

VERSES ON DEATH

Genesis 2:17 17 ...From the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you will not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will certainly die.

Genesis 3:4 4 The serpent said to the woman, You certainly will not die!

Genesis 3:19 19 You [Adam] are dust, and to dust you will return.

Genesis 5:5 5 ...All the days that Adam lived were 930 years, and he died.

Genesis 25:8 8 Abraham breathed his last and died in a good old age, an old man and full of years, and was gathered to his people.

2 Samuel 22:5-7 5 ...The waves of death encompassed me [David]. The torrents of destruction assailed me. 6 The cords of Sheol entangled me. The snares of death confronted me. 7 In my distress I called upon Yahweh to my God I called. From his temple he heard my voice, and my cry came to his ears.

1 Kings 2:1-2 1 When David's time to die drew near, he commanded Solomon his son, saying, 2 I am about to go the way of all the earth.

1 Kings 14:12-13 13 ...All Israel shall mourn for [the child] and bury him, for he only of Jeroboam shall come to the grave, because in him there is found something pleasing to Yahweh, the God of Israel, in the house of Jeroboam.

2 Kings 20:1 1 ...Isaiah the prophet...came to [Hezekiah] and said to him, Thus says Yahweh, Set your house in order, for you will die and not live.

1 Chronicles 29:28 28 ...[David] died at a good age, full of days, riches, and honor, and Solomon his son reigned in his place.

Job 1:21 21 Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will return there. Yahweh gave and Yahweh has taken away. Blessed be the name of Yahweh.

Psalms 13:3-4 3 Consider and answer me, Yahweh my God. Light up my eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death.

Psalms 23:4 4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me. Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

Psalms 30:3 3 Yahweh, you have brought up my soul from Sheol. You restored me to life from among those who go down to the pit.

Psalms 30:9 9 What profit is there in my death, if I go down to the pit? Will the dust praise you? Will it tell of your faithfulness?

Psalm 39:4-5 4 Yahweh, make me know my end and what is the measure of my days. Let me know how fleeting I am! 5 Behold, you have made my days a few handbreadths, and my lifetime is as nothing before you. Surely all mankind stands as a mere breath!

Psalm 49:10-11 10 ...Even the wise die. The fool and the stupid alike must perish and leave their wealth to others. 11 Their graves are their homes forever, their dwelling places to all generations, though they called lands by their own names.

Psalm 55:4 4 My heart is in anguish within me. The terrors of death have fallen upon me.

Psalm 89:47-48 47 Remember how short my time is! For what vanity you have created all the children of man! 48 What man can live and never see death? Who can deliver his soul from the power of Sheol?

Psalm 90:9-12 9 ...All our days pass away under your wrath. We bring our years to an end like a sigh. 10 The years of our life are seventy, or even by reason of strength eighty. Yet their span is but toil and trouble. They are soon gone, and we fly away. ...12 So teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom.

Psalm 116:15 15 Precious in the sight of Yahweh is the death of his saints.

Psalm 118:17-18 17 I shall not die, but I shall live, and recount the deeds of Yahweh. 18 Yahweh has disciplined me severely, but he has not given me over to death.

Proverbs 14:12 12 There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death.

Proverbs 14:27 27 The fear of Yahweh is a fountain of life, that one may turn away from the snares of death.

Proverbs 14:32 32 The wicked is overthrown through his evildoing, but the righteous finds refuge in his death.

Ecclesiastes 7:2 2 It is better to go to the house of mourning than to go to the house of feasting, for this is the end of all mankind, and the living will lay it to heart.

Ecclesiastes 9:2-3 2 It is the same for all, because the same event [death] happens to the righteous and the wicked, to the good and the evil, to the clean and the unclean, to him who sacrifices and him who does not sacrifice. As the good one is, so is the sinner, and he who swears is as he who shuns an oath. 3 This is an evil in all that is done under the sun, that the same event happens to all.

