

VERSES ON GLORIFICATION

Exodus 28:2 2 ... You shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother, for glory (כָּבוֹד) and for beauty (תְּפְאֶׁרֶת).

Psalm 8:3-5 3 When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, 4 what is man that you are mindful of him, and the son of man that you care for him? 5 Yet you have made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory (בָּבוֹד) and honor (הַדֶּר).

Psalm 21:3-6 3 For you meet [the king] with rich blessings. You set a crown of fine gold upon his head. 4 He [David] asked life of you. You gave it to him, length of days forever and ever. 5 His glory (קָּבוֹּדְיִ) is great through your salvation (יְשׁוּשָׁה). Splendour and majesty you bestow on him. 6 For you make him most blessed forever. You make him glad with the joy of your presence.

Psalm 34:5 5 Those who look to [Yahweh] are radiant, and their faces shall never be ashamed (חפר).

Psalm 73:24 24 You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will receive me to glory (בָּבוֹיך).

Proverbs 16:31 31 Gray hair is a crown of glory. It is gained in a righteous life.

Isaiah 23:9 9 Yahweh of hosts has purposed it, to defile the pompous pride of all glory, to dishonour all the honoured of the earth.

Isaiah 28:5 5 In that day Yahweh of hosts will be a crown of glory (צְּבִי), and a diadem of beauty, to the remnant of his people....

Isaiah 60:1-2 1 Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of Yahweh has risen upon you [Israel]. 2 For behold, darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples. But Yahweh will arise upon you, and his glory (בָּבוֹד) will be seen upon you. 3 And nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising.

Daniel 4:30 30 ... The king [Nebuchadnezzar] answered and said, Is not this great Babylon, which I have built by my mighty power as a royal residence and for the glory of my majesty?

Hosea 4:7 7 The more [Israel] increased, the more they sinned against me. I will change their glory (בָּבוֹד) into shame.

Habakkuk 2:16 16 You will have your fill of shame instead of glory (כָּבוֹד). Drink, yourself, and show your uncircumcision! The cup in Yahweh's right hand will come around to you, and utter shame will come upon your glory (כָּבוֹד)!



Haggai 2:7-9 7 ...I will shake all nations, so that the treasures of all nations shall come in, and I will fill this house with glory, says Yahweh of hosts. 8 The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, declares Yahweh of hosts. 9 The latter glory of this house shall be greater than the former, says Yahweh of hosts.

Matthew 4:8 8 ... The devil took [Jesus] to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory (δόξα).¹

Matthew 19:28 28 Jesus said to [the disciples], Truly, I say to you, in the new world, when the Son of Man will sit on his throne of glory (δόξα), you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

Mark 8:38 38 ... Whoever is ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him will the Son of Man also be ashamed when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.

Mark 10:37 37 ...[James and John] said to him, Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory.

Luke 4:5-6 5 ... The devil took [Jesus] up, showed him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time, 6 and said to him, To you I will give all this authority (ἐξουσία) and their glory (δόξα), for it has been delivered to me, and I give it to whom I desire.

Luke 9:32 32 Now Peter and those who were with [Jesus] were heavy with sleep, but when they became fully awake they saw his glory and the two men who stood with him.

Luke 24:26 26 Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and enter into his glory?

John 5:44 44 How can you believe, when you receive glory from one another and do not seek the glory that comes from the only God?

John 12:23-26 23 And Jesus answered them, The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. 24 Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone. But if it dies, it produces much fruit. 25 Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. 26 If anyone serves me, he must follow me, and where I am, there will my servant be also. If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him.

John 12:42-43 42 Nevertheless, many even of the [Jewish] authorities believed in [Jesus], but for fear of the Pharisees they did not [publicly] confess it, so that they would not be put out of the synagogue. 43 For they loved the glory (δόξα) that comes from man more than the glory (δόξα) that comes from God.

¹ This is the first usage of δόξα in the New Testament.



John 17:22-23 22 The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, 23 I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.

