

## VERSES ON ALL

Genesis 1:1 1 In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth [all things].

**Zechariah 14:9** 9 And Yahweh will be king over <u>*all*</u> the earth. On that day the Lord will be one and his name one.

**Romans 1:5** 5 ... Through whom [Jesus] we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his name among <u>all</u> the nations....

**Romans 3:22-23** 22 ... The righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Messiah for <u>all</u> who believe. For there is no distinction. 23 For <u>all</u> have sinned and fall short of the glory of God....

**Romans 5:18** 18 Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for <u>all</u> men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for <u>all</u> men.

**Romans 6:10** 10 For the death [Jesus] died he died to sin, once for <u>all</u>, but the life he lives he lives to God.

**Romans 8:28** 28 And we know that for those who love God <u>*all things*</u> work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

**Romans 8:32** 32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us <u>*all*</u>, how will he not also with him graciously give us <u>*all things*</u>?

**Romans 9:5** 5 To them belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Messiah, who is God over <u>*all*</u>, blessed forever. Amen.

**Romans 10:12** 12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord is Lord of <u>*all*</u>, bestowing his riches on <u>*all*</u> who call on him.

**Romans 11:36** 36 For from him, through him, and to him are <u>*all things*</u>. To him be glory forever. Amen.

**1** Corinthians 8:6 6 ... Yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are <u>all things</u> and for whom we exist, and one Lord Jesus Messiah, through whom are <u>all things</u> and through whom we exist.

**Ephesians 1:9** 9 ... Making known to us the mystery of his desire, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Messiah 10 as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite <u>all things</u> in him, things in heaven and things on earth. 11 In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works <u>all things</u> according to the counsel of his desire....



**Ephesians 1:21-23** 21 far above <u>all</u> rule, authority, power, and dominion, and above <u>every</u> name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. 22 And he put <u>all things</u> under his feet and gave him as head over <u>all things</u> to the church, 23 which is his body, the fullness of him who fills <u>all</u> in <u>all</u>.

**Ephesians 3:9** 9 ... And to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God, who created *<u>all things</u>....* 

**Ephesians 3:19-21** 19 ...And to know the love of Messiah that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with <u>all</u> the fullness of God. 20 Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than <u>all</u> that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, 21 to him be glory in the church and in Messiah Jesus throughout <u>all</u> generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Ephesians 4:6 6 ... One God and Father of <u>all</u>, who is over <u>all</u>, through <u>all</u>, and in <u>all</u>.

**Ephesians 4:10** 10 He who descended [Jesus] is the one who also ascended far above <u>*all*</u> the heavens, that he might fill <u>*all*</u> things.

**Ephesians 4:15** 15 Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in <u>all</u> things ( $\tau \dot{\alpha} \pi \dot{\alpha} v \tau \alpha$ , pl.) into him who is the head, into Messiah....

**Ephesians 6:16-18** 16 In <u>all</u> circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish <u>all</u> the flaming darts of the evil one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, 18 praying at <u>all</u> times in the Spirit, with <u>all</u> prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with <u>all</u> perseverance, making supplication for <u>all</u> the saints....

**Colossians 1:19** 19 For in [Jesus] <u>all</u> the fulness ( $\pi \tilde{\alpha} \nu \tau \delta \pi \lambda \eta \rho \omega \mu \alpha$ ) was pleased to dwell....

**Colossians 3:11** 11 Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free, but Messiah is <u>all</u> and in <u>all</u> ( $[\tau \dot{\alpha}] \pi \dot{\alpha} v \tau \alpha \kappa \dot{\alpha} \dot{\varepsilon} v \pi \tilde{\alpha} \sigma v$ ).