Ecclesiastes 12:5-7 5 ...The almond tree blossoms, the grasshopper drags itself along, and desire fails, because man is going to his eternal home, and the mourners go about the streets — 6 before the silver cord is snapped, or the golden bowl is broken, or the pitcher is shattered

at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern, 7 and the dust returns to the earth as it was, and the spirit returns to God who gave it.

Isaiah 25:7-8 7 [Yahweh] will swallow up on this mountain [Zion] the covering that is cast over all peoples, the veil that is spread over all nations. 8 He will swallow up death forever.

Isaiah 57:1-2 1 The righteous man perishes, and no one lays it to heart. Devout men are taken away, while no one understands. For the righteous man is taken away from calamity. 2 He enters into peace.

Hosea 13:14 14 I shall ransom them from the power of Sheol. I shall redeem them from Death. O Death, where are your plagues? O Sheol, where is your sting?

Luke 2:28-30 28 [Simeon] took [Jesus] up in his arms, blessed God, and said, 29 Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace, according to your word, 30 for my eyes have seen your salvation....

Luke 13:1-5 1 There were some present at that very time who told him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. 2 And he answered them, Do you think that these Galileans were worse sinners than all the other Galileans, because they suffered in this way? 3 No, I tell you. But unless you repent, you will all likewise perish. 4 Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them. Do you think that they were worse offenders than all the others who lived in Jerusalem? 5 No, I tell you. But unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.

Luke 16:22-26 22 The poor man died and was carried by the angels to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. 23 And in Hades, being in torment, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side. 24 And he called out, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus to dip the end of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am in anguish in this flame. 25 But Abraham said, Child, remember that you in your lifetime received your good things, and Lazarus in like manner bad things. But now he is comforted here, and you are in anguish. 26 And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been fixed, in order that those who would pass from here to you may not be able, and none may cross from there to us.

Luke 23:43 43 ...[Jesus] said to [the criminal], Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise.

John 8:51 51 Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death.

Acts 7:59 59 ...As they were stoning Stephen, he called out, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.

Acts 20:24 24 I [Paul] do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.

Acts 21:13 13 I [Paul] am ready not only to be imprisoned but even to die in Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus.

Ro 5:21; Ro 6:3–23; Ro 7:5–24; Ro 8:1–13; Ro 8:38–39; 14:8; 1 Co 15:55–57

2 Corinthians 5:1-10 1 ... We know that if the tent that is our earthly home is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. 2 For in this tent we groan, longing to put on our heavenly dwelling, 3 if indeed by putting it on we may not be found naked. 4 For while we are still in this tent, we groan, being burdened—not that we would be unclothed, but that we would be further clothed, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life. 5 He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the Spirit as a guarantee. 6 So we are always of good courage. We know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, 7 for we walk by faith, not by sight. 8 Yes, we are of good courage, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord. 9 So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him. 10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Messiah, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

Philippians 1:20-24 20 ... It is my eager expectation and hope that I will not be at all ashamed, but that with full courage now as always Messiah will be honoured in my body, whether by life or by death. 21 For to me to live is Messiah, and to die is gain. 22 If I am to live in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me. Yet which I shall choose I cannot tell. 23 I am hard pressed between the two. My desire is to depart and be with Messiah, for that is far better.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 13 ... We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. 14 For because we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep. 15 For this we declare to you by a word from the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. 16 For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Messiah will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore encourage one another with these words.

2 Timothy 1:10 10 Our Saviour Messiah Jesus...abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

2 Timothy 4:6-7 6 ... I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come. 7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

Hebrews 2:14-15 14 Because...the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of

death, that is, the devil, 15 and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong slavery.

Hebrews 9:27 27 ...It is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment....

James 1:14-15 14 ...Each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. 15 Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.

Revelation 2:10 10 Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life.

Revelation 9:6 6 ...In those days people will seek death and will not find it. They will long to die, but death will flee from them.

Revelation 20:12-15 12 ...I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. 13 And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them, and they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done.

Revelation 21:4 4 [God] will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more....