Romans 5:1-2 1 Therefore, because we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Messiah. 2 Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Romans 8:16-25 16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Messiah, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be co-glorified (συνδοξάζω) with him. 18 For I [Paul] consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory (δόξα) that is to be revealed to us. 19 For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God. 20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope 21 that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory (δόξα) of the children of God. 22 For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now. 23 And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies. 24 For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees? 25 But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience.

Romans 8:30 30 And those whom [God] predetermined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified (δοξάζω, aor.).

Romans 9:4 4 They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory $(\delta \delta \xi \alpha)$, the covenants, the giving of the Torah, the worship, and the promises.

Romans 9:23 23 ...In order to make known the riches of his glory for vessels of mercy, which he has prepared beforehand for glory....

- **1 Corinthians 2:7** 7 ... We impart a secret and hidden wisdom of God, which God decreed before the ages for our glory.
- **1 Corinthians 11:7** 7 ... A man ought not to cover his head, because he is the image and glory of God, but woman is the glory of man.
- 1 Corinthians 15:39-44 39 ... Not all flesh is the same, but there is one kind for humans, another for animals, another for birds, and another for fish. 40 There are heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the glory of the heavenly is of one kind, and the glory of the earthly is of another. 41 There is one glory of the sun, another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars, for star differs from star in glory. 42 So is it with the resurrection of the dead. What is sown is perishable. What is raised is imperishable. 43 It is sown in dishonour. It is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness. It is raised in power. 44 It is sown a natural body. It is raised a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body.



- 2 Corinthians 3:7-18 7 Now if the ministry of death, carved in letters on stone, came with such glory that the Israelites could not gaze at Moses' face because of its glory, which was being brought to an end, 8 will not the ministry of the Spirit have even more glory? 9 For if there was glory in the ministry of condemnation, the ministry of righteousness must far exceed it in glory. 10 Indeed, in this case, what once had glory has come to have no glory at all, because of the glory that surpasses it. 11 For if what was being brought to an end came with glory, much more will what is permanent have glory. ...18 And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.
- **2 Corinthians 4:17-18** 17 ... This light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, 18 as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.
- **Philippians 3:19** 19 Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things.
- **Philippians 4:19** 19 ... My God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
- **Colossians 1:27** 27 To [the saints] God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Messiah in you, the hope of glory.
- **Colossians 3:4** 4 When Messiah who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
- **1 Thessalonians 2:12** 12 ... We exhorted each one of you, encouraged you, and charged you to walk in a manner worthy of God, who calls you into his own kingdom and glory.
- **1 Thessalonians 2:20** 20 For you are our glory and joy.
- **2 Thessalonians 2:14** 14 To this he called you through our gospel, so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Messiah.
- **1 Timothy 3:16** 16 Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness: He was manifested in the flesh, vindicated by the Spirit, seen by angels, proclaimed among the nations, believed on in the world, taken up in glory.
- **2 Timothy 2:10** 10 ...I endure everything for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation that is in Messiah Jesus with eternal glory.
- **Hebrews 2:9-10** 9 ... We see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone. 10 For it was fitting that he, for whom and by



whom all things exist, in bringing many sons to glory, should make the founder of their salvation perfect through suffering.

- **1 Peter 1:6-7** 6 In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, 7 so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Messiah.
- **1 Peter 1:24** 24 ... All flesh is like grass and all its glory like the flower of grass. The grass withers, and the flower falls, 25 but the word of the Lord remains forever.
- **1 Peter 4:14** 14 If you are insulted for the name of Messiah, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you.
- 1 Peter 5:1-4 1 So I exhort the elders among you, as a co-elder and a witness of the sufferings of Messiah, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed: 2 shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; 3 not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock. 4 And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.
- **1 Peter 5:10** 10 ... After you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Messiah, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.
- **2 Peter 1:3** 3 [God's] divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence....
- **1 John 3:2** 2 Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared. But we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is.
- **Revelation 21:10-11** 10 ...[The angel] carried me away in the Spirit to a great, high mountain, and showed me the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God, 11 having the glory of God, its radiance like a most rare jewel, like a jasper, clear as crystal.
