

VERSES ON FIRM FOUNDATION

1 Kings 5:17-18 17 The king [Solomon] commanded, and [the forced laborers] quarried great stones, costly stones, to lay the **foundation** of the house with cut stones. 18 So Solomon's builders, Hiram's builders, and the Gebalites cut them and prepared the timbers and the stones to build the house.

1 Kings 6:37-38 37 In the fourth year the **foundation** of the house of Yahweh was laid, in the month of Ziv. 38 In the eleventh year, in the month of Bul, which is the eighth month, the house was finished throughout all its parts and according to all its plans. So [Solomon] was seven years in building it.

Psalms 11:3 3 If the **foundations** are destroyed, what can the righteous do?

Psalms 24:1-2 1 The earth is Yahweh's and the fullness thereof, the world and those who dwell therein, 2 for he has **founded** it upon the seas and established it upon the rivers.

Psalms 33:6-9 6 By the word of Yahweh the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host. 7 He gathers the waters of the sea as a heap. He puts the deeps in storehouses. 8 Let all the earth fear Yahweh. Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him! 9 For he spoke, and it came to be. He commanded, and it stood **firm**.

Psalms 40:1-2 1 I waited patiently for Yahweh, and he inclined to me and heard my cry. 2 He brought me up out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay, and he set my feet upon a rock making my footsteps **firm**.

Psalms 75:3 3 When the earth totters, and all its inhabitants, it is I [God] who **keep steady** its pillars.

Psalms 87:1-3 1 On the holy mount stands the city [Yahweh] **founded**. 2 Yahweh loves the gates of Zion more than all the dwelling places of Jacob. 3 Glorious things of you are spoken, city of God.

Psalms 93:1-2 1 Yahweh reigns. He is clothed with majesty. Yahweh has clothed and girded himself with strength. Indeed, the world is **firmly established**. It will not be moved.

Psalms 104:5 5 [Yahweh] set the earth on its **foundations** so that it should never be moved.

Psalms 108:1 1 My heart is **established**, God. I will sing, I will sing praises, even with my soul.

Psalms 118:22-23 22 The stone that the builders rejected has become the **chief cornerstone**. 23 This is Yahweh's doing. It is marvelous in our eyes.

Psalms 119:5 5 Oh that my ways may be **established** to keep your statutes!

Psalm 119:133 133 **Establish** my footsteps in your word, and do not let any iniquity have dominion over me.

Psalm 119:152 152 Of old I have known from your testimonies that you have **founded** them forever.

Psalm 125:1-2 1 Those who trust in Yahweh are as Mount Zion, which cannot be moved but **abides** forever. 2 As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so Yahweh surrounds his people from this time forth and forever.

Psalm 127:1 1 Unless Yahweh **builds** the house, they labor in vain who build it.

Proverbs 3:19 19 Yahweh by wisdom **founded** the earth. By understanding he **established** the heavens.

Proverbs 10:25 25 When the whirlwind passes, the wicked is no more. But the righteous has an **everlasting foundation**.

Isaiah 28:16 16 Look, I am laying in Zion a stone, a tested stone, a **costly cornerstone** for the **foundation**, **firmly placed**. He who believes in it will not be disturbed.

Isaiah 33:6 6 Yahweh will be the **stability** of your times, a wealth of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge.

Isaiah 48:12-13 12 Listen to me, Jacob, and Israel, whom I called! I am he. I am the first, and I am the last. 13 My hand laid the **foundation** of the earth, and my right hand spread out the heavens. When I call to them, they stand forth together.

Matthew 7:24-25 24 Everyone who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the **rock**. 25 And the rain fell, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been **founded** on the **rock**.

Matthew 21:42 42 Jesus said to [the Jewish leaders], Did you never read in the Scriptures, The **stone** that the builders rejected, this became the **chief cornerstone**. This came about from Yahweh, and it is marvelous in our eyes?

Luke 6:47-48 47 Everyone who comes to me, hears my words, and does them, I will show you what he is like. 48 He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the **foundation** on the **rock**. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house but could not shake it, because it had been well built.

Acts 4:11-12 11 [Jesus] is the **stone** that was rejected by you, the builders, but which became the **chief cornerstone**. 12 And there is salvation in no one else. For there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved.

Romans 15:20 20 I [Paul] aspired to preach the gospel, not where Messiah was named, so that I would not build on another man's **foundation**.

1 Corinthians 3:10-15 10 According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I [Paul] laid a **foundation**, and someone else is building upon it. Let each one take care how he builds upon it. 11 For no one can lay a **foundation** other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Messiah. 12 Now if anyone builds on the **foundation** with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, 13 each one's work will become manifest, for the day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each one has done. 14 If the work that anyone has built on the **foundation** survives, he will receive a reward. 15 If anyone's work is burned up, he will suffer loss, though he himself will be saved, but only as through fire.

Ephesians 2:19-21 19 You [Gentile believers] are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are co-citizens with the [Jewish] saints and members of the household of God, 20 built on the **foundation** of the apostles and prophets, Messiah Jesus himself being the **cornerstone**, 21 in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord.

1 Timothy 6:18-19 18 Instruct [the rich] to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, 19 storing up for themselves the treasure of a good **foundation** for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life indeed.

2 Timothy 2:19 19 The **firm foundation** of God stands, having this seal, The Lord knows those who are his, and, Everyone who names the name of the Lord is to abstain from wickedness.

Hebrews 6:1-2 1 Leaving the elementary teaching about the Messiah, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a **foundation** of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of instruction about washings and laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.

Hebrews 11:8-10 9 By faith [Abraham] lived as an alien in the land of promise, as in a foreign land, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, co-heirs of the same promise. 10 For he was looking for the city which has **foundations**, whose architect and builder is God.

1 Peter 2:4-6 4 Coming to [Jesus] as to a **living stone** that has been rejected by men but is choice and precious in the sight of God, 5 you also, as **living stones**, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Messiah. 6 For this is contained in Scripture: Behold, I lay in Zion a **choice stone**, a **precious cornerstone**, and he who believes in him will not be disappointed.

Revelation 21:14 14 The wall of the city [the new Jerusalem] had **twelve foundation stones**, and on them were the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.
