

**VERSES ON BIBLE STUDY**  
*(See also Verses on Teachability)*

**Ex 34:2-4** 2 Be ready by morning, come up in the morning to Mount Sinai, and present yourself there to me [Yahweh] on the top of the mountain. 3 No man is to come up with you [Moses], nor let any man be seen anywhere on the mountain. Even the flocks and the herds may not graze in front of that mountain. 4 So [Moses] cut out two stone tablets like the former ones, and Moses rose up early in the morning and went up to Mount Sinai, as Yahweh had commanded him, and he took two stone tablets in his hand.

**Dt 8:3** 3 [Yahweh] humbled you, let you be hungry, and fed you with manna that you did not know nor did your fathers know, that he might make you understand that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by everything that proceeds out of the mouth of Yahweh.

**Dt 11:18-20** 18 You will...impress these words of mine on your heart and on your soul, you will bind them as a sign on your hand, and they will be as frontals on your forehead. 19 You will teach them to your sons, talking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk along the road, when you lie down, and when you rise up. 20 You will write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

**Dt 17:18-20** 18 When [the king] sits on the throne of his kingdom, he will write for himself a copy of this law on a scroll in the presence of the Levitical priests. 19 It will be with him, and he will read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear Yahweh his God by carefully observing all the words of this law and these statutes, 20 that his heart may not be lifted up above his countrymen and that he may not turn aside from the commandment, to the right or the left, so that he and his sons may continue long in his kingdom in the midst of Israel.

**Ps 1:1-2** 1 How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked, nor stand in the path of sinners, nor sit in the seat of scoffers! 2 But his delight is in the law (תּוֹרָה) of Yahweh, and in his law (תּוֹרָה) he meditates day and night.

**Ps 25:4-5** 4 Make me know your ways, Yahweh. Teach me your paths. 5 Lead me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation. For you I wait all the day.

**Ps 111:2** 2 Very great (גְּדֹלִים) are the works of Yahweh, studied (דָּרַשׁ) by all who delight (דָּרַשׁ) in them.

**Ps 119:7** 7 I will give thanks to you with uprightness of heart, when I learn the judgments of your righteousness (מִשְׁפָּטֵי צְדָקָה).

**Ps 119:30** 30 I have chosen the faithful way. I have placed your ordinances before me.

**Ps 143:8-10** 8 Let me hear your loyal love in the morning, for I trust in you. Teach me the way in which I should walk, for to you I lift up my soul. ...10 Teach me to do your desire, for you are my God. Let your good Spirit lead me on level ground.

**Pr 8:34-35** 34 Blessed is the man who listens to me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at my doorposts. 35 For he who finds me finds [true] life (חַיִּים) and obtains what is pleasing (רְצוֹן) from Yahweh.

**Pr 9:1-6** 1 Wisdom has built her house. She has hewn out her seven pillars. 2 She has prepared her food. She has mixed her wine. She has also set her table. 3 She has sent out her maidens. She calls from the tops of the heights of the city: 4 Whoever is naive (פְּתִי), let him turn in here! To one in want of a heart (לֵב) she says: 5 Come, eat of my food, and drink of the wine I have mixed. 6 Forsake naivety (פְּתִי), live, and proceed in the way of understanding (בִּינָה).

**Pr 12:11** 11 He who tills his land will have plenty of bread, but he who pursues worthless things lacks sense.

**Pr 16:26** 26 A worker's appetite works for him, for his hunger urges him on.

**Pr 18:15** 15 The heart (לֵב) of a discerning person acquires knowledge (דַּעַת), and the ear of the wise (חֲכָמִים) seeks knowledge (דַּעַת).

**Pr 19:27** 27 Cease listening, my son, to discipline, and you will stray from the words of knowledge.

**Pr 20:13** 13 Do not love sleep or you will become poor. Open your eyes, and you will be satisfied with [spiritual and physical] food.

**Ho 4:6** 6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge [of God] (הִדְעַת). Because you [Israel] have rejected knowledge [of God] (הִדְעַת), I also will reject you from being my priest. Because you have forgotten the law (תּוֹרָה) of your God, I also will forget your children.

**Ho 8:12** 12 Though I [Yahweh] wrote for [Ephraim] ten thousand precepts of my law, they are regarded as a strange thing.

**Mt 4:4** 4 [Jesus] answered [Satan] and said: It is written: Man will not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.

**Jn 8:31-32** 31 Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed him: If you continue in my word, you are truly disciples of mine. 32 And you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free.

**Ro 15:4** 4 Whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, so that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

**1 Co 10:11** 11 These things happened to [Israel] as an example, and they were written for our instruction, upon whom the ends of the ages have come.

**Col 3:1-2** 1 Because you have been raised up with Messiah, keep seeking the things above where Messiah is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth.

**Col 3:16** 16 Let the word of Messiah richly dwell among you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another....

**2 Ti 2:15** 15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.

**2 Ti 3:16-17** 16 All Scripture is God-breathed (θεόπνευστος) and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, 17 so that the man of God may be proficient (ἄρτιος), equipped for every good work.

**Heb 5:11-14** 11 Concerning [the Son] we have much to say, but it is hard to explain because you have become dull of hearing. 12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need again for someone to teach you the elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need milk and not solid food. 13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is not accustomed to the word of righteousness, for he is an infant. 14 But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil.

**Jas 1:21-25** 21 Putting aside all filthiness and what remains of wickedness, in humility receive the message implanted, which is able to save your souls. 22 But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves. ...25 One who looks intently at the perfect law, that of liberty, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man will be blessed in what he does.

**1 Pe 1:10-12** 10 As to this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace that would come to you made careful searches and inquiries, 11 seeking to know what person or time the Spirit of Messiah within them was indicating as he predicted the sufferings of Messiah and the glories to follow. 12 It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, in these things that now have been announced to you through those who preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things into which angels long to look.

**1 Pe 2:2** 2 Like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation.

**2 Pe 1:19** 19 We have the prophetic word more certain [than our own experiences], to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts.

**1 Jn 2:27** 27 As for you [believers], the anointing that you received from [the Holy One] abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in him.
