

VERSES ON FAITH, HOPE, AND LOVE

Romans 5:1-5 1 Therefore, since we have been justified by *faith*, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Messiah. 2 Through him we have also obtained access by *faith* into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in *hope* of the glory of God. 3 Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, 4 and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, 5 and hope does not put us to shame, because God's *love* has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

1 Corinthians 13:13 13 So now *faith, hope, and love* abide, these three, but the greatest of these is *love*.

Galatians 5:5-6 5 For through the Spirit, by *faith*, we ourselves eagerly wait for the *hope* of righteousness. 6 For in Messiah Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only *faith* working through *love*.

Ephesians 1:15-18 15 I have heard of your *faith* in the Lord Jesus and your *love* toward all the saints and for this reason 16 I do not cease to give thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers. 17 I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Messiah, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation as you come to know him, 18 so that with the eyes of your heart enlightened you may know what is the *hope* to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance among the saints....

Ephesians 4:2-5 2 ... With all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in *love*, 3 eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. 4 There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one *hope* that belongs to your call— 5 one Lord, one *faith*, one baptism....

Colossians 1:3-5 3 We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Messiah, when we pray for you, 4 since we heard of your *faith* in Messiah Jesus and of the *love* that you have for all the saints, 5 because of the *hope* laid up for you in heaven.

1 Thessalonians 1:2-3 2 We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, 3 remembering before our God and Father your work of *faith* and labor of *love* and steadfastness of *hope* in our Lord Jesus Messiah.

1 Thessalonians 5:8 8 But because we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of *faith* and *love*, and for a helmet the *hope* of salvation.

2 Thessalonians 1:3 3 We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers and sisters, as is right, because your *faith* is growing abundantly, and the *love* of every one of you for one another is increasing.

1 Timothy 1:5 5 The aim of our charge is *love* that issues from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere *faith*.

Hebrews 6:10-12 10 For God is not unjust so as to overlook your work and the *love* that you have shown for his name in serving the saints, as you still do. 11 And we desire each one of you to show the same earnestness to have the full assurance of *hope* until the end, 12 so that you may not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through *faith* and patience inherit the promises.

Hebrews 10:22-24 22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of *faith*, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the confession of our *hope* without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. 24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to *love* and good works....

1 Peter 1:3-8 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Messiah! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living *hope* through the resurrection of Jesus Messiah from the dead, 4 to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, 5 who by God's power are being guarded through *faith* for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 6 In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, 7 so that the tested genuineness of your *faith*—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Messiah. 8 Though you have not seen him, you *love* him. Though you do not now see him, you *believe* in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory....

1 Peter 1:20-22 20 He was foreknown before the foundation of the world but was made manifest in the last times for the sake of you 21 who through him are believers in God, who raised him from the dead and gave him glory, so that your *faith* and *hope* are in God. 22 Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, *love* one another earnestly from a pure heart....
