

VERSES ON ANGELS

Genesis 3:24 24 ...And at the east of the garden of Eden [God] placed the *cherubim* and a flaming sword that turned every way to guard the way to the tree of life.

Exodus 25:18-22 18 And you shall make two *cherubim* of gold. Of hammered work shall you make them, on the two ends of the mercy seat. 19 Make one *cherub* on the one end, and one *cherub* on the other end. Of one piece with the mercy seat shall you make the *cherubim* on its two ends. 20 The *cherubim* shall spread out their wings above, overshadowing the mercy seat with their wings, their faces one to another. Toward the mercy seat shall the faces of the *cherubim* be. 21 And you shall put the mercy seat on the top of the ark, and in the ark you shall put the testimony that I shall give you. 22 There I will meet with you, and from above the mercy seat, from between the two *cherubim* that are on the ark of the testimony, I will speak with you about all that I will give you in commandment for the people of Israel.

Deuteronomy 32:8 8 When the Most High gave to the nations their inheritance, when he divided mankind, he fixed the borders of the peoples according to the number of the *sons of God*.

Deuteronomy 33:2 2 [Moses] said, Yahweh came from Sinai and dawned from Seir upon us. He shone forth from Mount Paran. He came from the ten thousands of *holy ones*, with flaming fire at his right hand.

Job 1:6 6 ...There was a day when the sons of God [angels] came to present themselves before Yahweh, and Satan also came among them.

Job 38:4-7 4 Where were you when I laid the foundation of the earth? Tell me, if you have understanding. 5 Who determined its measurements—surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it? 6 On what were its bases sunk, or who laid its cornerstone, 7 when the *morning stars* sang together and all the *sons of God* shouted for joy?

Psalms 68:17 17 The chariots of God are twice ten thousand, thousands upon thousands. Yahweh is among them.

Psalms 89:5-7 5 Let the heavens praise your wonders, Yahweh, your faithfulness in the assembly of the holy ones! 6 For who in the skies can be compared to Yahweh? Who among the heavenly beings is like Yahweh, 7 a God greatly to be feared in the council of the holy ones, and awesome above all who are around him?

Psalms 91:11-12 11 ...[Yahweh] will command his *angels* concerning you to guard you in all your ways. 12 On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.

Psalms 103:20-21 20 Bless Yahweh, you his *angels*, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word! 21 Bless Yahweh, all his *hosts*, his *ministers*, who do his will!

Psalms 148:1-5 1 Hallelujah! Praise Yahweh from the heavens. Praise him in the heights! 2 Praise him, all his *angels*. Praise him, all his *hosts*! 3 Praise him, sun and moon, praise him, all you shining stars! 4 Praise him, you highest heavens, and you waters above the heavens! 5 Let them praise the name of Yahweh! For he commanded, and they were created.

Isaiah 6:1-7 1 In the year that King Uzziah died I saw Yahweh sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up. And the train of his robe filled the temple. 2 Above him stood the *seraphim*. Each had six wings—with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. 3 And one called to another and said, Holy, holy, holy is Yahweh of hosts. The whole earth is full of his glory! ...6 Then one of the *seraphim* flew to me [Isaiah], having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. 7 And he touched my mouth and said, Behold, this has touched your lips. Your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for.

Ezekiel 1:4-14 4 As I [Ezekiel] looked, behold, a stormy wind came out of the north, and a great cloud, with brightness around it, and fire flashing forth continually, and in the midst of the fire, as it were gleaming metal. 5 And from the midst of it came the likeness of *four living creatures*. And this was their appearance: they had a human likeness, 6 but each had four faces, and each of them had four wings. 7 Their legs were straight, and the soles of their feet were like the sole of a calf's foot. And they sparkled like burnished bronze. 8 Under their wings on their four sides they had human hands. And the four had their faces and their wings thus: 9 their wings touched one another. Each one of them went straight forward, without turning as they went. 10 As for the likeness of their faces, each had a human face. The four had the face of a lion on the right side, the four had the face of an ox on the left side, and the four had the face of an eagle. 11 Such were their faces. And their wings were spread out above. Each *creature* had two wings, each of which touched the wing of another, while two covered their bodies. 12 And each went straight forward. Wherever the spirit would go, they went, without turning as they went. 13 As for the likeness of the *living creatures*, their appearance was like burning coals of fire, like the appearance of torches moving to and fro among the *living creatures*. And the fire was bright, and out of the fire went forth lightning. 14 And the *living creatures* darted to and fro, like the appearance of a flash of lightning.

