

## *VERSES ON HOLY SPIRIT*

**Genesis 1:2** 2 The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

**2 Kings 2:9** 9 When they had crossed, Elijah said to Elisha, Ask what I shall do for you, before I am taken from you. And Elisha said, Please let there be a double portion of your spirit on me.

**Nehemiah 9:20** 20 You gave your good Spirit to instruct [Israel], did not withhold your manna from their mouth, and gave them water for their thirst.

**Psalms 104:30** 30 When you send forth your Spirit, [living creatures] are created, and you renew the face of the ground.

**Isaiah 11:1-2** 1 There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit. 2 And the Spirit of Yahweh shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of Yahweh.

**Isaiah 30:1** 1 Ah, stubborn children, declares Yahweh, who carry out a plan, but not mine, and who make an alliance, but not of my Spirit, that they may add sin to sin.

**Isaiah 32:14-16** 14 The palace is forsaken, the populous city deserted. The hill and the watchtower will become dens forever, a joy of wild donkeys, a pasture of flocks, 15 until the Spirit is poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness becomes a fruitful field, and the fruitful field is deemed a forest. 16 Then justice will dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness abide in the fruitful field.

**Isaiah 40:13** 13 Who has measured the Spirit of Yahweh, or what man shows him his counsel?

**Isaiah 42:1** 1 Behold my Servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights. I have put my Spirit upon him. He will bring forth justice to the nations.

**Isaiah 44:3-4** 3 I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground. I will pour my Spirit upon your seed (עֲרֵב), and my blessing on your descendants. 4 They shall spring up among the grass like willows by flowing streams.

**Isaiah 48:16** 16 Draw near to me, hear this. From the beginning I have not spoken in secret, from the time it came to be I have been there. And now Lord Yahweh has sent me [Jesus] and his Spirit.

**Isaiah 59:21** 21 As for me, this is my covenant with them [Israel], says Yahweh: My Spirit that is upon you, and my words that I have put in your mouth, shall not depart out of your

mouth, out of the mouth of your seed, or out of the mouth of your seed's seed, says Yahweh, from this time forth and forevermore.

**Isaiah 61:1** 1 The Spirit of Lord Yahweh is upon me, because Yahweh has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound.

**Isaiah 63:10-14** 10 [Israel] rebelled and grieved his Holy Spirit. Therefore [Yahweh] turned to be their enemy and himself fought against them. 11 Then he remembered the days of old, of Moses and his people. Where is he who brought them up out of the sea with the shepherds of his flock? Where is he who put in the midst of them his Holy Spirit, 12 who caused his glorious arm to go at the right hand of Moses, who divided the waters before them to make for himself an everlasting name, 13 who led them through the depths? Like a horse in the desert, they did not stumble. 14 Like livestock that go down into the valley, the Spirit of Yahweh gave them rest. So you led your people, to make for yourself a glorious name.

**Ezekiel 3:12-14** 12 The Spirit lifted me [Ezekiel] up, and I heard behind me the voice of a great earthquake: Blessed be the glory of Yahweh from its place! 13 It was the sound of the wings of the living creatures as they touched one another, the sound of the wheels beside them, and the sound of a great earthquake. 14 The Spirit lifted me up and took me away, and I went in bitterness in the heat of my spirit, the hand of Yahweh being strong upon me.

**Ezekiel 11:1** 1 The Spirit lifted me [Ezekiel] up and brought me to the east gate of the house of Yahweh, which faces east.

**Joel 2:28-29** 28 It shall come to pass afterward, that I [Yahweh] will pour out my Spirit on all flesh. Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. 29 Even on the male and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit.

**Zechariah 4:6** 6 This is the word of Yahweh to Zerubbabel: Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, says Yahweh of hosts.

**Luke 1:35** 35 The Holy Spirit will come upon you [Mary], and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born [Jesus] will be called holy—the Son of God.

**Luke 2:25-26** 25 There was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was righteous and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. 26 And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Messiah.

**Luke 4:14** 14 Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and a report about him went out through all the surrounding country.

**John 3:5-8** 5 Jesus answered, Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. 7 Do not marvel that I said to you, You must be born again. 8 The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit.

