

VERSES ON GOD AS JUDGE

Genesis 3:11 11 [Yahweh God] said, Who told you [the man] that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?

Genesis 4:10 10 Yahweh said, What have you done? The voice of your brother's blood is crying to me from the ground.

1 Samuel 2:3 3 Talk no more so very proudly. Let not arrogance come from your mouth. For Yahweh is a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed.

1 Samuel 2:10 10 The adversaries of Yahweh shall be broken to pieces. Against them he will thunder in heaven. Yahweh will judge the ends of the earth. He will give strength to his king and exalt the horn of his Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ).

1 Samuel 24:12-15 12 May Yahweh judge between me [David] and you [Saul]. May Yahweh avenge me against you, but my hand shall not be against you. ...15 May Yahweh...be judge and give sentence between me and you, see to it, plead my cause, and deliver me from your hand.

Psalms 7:6-11 6 Arise, Yahweh, in your anger. Lift yourself up against the fury of my enemies. Awake for me. You have appointed a judgment. 7 Let the assembly of the peoples be gathered about you. Over it return on high. 8 Yahweh judges the peoples. Judge me, Yahweh, according to my righteousness and according to the integrity that is in me. 9 Oh let the evil of the wicked come to an end, and may you establish the righteous—you who test the minds and hearts, righteous God! 10 My shield is with God who saves the upright in heart. 11 God is a righteous judge, and a God who feels indignation every day.

Psalms 9:19-20 19 Arise, Yahweh! Let not man prevail. Let the nations be judged before you! 20 Put them in fear, Yahweh! Let the nations know that they are but men!

Psalms 50:1-6 1 The Mighty One, God, Yahweh, speaks and summons the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting. 2 Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God shines forth. 3 Our God comes. He does not keep silence. Before him is a devouring fire, around him a mighty tempest. 4 He calls to the heavens above and to the earth, that he may judge his people: 5 Gather to me my faithful ones, who made a covenant with me by sacrifice! 6 The heavens declare his righteousness, for God himself is judge!

Psalms 58:10-11 10 The righteous will rejoice when he sees the vengeance. He will bathe his feet in the blood of the wicked. 11 Mankind will say, Surely there is a reward for the righteous. Surely there is a God who judges on earth.

Psalms 75:2-8 2 At the set time that I appoint I will judge with equity. 3 When the earth totters and all its inhabitants, it is I who keep steady its pillars. 4 I say to the boastful, Do not boast, and

to the wicked, Do not lift up your horn. 5 Do not lift up your horn on high or speak with haughty neck. 6 For not from the east or from the west and not from the wilderness comes lifting up, 7 but it is God who executes judgment, putting down one and lifting up another. 8 For in the hand of Yahweh there is a cup with foaming wine, well mixed, and he pours out from it, and all the wicked of the earth shall drain it down to the dregs.

Psalm 82:1 1 God has taken his place in the divine council. In the midst of the gods he holds judgment.

Psalm 82:8 8 Arise, O God, judge the earth, for you shall inherit all the nations!

Psalm 96:10-13 10 Say among the nations, Yahweh reigns! Yes, the world is established. It shall never be moved. He will judge the peoples with equity. 11 Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice. Let the sea roar, and all that fills it. 12 Let the field exult, and everything in it! Then shall all the trees of the forest sing for joy 13 before Yahweh, for he comes, for he comes to judge the earth. He will judge the world in righteousness and the peoples in his faithfulness.

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 13 The end of the matter. All has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. 14 For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.

Isaiah 51:5 5 My righteousness draws near, my salvation has gone out, and my arms will judge the peoples. The coastlands hope for me, and for my arm they wait.

Jeremiah 17:10 10 I, Yahweh, search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds.

Ezekiel 24:14 14 I am Yahweh. I have spoken. It shall come to pass. I will do it. I will not go back. I will not spare. I will not relent. According to your ways and your deeds you [Jerusalem] will be judged, declares Lord Yahweh.

Acts 10:42 42 [Jesus] ordered us [apostles] to preach to the [Jewish] people, and solemnly to testify that this is the one who has been appointed by God as judge of the living and the dead.

Romans 2:1-11 1 You have no excuse, O man, every one of you who judges. For in passing judgment on another you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, practice the very same things. 2 We know that the judgment of God rightly falls on those who practice such things. 3 Do you suppose, O man...that you will escape the judgment of God? 4 Or do you presume on the riches of his kindness, forbearance, and patience, not knowing that God's kindness is meant to lead you to a change of mind? 5 But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous judgment will be revealed. 6 He will render to each one according to his works.... 9 There will be tribulation and distress for every human being who does evil, the Jew first and also the Greek, 10 but glory, honor, and

peace for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek. 11 For God shows no partiality.

Romans 2:16 16 ...On that day when, according to my gospel, God judges the secrets of men by Messiah Jesus.

Ephesians 6:7-9 7 ...Rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man, 8 knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a bondservant or is free. 9 Masters, do the same to [your servants], and stop your threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him.

1 Peter 4:4-5 4 [Gentile unbelievers] are surprised when you do not join them in the same flood of debauchery, and they malign you. 5 But they will give account to him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

Revelation 16:5-7 5 I [John] heard the angel in charge of the waters say, Just are you, O Holy One, who is and who was, for you brought these judgments. 6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and you have given them blood to drink. It is what they deserve! 7 And I heard the altar saying, Yes, Lord God the Almighty, true and just are your judgments!

Revelation 19:1-2 1 I [John] heard what seemed to be the loud voice of a great multitude in heaven crying out, Hallelujah! Salvation, glory, and power belong to our God, 2 for his judgments are true and just. For he has judged the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her immorality and has avenged on her the blood of his servants.

Revelation 20:11-13 11 I saw a great white throne and him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. 12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is of life. And the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them. And they were judged, every one according to their deeds.