Ezekiel 10:1-3 1 Then I [Ezekiel] looked, and behold, on the expanse that was over the heads of the *cherubim* there appeared above them something like a sapphire, in appearance like a throne. 2 And he said to the man clothed in linen, Go in among the whirling wheels underneath the cherubim. Fill your hands with burning coals from between the cherubim, and scatter them over the city. And he went in before my eyes. 3 Now the *cherubim* were standing on the south side of the house, when the man went in, and a cloud filled the inner court.

Daniel 4:13-14 13 I [Nebuchadnezzar] saw in the visions of my head as I lay in bed, and behold, *a watcher, a holy one*, came down from heaven. 14 He proclaimed aloud and said thus: Chop down the tree and lop off its branches, strip off its leaves and scatter its fruit. Let the beasts flee from under it and the birds from its branches.

Daniel 7:9-10 10 A stream of fire issued and came out from before [the Ancient of Days]. A *thousand thousands* served him, and *ten thousand times ten thousand* stood before him. The court sat in judgment, and the books were opened.

Daniel 9:20-24 20 While I [Daniel] was speaking and praying, confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my plea before Yahweh my God for the holy hill of my God, 21 while I was speaking in prayer, the man *Gabriel*, whom I had seen in the vision at the first, came to me in swift flight at the time of the evening sacrifice. 22 He made me understand, speaking with me and saying, O Daniel, I have now come out to give you insight and understanding. 23 At the beginning of your pleas for mercy a word went out, and I have come to tell it to you, for you are greatly loved. Therefore consider the word and understand the vision. 24 Seventy weeks are decreed about your people and your holy city....

Daniel 10:12-21 12 Then [Gabriel] said to me, Fear not, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand and humbled yourself before your God, your words have been heard, and I have come because of your words. 13 The prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days, but *Michael*, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I was left there with the kings of Persia, 14 and came to make you understand what is to happen to your people in the latter days. For the vision is for days yet to come. ...20 Then he said, Do you know why I [Gabriel] have come to you? But now I will return to fight against the prince of Persia. And when I go out, behold, the prince of Greece will come. 21 But I will tell you what is inscribed in the book of truth. There is none who contends by my side against these except Michael, your prince.

Daniel 12:1 1 At that time shall arise Michael, the great prince who has charge of your people [Israel]. And there shall be a time of trouble, such as never has been since there was a nation till that time.

Matthew 1:20 20 But [Joseph] considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream saying, Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 2:13 13 Now when they had departed, behold, an *angel* of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you, for Herod is about to search for the child, to destroy him.

Matthew 2:19-20 19 But when Herod died, behold, an *angel* of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, 20 saying, Rise, take the child and his mother and go to the land of Israel, for those who sought the child's life are dead.

Matthew 4:11 11 Then the devil left [Jesus], and behold, *angels* came and were ministering to him.

Matthew 13:39 39 The harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are *angels*.

Matthew 13:49-50 49 So it will be at the end of the age. The *angels* will come out and separate the evil from the righteous 50 and throw them into the fiery furnace. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 16:27 27 For the Son of Man is going to come with his *angels* in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done.

Matthew 18:10 10 See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that in heaven their *angels* always see the face of my Father who is in heaven.

Matthew 22:30 30 For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like *angels* in heaven.

Matthew 24:31 31 And [the Son of God] will send out his *angels* with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Matthew 24:36 36 But concerning that day and hour no one knows, not even the *angels* of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father only.

Matthew 25:31 31 When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the *angels* with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne.

Matthew 26:53 53 Do you think that I [Jesus] cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of *angels*?

Matthew 28:2-7 2 And behold, there was a great earthquake, for an *angel* of the Lord descended from heaven came, rolled back the stone, and sat on it. 3 His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as snow. 4 And for fear of him the guards trembled and became like dead men. 5 But the *angel* said to the women, Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. 6 He is not here, for he has risen, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay. 7 Then go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and behold, he is going before you to Galilee. There you will see him. See, I have told you.

Mark 1:13 13 And [Jesus] was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. And he was with the wild animals, and the angels were ministering to him.

