

## *VERSES ON ENDURANCE*

**Matthew 10:22** 22 ... You will be hated by all for my name's sake. But the one who endures (ὕπομένω) to the end will be saved.

**Matthew 24:13** 13 ... The one who endures to the end will be saved.

**Luke 8:15** 15 As for that in the good soil, they are those who, hearing the word, hold it fast in an honest and good heart, and bear fruit with endurance (ὕπομονή).

**Luke 21:17-19** 17 You will be hated by all for my name's sake, 18 but not a hair of your head will perish. 19 By your endurance (ὕπομονή) you will gain your lives.

**Romans 5:3** 3 ... We rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance (ὕπομονή), 4 and endurance (ὕπομονή) produces character....

**Romans 8:25** 25 ... If we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with endurance (ὕπομονή).

**Romans 12:12** 12 Rejoice in hope, endure (ὕπομένω) in tribulation, be constant in prayer.

**Romans 15:4** 4 ... Whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance (ὕπομονή) and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

**1 Corinthians 9:12** 12 ... We have not made use of this right [of receiving financial gifts], but we endure anything rather than put an obstacle in the way of the gospel of Messiah.

**2 Corinthians 6:4-5** 4 ... As servants of God we commend ourselves in every way: by great endurance, in afflictions, hardships, calamities, 5 beatings, imprisonments, riots, labours, sleepless nights, hunger....

**2 Corinthians 12:12** 12 The signs of a true apostle were performed among you with utmost endurance, with signs, wonders, and mighty works.

**Galatians 6:9** 9 ... Let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.

**Colossians 1:11** 11 ... Being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance (ὕπομονή) and patience (μακροθυμία) with joy....

**Colossians 3:12** 12 Put on... as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience (μακροθυμία), 13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other.

**1 Timothy 6:11** 11 But as for you, O man of God, flee these things. Pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance (ὕπομονή), gentleness.

**2 Timothy 2:24** 24 ...The Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring (ἀνεξίκακος) evil....

**Titus 2:2** 2 Older men are to be sober-minded, dignified, self-controlled, sound in faith, in love, and in endurance (ὕπομονή).

**Hebrews 10:36** 36 ...You have need of endurance (ὕπομονή), so that when you have done the desire of God you may receive what is promised.

**Hebrews 12:1-2** 1 ...Because we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance (ὕπομονή) the race that is set before us, 2 looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured (ὕπομένω) the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

**James 1:3-4** 3 ... You know that the testing of your faith produces endurance (ὕπομονή). 4 And let endurance (ὕπομονή) have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

**James 5:7-8** 7 Be patient (μακροθυμέω), ...brothers and sisters, until the coming of the Lord. See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, being patient (μακροθυμέω) about it, until it receives the early and the late rains. 8 You also, be patient (μακροθυμέω). Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand.

**1 Peter 2:19-23** 19 ...This is a gracious thing, when, mindful of God, one endures (ὕποφέρω) sorrows while suffering unjustly. 20 For what credit is it if, when you sin and are beaten for it, you endure (ὕπομένω)? But if when you do good and suffer for it you endure (ὕπομένω), this is a gracious thing in the sight of God.

**2 Peter 1:5-6** 5 ...Make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, virtue with knowledge, 6 knowledge with self-control, self-control with endurance (ὕπομένω), and endurance (ὕπομένω) with godliness....

**Revelation 1:9** 9 I, John, your brother and partner in the tribulation, the kingdom, and the patient endurance (ὕπομονή) that are in Jesus, was on the island called Patmos on account of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.

**Revelation 13:10** 10 If anyone is to be taken captive, to captivity he goes. If anyone is to be slain with the sword, with the sword must he be slain. Here is a call for the endurance (ὕπομονή) and faith (πίστις) of the saints.

**Revelation 14:12** 12 Here is a call for the endurance (ὕπομονή) of the saints, those who keep the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus.
