

## VERSES ON GOD'S HOLINESS

**Exodus 3:5** 5 Yahweh said [to Moses], Do not come near here. Remove your sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground.

**Exodus 15:11** 11 Who is like you among the gods, Yahweh? Who is like you, majestic in holiness, awesome in praises, working wonders?

**Leviticus 11:44-45** 44 I am Yahweh your God. Consecrate yourselves therefore and be holy, for I am holy. And you shall not make yourselves unclean with any of the swarming things that swarm on the earth. 45 For I am Yahweh who brought you up from the land of Egypt to be your God. Thus you shall be holy, for I am holy.

**Leviticus 19:1-2** 1 Yahweh spoke to Moses saying: 2 Speak to all the congregation of the sons of Israel and say to them, You shall be holy, for I, Yahweh your God, am holy.

**Leviticus 20:26** 26 You are to be holy to me, for I, Yahweh, am holy, and I have set you apart from the peoples to be mine.

**Numbers 20:12** 12 Yahweh said to Moses and Aaron, Because you have not believed me, to treat me as holy in the sight of the sons of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this assembly into the land that I have given them.

**Deuteronomy 23:14** 14 Because Yahweh your God walks in the midst of your camp to deliver you and to defeat your enemies before you, therefore your camp must be holy. And he must not see anything indecent among you, or he will turn away from you.

**Joshua 5:15** 15 The commander of Yahweh's army said to Joshua, Take off your sandals from your feet, for the place where you are standing is holy. And Joshua did so.

**Joshua 24:19-20** 19 Joshua said to the people, You are not able to serve Yahweh, for he is a holy God. He is a jealous God. He will not forgive your transgressions or your sins. 20 If you forsake Yahweh and serve foreign gods, then he will turn, do you harm, and consume you after having done you good.

**1 Samuel 6:19-20** 19 [Yahweh] struck some of the men of Beth-shemesh because they looked upon the ark of Yahweh. He struck seventy men of them, and the people mourned because Yahweh had struck the people with a great blow. 20 Then the men of Beth-shemesh said, Who is able to stand before Yahweh, this holy God?

**2 Samuel 6:6-12** 6 When they came to the threshing floor of Nacon, Uzzah put out his hand to the ark of God and took hold of it, for the oxen stumbled. 7 And the anger of Yahweh was kindled against Uzzah, and God struck him down there because of his error, and he died there beside the ark of God. ...9 And David was afraid of Yahweh that day, and he said, How can the ark of Yahweh come to me? 10 So David was not willing to take the ark of Yahweh into the city of David. But David took it aside to the house of Obed-edom the Gittite. 11 And the

ark of Yahweh remained in the house of Obed-edom the Gittite three months, and Yahweh blessed Obed-edom and all his household. 12 And it was told King David, Yahweh has blessed the household of Obed-edom and all that belongs to him, because of the ark of God. So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed-edom to the city of David with rejoicing.

**Psalm 22:3** 3 You are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel.

**Psalm 24:3-4** 3 Who shall ascend the hill of Yahweh? And who shall stand in his holy place? 4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully.

**Psalm 65:4** 4 Blessed is the one you choose and bring near, to dwell in your courts! We shall be satisfied with the goodness of your house, the holiness of your temple!

**Psalm 71:22** 22 I will sing praises to you with the lyre, Holy One of Israel (קָדוֹשׁ יְהוָה).

**Psalm 77:13** 13 Your way, God, is holy (קָדוֹשׁ). What god is great like our God?

**Psalm 93:5** 5 Holiness befits your house, Yahweh, forevermore.

**Psalm 99:2-9** 2 Yahweh is great in Zion. He is exalted over all the peoples. 3 Let them praise your great and awesome name! Holy is he! ...5 Exalt Yahweh our God. Worship at his footstool! Holy is he! ...9 Exalt Yahweh our God and worship at his holy mountain. For Yahweh our God is holy!

**Isaiah 1:4** 4 Ah, sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, offspring of evildoers, children who deal corruptly! They have forsaken Yahweh. They have despised the Holy One of Israel. They are utterly estranged.

**Isaiah 5:16** 16 The Holy God (קָדוֹשׁ הָאֱלֹהִים) shows himself holy in righteousness.

**Isaiah 6:1-3** 1 I [Isaiah] saw the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of his robe filled the temple. 2 Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings. With two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. 3 And one called to another and said: Holy, holy, holy is Yahweh of armies. The whole earth is full of his glory!

**Isaiah 8:12-13** 12 Do not call conspiracy all that this people calls conspiracy, and do not fear what they fear, nor be in dread. 13 But Yahweh of hosts, him you shall honour as holy. Let him be your fear, and let him be your dread.

**Isaiah 17:7** 7 In that day man will look to his Maker, and his eyes will look on the Holy One of Israel.

**Isaiah 37:23** 23 Whom have you mocked and reviled? Against whom have you raised your voice and lifted your eyes to the heights? Against the Holy One of Israel!

**Isaiah 40:25** 25 To whom then will you compare me, that I should be like him? says the Holy One.

**Isaiah 43:15** 15 I am Yahweh, your Holy One, the Creator of Israel, your King.

**Isaiah 54:5** 5 ...The Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer, the God of the whole earth he is called.

**Ezekiel 36:23-24** 23 I will vindicate the holiness of my great name that has been profaned among the nations and that you have profaned among them. So the nations will know that I am Yahweh, declares my Lord Yahweh, when through you I vindicate my holiness before their eyes.

**Ezekiel 38:16** 16 You [Gog] will come up against my people Israel like a cloud covering the land. In the latter days I will bring you against my land, that the nations may know me, when through you, Gog, I vindicate my holiness before their eyes.

**Ezekiel 38:23** 23 I will show my greatness and my holiness and make myself known in the eyes of many nations. Then they will know that I am Yahweh.

**Ezekiel 39:7** 7 My holy name I will make known in the midst of my people Israel, and I will not let my holy name be profaned anymore. And the nations shall know that I am Yahweh, the Holy One in Israel.

**Ezekiel 39:27** 27 ...When I have brought [Israel] back from the peoples and gathered them from their enemies' lands, and through them have vindicated my holiness in the sight of many nations.

**Hosea 11:9** 9 I will not execute my burning anger. I will not again destroy Ephraim. For I am God and not a man, the Holy One in your midst, and I will not come in wrath.

**John 10:36** 36 Do you say of him whom the Father set apart (ἀγίαζω, aor.) and sent into the world, You are blaspheming, because I said, I am the Son of God?

**2 Corinthians 6:14-15** 14 What partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? 15 What accord has Messiah with Belial?

**Hebrews 12:10** 10 [Our earthly fathers] disciplined us for a short time as it seemed best to them, but [the Father of spirits] disciplines us for our good, that we may share his holiness.

**1 Peter 1:15-16** 15 As he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, 16 because it is written, You shall be holy, for I am holy.

**Revelation 4:8-11** 8 Day and night [the four living creatures] never cease to say, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was, is, and is to come! 9 And whenever the living

creatures give glory, honor, and thanks to him who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before him who is seated on the throne and worship him who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne saying, 11 Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory, honor, and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created.

**Revelation 15:4** 4 Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship you, for your righteous acts have been revealed.