Mark 12:25 25 For when [believers] rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like *angels* in heaven.

Mark 13:32 32 But concerning that day or that hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

Mark 13:27 27 And then [the Son of Man] will send out the *angels* and gather his elect from the four winds, from the ends of the earth to the ends of heaven.

Mark 16:5-7 5 And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed. 6 And he said to them, Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen. He is not here. See the place where they laid him. 7 But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going before you to Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.

Luke 1:11-19 11 And there appeared to [Zechariah] an *angel* of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense. 12 And Zechariah was troubled when he saw him, and fear fell upon him. 13 But the *angel* said to him, Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer has been heard, and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. ... 16 And he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God, 17 and he will go before him in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready for the Lord a people prepared. 18 And Zechariah said to the *angel*, How shall I know this? For I am an old man, and my wife is advanced in years. 19 And the *angel* answered him, I am *Gabriel*. I stand in the presence of God, and I was sent to speak to you and to bring you this good news.

Luke 1:26-38 26 In the sixth month the *angel Gabriel* was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, 27 to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin's name was Mary. 28 And he came to her and said, Greetings, O favoured one, the Lord is with you! 29 But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of greeting this might be. 30 And the *angel* said to her, Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. 31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. 32 He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David, 33 he will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end. 34 And Mary said to the *angel*, How will this be, since I am a virgin? 35 And the *angel* answered her, The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God. 36 And behold, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren. 37 For nothing will be impossible with God. 38 And Mary said, Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word. And the *angel* departed from her.

Luke 2:8-15 8 And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. 9 And an *angel* of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with great fear. 10 And the *angel* said to them, Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. 11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, who is Messiah the Lord. 12 And this will be a sign for you You will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger. 13 And suddenly there was with the *angel* a multitude of the *heavenly host* praising God and saying, 14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased! 15 When the *angels* went away from them into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, Let us go over to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has made known to us.

Luke 9:26 26 For whoever is ashamed of me and of my words, of him will the Son of Man be ashamed when he comes in his glory and the glory of the Father and of the holy angels.

Luke 12:8-9 8 And I tell you, everyone who acknowledges me before men, the Son of Man also will acknowledge before the angels of God, 9 but the one who denies me before men will be denied before the angels of God.

Luke 16:22 22 The poor man died and was carried by the angels to Abraham's side.

Luke 20:36 36 ...For [believers in the Messianic age] cannot die anymore, because they are equal to angels and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection.

Luke 22:41-43 41 And [Jesus] withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed 42 saying, Father, if you are willing, remove this cup from me. Nevertheless, not my will, but yours, be done. 43 And there appeared to him an angel from heaven, strengthening him.

Luke 24:4-7 4 While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel. 5 And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, Why do you seek the living among the dead? 6 He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, 7 that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise?

John 20:12-13 12 And [Mary] saw two angels in white, sitting where the body of Jesus had lain, one at the head and one at the feet. 13 They said to her, Woman, why are you weeping? She said to them, They have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid him.

Acts 1:10-11 10 And while [the apostles] were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes 11 and said, Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven.

Acts 5:19-20 19 But during the night an angel of the Lord opened the prison doors, brought [the apostles] out, and said, 20 Go and stand in the temple and speak to the people all the words of this Life.

Acts 7:52-53 52 Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who announced beforehand the coming of the Righteous One, whom you have now betrayed and murdered, 53 you who received the law as delivered by angels and did not keep it.

Acts 8:26 26 Now an angel of the Lord said to Philip, Rise and go toward the south to the road that goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza.

Acts 10:3 3 About the ninth hour of the day [Cornelius] saw clearly in a vision an angel of God come in and say to him, Cornelius.

Acts 12:7-11 7 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood next to [Peter], and a light shone in the cell. He struck Peter on the side and woke him saying, Get up quickly. And the chains fell off his hands. 8 And the angel said to him, Dress yourself and put on your sandals. And he did so. And he said to him, Wrap your cloak around you and follow me. 9 And he went out and followed him. He did not know that what was being done by the angel was real, but thought he was seeing a vision. 10 When they had passed the first and the second guard, they came to the iron gate leading into the city. It opened for them of its own accord, and they went out and went along one street, and immediately the angel left him. 11 When Peter came to himself, he said, Now I am sure that the Lord has sent his angel and rescued me from the hand of Herod and from all that the Jewish people were expecting.