**John 6:63** 63 It is the Spirit who gives life. The flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life.

**John 7:37-39** 37 On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. 38 Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water. 39 Now this he said about the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were to receive, for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

**John 14:16-17** 16 I [Jesus] will ask the Father, and he will give you [disciples] another Helper, to be with you forever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

**John 14:25-26** 25 These things I [Jesus] have spoken to you [disciples] while I am still with you. 26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

**John 15:26** 26 When the Helper comes, whom I [Jesus] will send to you [disciples] from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will testify about me.

**John 16:7** 7 I [Jesus] tell you [disciples] the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.

**John 16:8-14** 8 When [the Helper] comes, he will convict the world concerning sin, righteousness, and judgment: 9 concerning sin, because they do not believe in me; 10 concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer; 11 concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged. 12 I [Jesus] still have many things to say to you [disciples], but you cannot bear them now. 13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. 14 He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

**Acts 1:8** 8 You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

**Acts 1:16** 16 Brothers, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus.

**Acts 2:1-4** 1 When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. 2 And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. 3 And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

**Acts 2:38** 38 Peter said to [the Jewish people], Change your minds and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Messiah for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

**Acts 4:25** 25 ... Who through the mouth of our father David, your servant, said by the Holy Spirit, Why did the Gentiles rage, and the peoples plot in vain?

**Acts 4:31** 31 When [the believers] had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.

**Acts 5:31-32** 31 God exalted [Jesus] at his right hand as Leader and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins. 32 And we are witnesses to these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him.

**Acts 6:3** 3 Brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty.

**Acts 6:5** 5 [The disciples] chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit.

**Acts 6:10** 10 [The Jewish unbelievers] could not withstand the wisdom and the Spirit with which [Stephen] was speaking.

**Acts 9:17** 17 Laying his hands on [Saul] [Ananias] said, Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.

**Acts 9:31** 31 The church throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied.

**Acts 10:19-20** 19 While Peter was pondering the vision, the Spirit said to him, Behold, three men are looking for you. 20 Rise and go down and accompany them without hesitation, for I have sent them.

**Acts 10:38** 38 God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

**Acts 10:44-47** 44 While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word. 45 And the believers from among the circumcised who had come with Peter

were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit was poured out even on the Gentiles. 46 For they were hearing them speaking in tongues and extolling God. Then Peter declared, 47 Can anyone withhold water for baptising these people, who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?

**Acts 11:15-17** 15 As I [Peter] began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell on them [Cornelius and other Gentiles] just as on us at the beginning. 16 And I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, John baptised with water, but you will be baptised with the Holy Spirit. 17 If then God gave the same gift to them as he gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Messiah, who was I that I could stand in God's way?

**Acts 11:24** 24 [Barnabas] was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith.

**Acts 11:28** 28 One of [the prophets] named Agabus stood up and foretold by the Spirit that there would be a great famine over all the world (this took place in the days of Claudius).

**Acts 15:8** 8 God, who knows the heart, testified to [the Gentiles' faith] by giving them the Holy Spirit just as he did to us.

**Acts 15:28** 28 It has seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us to lay on you no greater burden than these requirements....

**Acts 20:22-23** 22 Behold, I [Paul] am going to Jerusalem, constrained by the Spirit, not knowing what will happen to me there, 23 except that the Holy Spirit testifies to me in every city that imprisonment and afflictions await me.

**Acts 21:11** 11 Coming to us, [Agabus] took Paul's belt, bound his own feet and hands, and said, Thus says the Holy Spirit, This is how the Jews at Jerusalem will bind the man who owns this belt and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.

**Romans 1:4** 4 [God's Son] was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Messiah our Lord.

**Romans 5:5** 5 Hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

**Romans 7:6** 6 Now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit and not in the old way of the written code.

**Romans 8:2-16** 2 The law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Messiah Jesus from the law of sin and death. 3 For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, 4 in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. 5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. 6 For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the

mind on the Spirit is life and peace. ...9 You...are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Messiah does not belong to him. 10 But if Messiah is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. 11 If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Messiah Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you. 12 So then, brothers and sisters, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. 13 For if you live according to the flesh you will die. But if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. 14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, Abba! Father! 16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God.

**Romans 8:23** 23 Not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.

**Romans 8:26-27** 26 The Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. 27 And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the desire of God.

