

VERSES ON GENTLENESS

Matthew 5:5 5 Blessed are the <u>gentle</u> ($\pi \rho \alpha \delta \varsigma$), for they shall inherit the earth.

Matthew 11:29 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am <u>gentle</u> ($\pi \rho \alpha \hat{\upsilon} \varsigma$) and humble ($\tau \alpha \pi \epsilon \iota v \delta \varsigma$) in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Matthew 21:5 5 Say to the daughter of Zion, Behold, your king is coming to you, *gentle* $(\pi\rho\alpha\hat{v}\varsigma)$, and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.

1 Corinthians 4:21 21 What do you desire? Shall I [Paul] come to you with a rod, or with love in a spirit of *gentleness* (πραΰτης)?

2 Corinthians 10:1 1 I, Paul, myself entreat you, by the <u>gentleness</u> (πραΰτης) and clemency (ἐπιείκεια) of Messiah—I who am humble (ταπεινός) when face to face with you, but bold toward you when I am away!....

Galatians 5:22-23 22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 <u>gentleness</u> ($\pi \rho \alpha \ddot{\upsilon} \tau \eta \varsigma$), self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Galatians 6:1 1 Brothers and sisters, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of <u>gentleness</u> ($\pi \rho \alpha \hat{\upsilon} \tau \eta \varsigma$). Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted.

Ephesians 4:1-3 1 I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, 2 with all humility ($\tau\alpha\pi\epsilon\nu\sigma\phi\rho\sigma\sigma\nu\eta$) and *gentleness* ($\pi\rho\alpha\nu\tau\eta\varsigma$), with patience, bearing with one another in love, 3 eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Philippians 4:5 5 Let your *gentleness* (ἐπιεικής) be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand.

Colossians 3:12-13 12 Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, *gentleness* ($\pi \rho \alpha \tilde{\nu} \tau \eta \varsigma$), and patience, 13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other.

1 Timothy 3:2-3 2 Therefore an overseer must be above reproach, the husband of one wife, sober-minded, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, 3 not a drunkard, not violent but <u>vielding</u> ($\dot{\epsilon}\pi\iota\epsilon\iota\kappa\eta\varsigma$), not quarrelsome, not a lover of money.

2 Timothy 2:24-25 24 And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, 25 correcting his opponents with <u>gentleness</u> ($\pi \rho \alpha \tilde{\upsilon} \tau \eta \varsigma$). God may perhaps grant them a change of mind leading to a knowledge of the truth....



Titus 3:1-2 1 Remind them to be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good work, 2 to speak evil of no one, to avoid quarrelling, to be <u>yielding</u> (ἐπιεικής), and to show every <u>gentleness</u> (πᾶσαν...πραΰτητα) toward all people.

James 1:21 21 Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with <u>gentleness</u> ($\pi\rho\alpha\tilde{v}\tau\eta\varsigma$) the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

James 3:13 13 Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the *gentleness* ($\pi \rho \alpha \tilde{\upsilon} \tau \eta \varsigma$) of wisdom.

James 3:17 17 But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, <u>*vielding*</u> ($\dot{\epsilon}\pi\iota\epsilon\iota\kappa\eta\varsigma$), open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere.

1 Peter 2:18 18 Servants, be subject to your masters with all respect, not only to the good and *gentle* (ἐπιεικής) but also to the unjust.

1 Peter 3:3-6 3 Do not let your adorning be external—the braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewellery, or the clothing you wear— 4 but let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a <u>gentle</u> ($\pi\rho\alpha\ddot{v}\varsigma$) and quiet ($\dot{\eta}\sigma\dot{v}\chi\iota\sigma\varsigma$) spirit, which in God's sight is very precious. 5 For this is how the holy women who hoped in God used to adorn themselves, by submitting to their own husbands, 6 as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord.

1 Peter 3:15-16 15 But in your hearts honour Messiah the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you, yet do it with *gentleness* ($\pi \rho \alpha \tilde{\nu} \tau \eta \varsigma$) and respect ($\phi \delta \beta \sigma \varsigma$), 16 having a good conscience, so that, when you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Messiah may be put to shame.
