

VERSES ON FOREKNOWLEDGE

John 6:64-65 64 ... There are some of you [disciples] who do not believe. (For Jesus knew from the beginning who those were who did not believe, and who it was who would betray him [foreknowledge].) 65 And he said, This is why I told you that no one can come to me [faith in Jesus] unless it is granted him by the Father [God's special call].

Acts 2:23 23 This Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge $(\pi \rho \acute{o} γνωσις)^1$ of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men.

Acts 26:5 5 [The Jewish leaders] have foreknown (προγινώσκω, pres.)² for a long time, if they are willing to testify, that according to the strictest party of our religion I [Paul] have lived as a Pharisee.

Romans 8:28-30 28 We know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called $(\kappa\lambda\eta\tau\delta\zeta)$ according to his purpose. 29 For those whom he foreknew $(\pi\rho\circ\gamma\iota\nu\delta\sigma\kappa\omega)$ he also predetermined $(\pi\rho\circ\rho\iota\zeta\omega)$ to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. 30 And those whom he predestined $(\pi\rho\circ\rho\iota\zeta\omega)$ he also called $(\kappa\alpha\lambda\epsilon\omega)$, and those whom he called he also justified $(\delta\iota\kappa\alpha\iota\delta\omega)$, and those whom he justified he also glorified $(\delta\circ\xi\dot\alpha\zeta\omega)$.

Romans 11:2 2 God has not rejected his people [the remnant of Israel] whom he foreknew (προγινώσκω).

1 Peter 1:1-2 1 Peter, an apostle of Jesus Messiah, To those who are elect exiles of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, 2 according to the foreknowledge (πρόγνωσις) of God the Father....

1 Peter 1:20 20 [Jesus] was foreknown (προγινώσκω) before the foundation of the world but was made manifest in the last times for the sake of you.

2 Peter 3:17 17 You..., beloved, knowing this beforehand (προγινώσκω), take care that you are not carried away with the error of lawless people and lose your own stability.