Acts 12:14-15 14 Recognizing Peter's voice, in her joy [Rhoda] did not open the gate but ran in and reported that Peter was standing at the gate. 15 They said to her, You are out of your mind. But she kept insisting that it was so, and they kept saying, It is his angel (ἄγγελος)!

Acts 12:23 23 Immediately an angel of the Lord struck [Herod] down, because he did not give God the glory, and he was eaten by worms and breathed his last.

Acts 27:23-24 23 For this very night there stood before me [Paul] an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I worship, 24 and he said, Do not be afraid, Paul. You must stand before Caesar. And behold, God has granted you all those who sail with you.

1 Corinthians 4:9 9 For I think that God has exhibited us apostles as last of all, like men sentenced to death, because we have become a spectacle to the world, to angels, and to men.

1 Corinthians 6:2-3 2 Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if the world is to be judged by you, are you incompetent to try trivial cases? 3 Do you not know that we are to judge angels? How much more, then, matters pertaining to this life.

1 Corinthians 11:8-10 8 For man was not made from woman, but woman from man. 9 Neither was man created for woman, but woman for man. 10 That is why a wife ought to have a symbol of authority on her head, because of the angels.

Galatians 3:19 19 Why then the law? It was added because of transgressions, until the offspring should come to whom the promise had been made, and it was put in place through angels by an intermediary.

Ephesians 1:19-22 19 ...And what is the immeasurable greatness of [God's] power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might 20 that he worked in Messiah when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule, authority, power, and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. 22 And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church....

Ephesians 3:9-10 9 ...And to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God, who created all things, 10 so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.

Colossians 1:16 16 For by [the Son] all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones, dominions, rulers, or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.

Colossians 2:18-19 18 Let no one disqualify you, insisting on asceticism and worship of *angels*, going on in detail about visions, puffed up without reason by his sensuous mind, 19 and not holding fast to the Head....

1 Thessalonians 4:16 16 For the Lord [Jesus] himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an *archangel*, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Messiah will rise first.

2 Thessalonians 1:7 7 ...And to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty *angels*....

1 Timothy 3:16 16 Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness: He [Jesus] was manifested in the flesh, vindicated by the Spirit, seen by *angels*....

1 Timothy 5:21 21 In the presence of God, of Messiah Jesus, and of the elect *angels* I charge you to keep these rules without prejudging, doing nothing from partiality.

Hebrews 1:3-14 3 After making purification for sins, [Jesus] sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, 4 having become as much superior to *angels* as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs. 5 For to which of the *angels* did God ever say, You are my Son, today I have begotten you? Or again, I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son? 6 And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, Let all God's *angels* worship him. 7 Of the *angels* he says, He makes his *angels* winds, and his *ministers* a flame of fire. 8 But of the Son he says, Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the sceptre of uprightness is the sceptre of your kingdom. ...13 And to which of the *angels* has he ever said, Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet? 14 Are they not all *ministering spirits* sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?

Hebrews 2:5-16 5 For it was not to *angels* that God subjected the world to come, of which we are speaking. 6 It has been testified somewhere, What is man, that you are mindful of him, or the son of man, that you care for him? 7 You made him for a little while lower than the *angels*. You have crowned him with glory and honor, 8 putting everything in subjection under his feet. Now in putting everything in subjection to him, he left nothing outside his control. At present, we do not yet see everything in subjection to him. 9 But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the *angels*, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for

everyone. ... 16 For surely it is not angels that he helps, but he helps the offspring of Abraham.

Hebrews 12:22 22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering....

Hebrews 13:2 2 Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

1 Peter 1:12 12 It was revealed to [the Old Testament prophets] that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.

1 Peter 3:22 22 ... Who [Jesus] has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him.

2 Peter 2:10-11 10 Bold and wilful, they do not tremble as they blaspheme the glorious ones, 11 whereas angels, though greater in might and power, do not pronounce a blasphemous judgment against them before the Lord.

Jude 6 6 And the angels who did not stay within their own position of authority, but left their proper dwelling, he has kept in eternal chains under gloomy darkness until the judgment of the great day....

