of Syene.” Sing for joy, O heavens, and exult, O earth; break forth, O mountains, into singing! For the LORD has comforted his people and will have compassion on his afflicted.

Eze 39:25-29. “Therefore, thus says the Lord GOD: Now I will restore the fortunes of Jacob and have mercy on the whole house of Israel, and I will be jealous for my holy name. They shall forget their shame and all the treachery they have practiced against me, when they dwell securely in their land with none to make them afraid, when I have brought them back from the peoples and gathered them from their enemies’ lands, and through them have vindicated my holiness in the sight of many nations. Then they shall know that I am the LORD their God, because I sent them into exile among the nations and then assembled them into their own land. I will leave none of them remaining among the nations anymore. And I will not hide my face anymore from them, when I pour out my Spirit upon the house of Israel, declares the Lord GOD.”
