

## ***ONE ANOTHERS***

### ***Introduction***

1. “One another” is two words in English, but it’s one word in Greek, ἀλλήλων. It’s used exactly 100 times in the New Testament.
2. The One Others listed below apply to relationships within the Church, and especially to relationships within our families and local churches.
3. The greatest test is whether we apply the One Others in our closest relationships.
4. We cannot live out the One Others in our own strength. We can only do so by living in fellowship with the Father, abiding in Jesus, and walking by the Spirit.
5. Living by the One Others produces unity, growth, maturity, and fullness in the local church.

### ***Thirty-Six One Others***

#### **1. Love one another.**

##### a. Jesus.

- (1) **Jn 13:34** 34 A new commandment I [Jesus] give to you [apostles], that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.
- (2) **Jn 15:12** 12 This is my commandment, that you [disciples] love one another as I [Jesus] have loved you.
- (3) **Jn 15:17** 17 These things I command you, so that you will love one another.

##### b. Paul.

- (1) **Ro 12:10** 10 Love one another with brotherly affection.
- (2) **Ro 13:8** 8 Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the Torah.
- (3) **1 Th 3:12** 12 ...May the Lord [Jesus] make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you.
- (4) **1 Th 4:9** 9 ...Concerning brotherly love you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love one another.

##### c. Peter.

- (1) **1 Pe 1:22** 22 Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart.
- (2) **1 Pe 3:8** 8 ...Have unity of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind.
- (3) **1 Pe 4:8** 8 Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, because love covers a multitude of sins.

##### d. John.

- (1) **1 Jn 3:11** 11 ...This is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

- (2) **1 Jn 3:23** 23 ... This is [God's] commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Messiah and love one another, just as he has commanded us.
- (3) **1 Jn 4:7** 7 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.
- (4) **1 Jn 4:11-12** 11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. 12 No one has ever seen God. If we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.
- (5) **2 Jn 5** 5 ... Now I ask you, dear lady—not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning—that we love one another.

**2. Be at peace with one another.**

- a. **Mk 9:50** 50 Have salt in yourselves and be at peace with one another.
- b. **Ro 12:16** 16 Live in harmony with one another.
- c. **Ro 15:5** 5 May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Messiah Jesus....

**3. Wash one another's feet.**

- a. **Jn 13:14** 14 If I [Jesus] then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you [disciples] also ought to wash one another's feet.

**4. Encourage and build up one another.**

- a. **Ro 1:11-12** 11 ... I [Paul] long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you— 12 that is, that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine.
- b. **1 Th 4:18** 18 ... Encourage one another with these words.
- c. **1 Th 5:11** 11 ... Encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.
- d. **Heb 10:25** 25 ... Encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

**5. Outdo one another in showing honour.**

- a. **Ro 12:10** 10 Outdo one another in showing honour.

**6. Don't pass judgment on one another.**

- a. **Ro 14:13** 13 ... Let us not pass judgment on one another any longer....

**7. Don't put a stumbling block in one another's way.**

- a. **Ro 14:13** 13 Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.

**8. Welcome one another.**

- a. **Ro 15:7** 7 ... Welcome one another as Messiah has welcomed you, for the glory of God.

**9. Greet one another with a kiss.**

- a. **Ro 16:16** 16 Greet one another with a holy kiss.
- b. **1 Co 16:20** 20 Greet one another with a holy kiss.
- c. **2 Co 13:12** 12 Greet one another with a holy kiss.
- d. **1 Pe 5:14** 14 Greet one another with the kiss of love.

**10. Within marriage, don't deprive one another of sex.**

- a. **1 Co 7:5** 5 Do not deprive one another, except perhaps by agreement for a limited time, that you may devote yourselves to prayer. But then come together again, so that Satan may not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

**11. Wait for one another when you eat together.**

- a. **1 Co 11:33** 33 So then, my brothers and sisters, when you come together to eat, wait for one another....

**12. Care for one another.**

- a. **1 Co 12:24-25** 24 ...God has so composed the body, giving greater honour to the part that lacked it, 25 that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.

**13. Serve one another.**

- a. **Ga 5:13** 13 ...You were called to freedom, brothers and sisters. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

**14. Don't bite, devour, or consume one another.**

- a. **Ga 5:15** 15 ...If you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another.

**15. Don't provoke one another.**

- a. **Ga 5:26** 26 Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

**16. Don't envy one another.**

- a. **Ga 5:26** 26 Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

**17. Bear one another's burdens.**

- a. **Ga 6:2** 2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfil the Torah of Messiah.

**18. Bear with one another.**

- a. **Eph 4:2** 2 ...With all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love....
- b. **Col 3:13** 13 ...Bearing with one another....

**19. Speak truth with one another.**

- a. **Eph 4:25** 25 ...Having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbour, for we are members one of another.

**20. Be kind to one another.**

- a. **Eph 4:32** 32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

**21. Forgive one another.**

- a. **Eph 4:32** 32 ...Forgiving one another, as God in Messiah forgave you.
- b. **Col 3:13** 13 ...If one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other. As the Lord [Jesus] has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

**22. Address one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs.**

- a. **Eph 5:19** 19 ...Addressing one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord [Jesus] with your heart....

**23. Submit to one another.**

- a. **Eph 5:21** 21 ...Submitting to one another out of reverence for Messiah.

**24. Count one another more significant.**

- a. **Php 2:3** 3 Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count one another more significant than yourselves.

**25. Do not lie to one another.**

- a. **Col 3:9** 9 Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices.

**26. Teach and admonish one another in all wisdom.**

- a. **Col 3:16** 16 Let the word of Messiah dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom....

**27. Do good to one another.**

- a. **1 Th 5:15** 15 ...Always seek to do good to one another and to everyone.

**28. Exhort one another daily.**

- a. **Heb 3:13** 13 ...Exhort one another every day, as long as it is called today, that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

**29. Stir up one another to love and good works.**

- a. **Heb 10:24** 24 ...Let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works....

**30. Do not speak evil against one another.**

- a. **Jas 4:11** 11 Do not speak evil against one another, brothers and sisters.

**31. Do not grumble against one another.**

- a. **Jas 5:9** 9 Do not grumble against one another, brothers and sisters, so that you may not be judged. Behold, the Judge is standing at the door.

**32. Confess your sins to one another.**

- a. **Jas 5:16** 16 ...Confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

**33. Pray for one another.**

- a. **Jas 5:16** 16 ...Pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

**34. Show hospitality to one another.**

- a. **1 Pe 4:9** 9 Show hospitality to one another without grumbling.

**35. Use your spiritual gift to serve one another.**

- a. **1 Pe 4:10** 10 As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace.

**36. Clothe yourselves with humility toward one another.**

- a. **1 Pe 5:5** 5 Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.