Jude 8-9 8 Yet in like manner these people also, relying on their dreams, defile the flesh, reject authority, and blaspheme the glorious ones. 9 But when the archangel Michael, contending with the devil, was disputing about the body of Moses, he did not presume to pronounce a blasphemous judgment, but said, The Lord rebuke you.

Jude 14 14 It was also about these that Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied, saying, Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of his holy ones....

Revelation 1:1 1 The revelation of Jesus Messiah, which God gave him to show to his servants the things that must soon take place. He made it known by sending his angel to his servant John....

Revelation 1:20 20 As for the mystery of the seven stars that you saw in my right hand, and the seven golden lampstands, the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches....

Revelation 2:1 1 To the angel of the church in Ephesus write: The words of him who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks among the seven golden lampstands.

Revelation 4:6-10 6 And around the throne, on each side of the throne, are four living creatures, full of eyes in front and behind: 7 the first living creature like a lion, the second living creature like an ox, the third living creature with the face of a man, and the fourth

living creature like an eagle in flight. 8 And the *four living creatures*, each of them with six wings, are full of eyes all around and within, and day and night they never cease to say, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come! 9 And whenever the *living creatures* give glory, honor, and thanks to him who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before him who is seated on the throne and worship him who lives forever and ever.

Revelation 5:11-12 11 Then I looked, and I heard around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders the voice of many *angels*, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power, wealth, wisdom, might, honor, glory, and blessing!

Revelation 7:1-3 1 After this I saw four *angels* standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of the earth, that no wind might blow on earth or sea or against any tree. 2 Then I saw another *angel* ascending from the rising of the sun, with the seal of the living God, and he called with a loud voice to the four *angels* who had been given power to harm earth and sea 3 saying, Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees, until we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads.

Revelation 8:7 7 The first *angel* blew his trumpet, and there followed hail and fire, mixed with blood, and these were thrown upon the earth. And a third of the earth was burned up, and a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.

Revelation 9:14-15 14 ...Saying to the sixth *angel* who had the trumpet, Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates. 15 So the four *angels*, who had been prepared for the hour, the day, the month, and the year, were released to kill a third of mankind.

Revelation 10:1-3 1 Then I saw another mighty *angel* coming down from heaven, wrapped in a cloud, with a rainbow over his head, and his face was like the sun, and his legs like pillars of fire. 2 He had a little scroll open in his hand. And he set his right foot on the sea, and his left foot on the land, 3 and called out with a loud voice, like a lion roaring. When he called out, the seven thunders sounded.

Revelation 12:7-9 7 Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his *angels* fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his *angels* fought back, 8 but he was defeated, and there was no longer any place for them in heaven. 9 And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world—he was thrown down to the earth, and his *angels* were thrown down with him.

Revelation 14:6-7 6 Then I saw another *angel* flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation, tribe, language, and people. 7 And he said with a loud voice, Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come, and worship him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water.

Revelation 14:9-10 9 And another *angel*, a third, followed them, saying with a loud voice, If anyone worships the beast and its image and receives a mark on his forehead or on his hand, 10 he also will drink the wine of God's wrath, poured full strength into the cup of his anger, and he will be tormented with fire and sulphur in the presence of the holy *angels* and in the presence of the Lamb.

Revelation 14:17-19 17 Then another *angel* came out of the temple in heaven, and he too had a sharp sickle. 18 And another *angel* came out from the altar, the *angel* who has authority over the fire, and he called with a loud voice to the one who had the sharp sickle, Put in your sickle and gather the clusters from the vine of the earth, for its grapes are ripe. 19 So the *angel* swung his sickle across the earth and gathered the grape harvest of the earth and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

Revelation 16:2 2 So the first *angel* went and poured out his bowl on the earth, and harmful and painful sores came upon the people who bore the mark of the beast and worshiped its image.

Revelation 19:17-18 17 Then I saw an *angel* standing in the sun, and with a loud voice he called to all the birds that fly directly overhead, Come, gather for the great supper of God, 18 to eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and their riders, and the flesh of all men, both free and slave, both small and great.

Revelation 20:1-3 1 Then I saw an *angel* coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain. 2 And he seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years, 3 and threw him into the pit, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were ended.

Revelation 22:8-9 8 I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the *angel* who showed them to me, 9 but he said to me, You must not do that! I am a *fellow servant* with you and your brothers the prophets, and with those who keep the words of this book. Worship God.
