

VERSES ON CONDEMNATION

Exodus 22:9 9 ...Every breach of trust, whether it is for an ox, for a donkey, for a sheep, for a cloak, or for any kind of lost thing, of which one says, This is it, the case of both parties shall come before God. The one whom God condemns shall pay double to his neighbour.

Deuteronomy 25:1-2 1 If there is a dispute between men, they come into court, and the judges decide between them, acquitting the innocent and condemning the guilty, 2 then if the guilty man deserves to be beaten, the judge....

1 Kings 8:31-32 31 If a man sins against his neighbour, is made to take an oath, and comes and swears his oath before your altar in this house, 32 then hear in heaven, act, and judge your servants, condemning the guilty by bringing his conduct on his own head, and vindicating the righteous by rewarding him according to his righteousness.

Job 40:6-8 6 ...Yahweh answered Job out of the whirlwind and said: 7 Dress for action like a man. I will question you, and you make it known to me. 8 Will you even put me in the wrong? Will you condemn me that you may be in the right?

Psalms 34:21-22 21 Affliction will slay the wicked, and those who hate the righteous will be condemned. 22 Yahweh redeems the life of his servants. None of those who take refuge in him will be condemned.

Psalms 37:32-33 32 The wicked watches for the righteous and seeks to put him to death. 33 Yahweh will not abandon him to his power or let him be condemned when he is brought to trial.

Psalms 94:20-23 20 Can wicked rulers be allied with you, those who frame injustice by statute? 21 They band together against the life of the righteous and condemn the innocent to death. 22 But Yahweh has become my stronghold, and my God the rock of my refuge. 23 He will bring back on them their iniquity and wipe them out for their wickedness. Yahweh our God will wipe them out.

Psalms 109:29-31 29 May my accusers be clothed with dishonour. May they be wrapped in their own shame as in a cloak! 30 With my mouth I will give great thanks to Yahweh. I will praise him in the midst of the throng. 31 For he stands at the right hand of the needy one, to save him from those who condemn his soul to death.

Proverbs 12:2 2 A good man obtains grace from Yahweh, but a man of evil devices he condemns.

Proverbs 17:15 15 He who justifies the wicked and he who condemns the righteous are both alike an abomination to Yahweh.

Isaiah 50:7-9 7 ...Lord Yahweh helps me. Therefore I have not been disgraced. Therefore I have set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be put to shame. 8 He who vindicates

me is near. Who will contend with me? Let us stand up together. Who is my adversary? Let him come near to me. 9 Behold, Lord Yahweh helps me. Who will declare me guilty? Behold, all of them will wear out like a garment. The moth will eat them up.

Isaiah 54:17 17 ...No weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed, and you shall refute every tongue that rises against you in judgment. This is the inheritance of the servants of Yahweh and their vindication (הַקָּדוֹשׁ) from me, declares Yahweh.

Matthew 11:20-24 20 ...[Jesus] began to denounce the cities where most of his mighty works had been done, because they did not repent. 21 Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. 22 But I tell you, it will be more bearable on the day of judgment for Tyre and Sidon than for you. 23 And you, Capernaum, will you be exalted to heaven? You will be brought down to Hades. For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. 24 But I tell you that it will be more tolerable on the day of judgment for the land of Sodom than for you.

Matthew 12:33-37 33 Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or make the tree bad and its fruit bad, for the tree is known by its fruit. 34 You brood of vipers! How can you speak good, when you are evil? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. 35 The good person out of his good treasure brings forth good, and the evil person out of his evil treasure brings forth evil. 36 I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak. 37 For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

Matthew 12:41-42 41 The men of Nineveh will rise up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it, for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and behold, something greater than Jonah is here. 42 The queen of the South will rise up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it, for she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon, and behold, something greater than Solomon is here.

Matthew 20:18 18 See, we are going up to Jerusalem. And the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and scribes, and they will condemn him to death.

Matthew 26:66 66 What is your judgment? They answered, He [Jesus] deserves death.

Matthew 27:3 3 ...When Judas, his betrayer, saw that Jesus was condemned, he changed his mind and brought back the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and the elders....

Mark 14:64 64 You have heard his blasphemy. What is your decision? And they all condemned him as deserving death.

Mark 16:16 16 Whoever believes and is baptised will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Luke 20:46-47 46 Beware of the scribes, who like to walk around in long robes, and love greetings in the marketplaces and the best seats in the synagogues and the places of honour at feasts, 47 who devour widows' houses and for a pretense make long prayers. They will receive the greater condemnation.

John 3:17-18 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. 18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

John 9:9-11 9 ...When [the scribes and Pharisees] heard it, they went away one by one, beginning with the older ones, and Jesus was left alone with the woman standing before him. 10 Jesus stood up and said to her, Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you? 11 She said, No one, Lord. And Jesus said, Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on sin no more.

Romans 2:1 1 ...You have no excuse, O man, every one of you who judges. For in passing judgment on another you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, practice the very same things.

Romans 5:16-18 16 ...The judgment following one trespass brought condemnation, but the free gift following many trespasses brought justification. 17 For if, because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one man, much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and the free gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man Jesus Messiah. 18 Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.

Romans 8:1-4 1 There is...now no condemnation for those who are in Messiah Jesus. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Messiah Jesus from the law of sin and death. 3 For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, 4 in order that the righteous requirement of the Torah might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:33-34 33 Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. 34 Who is to condemn? Messiah Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.

1 Corinthians 11:31-32 31 ...If we judged ourselves truly, we would not be judged. 32 But when we are judged by the Lord, we are disciplined so that we may not be condemned along with the world.

2 Corinthians 3:7-9 7 ...If the ministry of death, carved in letters on stone, came with such glory that the Israelites could not gaze at Moses' face because of its glory, which was being brought to an end, 8 will not the ministry of the Spirit have even more glory? 9 For if there

was glory in the ministry of condemnation, the ministry of righteousness must far exceed it in glory.

2 Thessalonians 2:11-12 11 ...God sends [unbelievers] a strong delusion, so that they may believe what is false, 12 in order that all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Hebrews 11:7 7 By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.