**Romans 14:17** 17 The kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit.

**Romans 15:13** 13 May the God of hope fill you [Roman believers] with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

**Romans 15:15** 15 On some points I [Paul] have written to you very boldly by way of reminder, because of the grace given me by God 16 to be a minister of Messiah Jesus to the Gentiles in the priestly service of the gospel of God, so that the offering of the Gentiles may be acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.

**Romans 15:30** 30 I appeal to you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Messiah and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God on my behalf.

**1 Corinthians 2:9-13** 9 As it is written, What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, what God has prepared for those who love him— 10 these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God. 11 For who knows a person's thoughts except the spirit of that person, which is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. 12 Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God. 13 And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual. 14 The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.



**1 Corinthians 3:16** 16 Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?

**1 Corinthians 6:11** 11 Such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Messiah and by the Spirit of our God.

**1 Corinthians 6:19** 19 Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own.

**1 Corinthians 12:7-13** 7 To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. 8 For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he desires. 12 For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Messiah. 13 For in one Spirit we were all baptised into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

**2 Corinthians 1:21-22** 21 It is God who establishes us with you in Messiah and has anointed us, 22 and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

**2 Corinthians 3:3** 3 You show that you are a letter from Messiah delivered by us, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts.

**2 Corinthians 3:6** 6 [God] has made us sufficient to be ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit. For the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

**2 Corinthians 3:17-18** 17 The Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. 18 And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit.

**2 Corinthians 5:5** 5 God...has given us the Spirit as a guarantee.

**Galatians 4:6** 6 Because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts crying, Abba! Father!

**Galatians 5:22-25** 22 The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law. ...25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.

**Ephesians 1:13-14** 13 In Messiah you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of [God's] glory.

**Ephesians 2:18** 18 For through [Jesus] we [Jews and Gentiles] both have access in one Spirit to the Father.

**Ephesians 2:22** 22 In [Jesus] you [Gentiles] also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.

**Ephesians 3:4-5** 4 When you read this, you can perceive my [Paul's] insight into the mystery of Messiah, 5 which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit.

**Ephesians 3:14-17** 14 I [Paul] bow my knees before the Father, ... 16 that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, 17 so that Messiah may dwell in your hearts through faith.

**Ephesians 4:30** 30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

**Ephesians 5:18** 18 And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit....

**Ephesians 6:17-18** 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, 18 praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication.

**Philippians 1:19** 19 I [Paul] know that through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Messiah this will turn out for my deliverance.

**1 Thessalonians 1:6** 6 You became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit.

**2 Thessalonians 2:13** 13 We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers and sisters beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the firstfruits to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth.

**1 Timothy 4:1** 1 The Spirit expressly says that in later times some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons.

**2 Timothy 1:14** 14 By the Holy Spirit who dwells within us, guard the good deposit entrusted to you.

**Hebrews 9:7-8** 7 Into the second only the high priest goes, and he but once a year, and not without taking blood, which he offers for himself and for the unintentional sins of the people.



8 By this the Holy Spirit indicates that the way into the holy places is not yet opened as long as the first section is still standing.

**Hebrews 10:15-17** 15 The Holy Spirit also testifies to us. For after saying, 16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, declares the Lord. I will put my laws on their hearts and write them on their minds, 17 then he adds, I will remember their sins and their lawless deeds no more.

**Hebrews 10:29** 29 How much worse punishment, do you think, will be deserved by the one who has trampled underfoot the Son of God, has profaned the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has outraged the Spirit of grace?

**1 Peter 1:1-2** 1 Peter, an apostle of Jesus Messiah, to those who are elect exiles of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, 2 according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in the sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Messiah.

**1 Peter 1:10-12** 10 Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and inquired carefully, 11 inquiring what person or time the Spirit of Messiah in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Messiah and the subsequent glories. 12 It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.

**2 Peter 1:21** 21 No prophecy was ever produced by the desire of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

**1 John 3:24** 24 By this we know that [God] abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given us.

**1 John 4:13** 13 By this we know that we abide in [God], and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit.

**1 John 5:6** 6 The Spirit is the one who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth.

**Revelation 1:4-5** 4 Grace to you and peace from him who is, who was, and who is to come, and from the seven spirits who are before his throne, 5 and from Jesus Messiah the faithful witness.
