Jn 1:45 45 Philip found Nathanael and said to him, We have found him about whom Moses in the law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus son of Joseph from Nazareth. Jn 6:14 14 When the people saw the sign that [Jesus] had done, they began to say, This is indeed the prophet who is to come into the world.
