

VERSES ON GOD'S TRUTH

Numbers 23:19 19 God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?

2 Samuel 7:27-29 27 You, Yahweh of armies, the God of Israel, have made this revelation to your servant [David] saying, I will build you a house. Therefore your servant has found courage to pray this prayer to you. 28 And now, my Lord Yahweh, you are God, and your words are true, and you have promised this good thing to your servant. 29 Now therefore may it please you to bless the house of your servant so that it may continue forever before you. For you, my Lord Yahweh, have spoken, and with your blessing shall the house of your servant be blessed forever.

Psalm 12:6 6 The words of Yahweh are pure words, like silver refined in a furnace on the ground, purified seven times.

Psalm 89:14 14 Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne. Loyal love and truth (תִּמְנוּן) go before you.

Psalm 111:7-8 7 The works of [Yahweh's] hands are truth (תִּמְנוּן) and justice. All his precepts are trustworthy (אֱמֵן). 8 They are established forever and ever, to be performed with truth (תִּמְנוּן) and uprightness.

Psalm 117:2 2 [Yahweh's] loyal love is great toward us, and the truth of Yahweh is everlasting.

Psalm 119:142 142 Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and your instruction (תּוֹרָה) is truth (תִּמְנוּן).¹

Psalm 119:151 151 You are near, Yahweh, and all your commandments are truth.

Psalm 119:160 160 The sum of your word is truth, and every one of your righteous ordinances is everlasting.

Proverbs 12:22 22 Lying lips are an abomination to Yahweh, but those who act faithfully (אֱמוּנָה) are his delight.

Proverbs 30:5-6 5 Every word of God is tested. He is a shield to those who take refuge in him. 6 Do not add to his words or he will reprove you, and you will be proved a liar.

Isaiah 45:19 19 I did not speak in secret, in a land of darkness. I did not say to the seed of Jacob, Seek me in vain. I, Yahweh, speak the truth. I declare what is right.

¹ Ps 119 describes the attitude and lifestyle of one who knows absolutely that God's word is truth.

John 1:14-17 14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. ... 16 For from his fulness we have all received, grace upon grace. 17 For the law was given through Moses. Grace and truth came through Jesus Messiah.

John 3:33 33 He who has received [Jesus'] testimony has set his seal to this, that God is true.

John 7:18 18 The one who speaks on his own authority seeks his own glory, but the one who seeks the glory of who sent him is true, and in him there is no falsehood.

John 7:28 28 So Jesus proclaimed, as he taught in the temple, You know me, and you know where I come from. But I have not come of my own accord. He who sent me is true, and him you do not know.

John 14:6 6 Jesus said to [Thomas], I am the way (ἡ ὁδός), the truth (ἡ ἀλήθεια), and the life (ἡ ζωή). No one comes to the Father but through me.

John 14:16-17 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper to be with you forever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

John 15:26 26 But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will testify about me.

John 16:13 13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.

John 17:3 3 This is eternal life, that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Messiah whom you have sent.

John 18:37-38 37 Pilate said to [Jesus], So you are a king? Jesus answered, You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world—to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice. 38 Pilate said to him, What is truth? After he had said this, he went back outside to the Jews and told them, I find no guilt in him.

Romans 3:4 4 Let God be true though every one were a liar, as it is written, That you may be justified in your words and prevail when you are judged.²

Ephesians 4:20-21 20 But that is not the way you learned Messiah!— 21 assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus....

² If every human being agreed something was true when God thought it false, it is God who would be right.

Titus 1:1-2 1 Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Messiah, for the sake of the faith of God's elect and their knowledge of the truth, which accords with godliness, 2 in hope of eternal life, which God, who never lies, promised before the ages began....

Hebrews 6:17-18 17 God, desiring even more to show to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of his purpose, interposed with an oath, 18 so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.

1 John 5:6 6 It is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth.

1 John 5:20 20 We know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding so that we may know him who is the true one. And we are in the true one, in his Son Jesus Messiah. This is the true God and eternal life.

Revelation 3:7 7 To the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: The words of the holy one, the true one (ὁ ἀληθινός), who has the key of David.

Revelation 21:5 5 [God] who sits on the throne said, Behold, I am making all things new. And He said, Write, for these words are faithful and true.
