

VERSES ON GOD THE FATHER

Deuteronomy 32:6 6 Do you thus repay Yahweh, you foolish and senseless people? Is not he your **Father** who created you, who made you and established you?

Deuteronomy 32:18 18 You were unmindful of the Rock that **fathered** (בָּנָה) you, and you forgot the God who **birthed** (בָּרַךְ) you.

1 Chronicles 29:10 10 David blessed Yahweh in the presence of all the assembly. And David said: Blessed are you, Yahweh, the God of Israel our **Father**, forever and ever.

Psalm 2:7-8 7 I [Messiah] will tell of the decree: Yahweh said to me, You are my Son. Today I have **fathered** (בָּנָה) you. 8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage and the ends of the earth your possession.

Psalm 68:5 5 **Father** (בָּנָה) of the fatherless and protector of widows is God in his holy habitation.

Psalm 103:13-14 13 As a **father** shows compassion to his children, so Yahweh shows compassion to those who fear him.

Isaiah 63:16 16 You are our **Father**, though Abraham does not know us, and Israel does not acknowledge us. You, Yahweh, are our **Father**, our Redeemer from of old is your name.

Isaiah 64:8 8 Yahweh, you are our **Father**. We are the clay, and you are our potter. We are all the work of your hand.

Daniel 7:9-10 9 As I looked, thrones were placed, and the **Ancient of Days** [God the Father] took his seat. His clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool. His throne was fiery flames. Its wheels were burning fire. 10 A stream of fire issued and came out from before him. A thousand thousands served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him. The court sat in judgment, and the books were opened.

Matthew 3:17 17 Behold, a **voice from heaven** said, This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.

Matthew 6:9-13 9 Our **Father** (πατέρα) in heaven, hallowed be your name. 10 Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. 11 Give us this day our daily bread, 12 and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. 13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Matthew 7:11 11 If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your **Father** who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

Matthew 23:9 9 Call no man your father on earth, for you have one **Father** who is in heaven.

Mark 14:36 36 [Jesus] said, Abba, **Father**, all things are possible for you. Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I desire, but what you desire.

John 4:23-24 23 The hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the **Father** in spirit and truth, for the **Father** is seeking such people to worship him. 24 God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.

John 5:26 26 As the **Father** has life in himself, so he has granted the Son also to have life in himself.

John 8:38-42 38 I [Jesus] speak of what I have seen with my **Father**, and you do what you have heard from your father. 39 They answered him, Abraham is our father. Jesus said to them, If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works Abraham did, 40 but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did. 41 You are doing the works your father did. They said to him, We were not born of sexual immorality. We have one **Father**—even God. 42 Jesus said to them, If God were your **Father**, you would love me, for I came from God and I am here. I came not of my own accord, but he sent me.

John 14:6-11 6 Jesus said to him, I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the **Father** except through me. 7 If you had known me, you would have known my **Father** also. From now on you do know him and have seen him. 8 Philip said to him, Lord, show us the **Father**, and it is enough for us. 9 Jesus said to him, Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the **Father**. How can you say, Show us the **Father**? 10 Do you not believe that I am in the **Father** and the **Father** is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the **Father** who dwells in me does his works. 11 Believe me that I am in the **Father** and the **Father** is in me, or else believe on account of the works themselves.

John 17:1-11 1 When Jesus had spoken these words, he lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, **Father**, the hour has come. Glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, 2 because you have given him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. 3 And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Messiah whom you have sent. 4 I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do. 5 And now, **Father**, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed. 6 I have manifested your name to the people whom you gave me out of the world. Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. 7 Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you, 8 for I have given them the words that you gave me. They have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you, and they have believed that you sent me. 9 I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours. 10 All mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them. 11 And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. **Holy Father** ($\pi\acute{a}\tau\epsilon\varphi\acute{\alpha}\gamma\imath\epsilon$), keep them in your name that you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one.

Romans 8:15 15 You did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, Abba! **Father!**

1 Corinthians 8:6 6 For us [believers] there is one God, the **Father**, from whom are all things and for whom we exist.

Galatians 4:4-6 4 When the fullness of time had come, God [the Father] sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. 6 And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, Abba! **Father!**

Ephesians 1:3-6 3 Blessed be the God and **Father** of our Lord Jesus Messiah, who has blessed us in Messiah with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, 4 even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love 5 he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Messiah, according to the purpose of his desire, 6 to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved.

Colossians 1:12-13 12 ...Giving thanks to the **Father**, who has qualified you [believers] to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. 13 He has delivered us [believers] from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son.

2 Thessalonians 2:13-17 13 We ought always to give thanks to **God** [the Father] for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the firstfruits to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth. 14 To this he called you through our gospel, so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Messiah. ...16 Now may our Lord Jesus Messiah himself, and God our **Father**, who loved us and gave us eternal comfort and good hope through grace, 17 comfort your hearts and establish them in every good work and word.

Hebrews 2:10-11 10 It was fitting that [God the Father], for whom and by whom all things exist, in bringing many sons to glory, should make the founder of their salvation [Jesus] perfect through suffering. 11 For he who sanctifies [Jesus] and those who are sanctified [believers] all have one source [God the Father]. That is why he [Jesus] is not ashamed to call them [believers] brothers.

James 1:17-18 17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the **Father** of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change. 18 By his own wish ($\betaούλομαι$) he brought us forth by the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

1 Peter 1:17 17 If you call on him as **Father** who judges impartially according to each one's deeds, conduct yourselves with fear throughout the time of your exile.

1 John 5:9-11 9 If we receive the testimony of men, the testimony of **God** [the Father] is greater, for this is the testimony of God that he has borne concerning his Son. 10 Whoever believes in the Son of God has the testimony in himself. Whoever does not believe God has

made him a liar, because he has not believed in the testimony that God has borne concerning his Son. 11 And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.

Revelation 4:8-11 8 The four living creatures...never cease to say, Holy, holy, holy, is the **Lord God Almighty** [the Father], who was, is, and is to come! 9 And whenever the living creatures give glory, honor, and thanks to him who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before him who is seated on the throne and worship him who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne saying, 11 Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory, honor, and power, for you created all things, and by your desire ($\theta\acute{e}\lambda\eta\mu\alpha$) they existed and were created.
