

VERSES ON HOPE

Psalm 27:1-14 13 I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of Yahweh in the land of the living! 14 Wait for Yahweh. Be strong, and let your heart take courage. Wait for Yahweh!

Psalm 33:17 17 The war horse is an empty hope (חַפְץ הַקָּרֵב) for salvation, and by its great might it cannot rescue.

Psalm 43:5 5 Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope (יְהִלָּה) in God, for I shall again praise him, my salvation and my God.

Psalm 62:5 5 For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him.

Psalm 119:49-50 49 Remember your word to your servant, in which you have made me hope (לִזְמֹר). 50 This is my comfort in my affliction, that your promise gives me life.

Psalm 119:116 116 Uphold me according to your promise, that I may live, and let me not be put to shame in my hope (בְּחַפְץ)!

Psalm 130:5 5 I wait for Yahweh, my soul waits, and in his word I hope (לִזְמֹר).

Psalm 146:5 5 Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope (בְּחַפְץ) is in Yahweh his God.

Proverbs 10:28 28 The hope (תֹּוֹהֶת) of the righteous brings joy, but the expectation of the wicked will perish.

Proverbs 11:7 7 When the wicked dies, his hope (תְּקוּנָה) will perish, and the expectation of wealth perishes too.

Proverbs 13:12 12 Hope (תֹּוֹהֶת) deferred makes the heart sick, but a desire fulfilled is a tree of life.

Proverbs 23:18 18 Surely there is a future, and your hope (תְּקוּנָה) will not be cut off.

Proverbs 24:13-14 13 My son, eat honey, for it is good, and the drippings of the honeycomb are sweet to your taste. 14 Know that wisdom is such to your soul. If you find it, there will be a future, and your hope (תְּקוּנָה) will not be cut off.

Lamentations 3:21-24 21 But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope. 22 The loyal love of Yahweh never ceases. His mercies never come to an end. 23 They are new every morning. Great is your faithfulness. 24 Yahweh is my portion, says my soul, therefore I will hope in him.

John 5:45 45 Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father. There is one who accuses you: Moses, on whom you have set your hope (ἐλπίζω).

Acts 28:20 20 For this reason, therefore, I have asked to see you and speak with you, because it is because of the hope (ἐλπίς) of Israel that I am wearing this chain.

***Romans 5:2-5** 2 Through [Jesus] we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope (ἐλπίς) of the glory of God. 3 Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, 4 and endurance produces character, and character produces hope (ἐλπίς), 5 and hope (ἐλπίς) does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

***Romans 8:18-25** 18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us. 19 For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God. 20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope (ἐλπίς) 21 that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God. 22 For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now. 23 And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies. 24 For in this hope (ἐλπίς) we were saved. Now hope (ἐλπίς) that is seen is not hope (ἐλπίς). For who hopes (ἐλπίς) for what he sees? 25 But if we hope (ἐλπίς) for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience.

***Romans 15:4** 4 For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope (ἐλπίς).

Romans 15:13 13 May the God of hope (ἐλπίς) fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope (ἐλπίς).

Ephesians 2:12 12 remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope (ἐλπίδα μὴ ἔχοντες) and without God in the world.

Colossians 1:27 27 To them God chose to make known how great among the nations are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Messiah in you, the hope of glory (ή ἐλπίς τῆς δόξης).

1 Thessalonians 4:13 13 But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope (ἐλπίς).

1 Timothy 1:1 1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by command of God our Savior and of Messiah Jesus our hope (ἐλπίς)....

1 Timothy 4:10 10 For to this end we toil and strive, because we have our hope (ἐλπίζω) set on the living God, who is the Savior of all people, especially of those who believe.

1 Timothy 5:5 5 She who is truly a widow, left all alone, has set her hope ($\epsilon\lambda\pi\zeta\omega$) on God and continues in supplications and prayers night and day....

1 Timothy 6:17 17 As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes ($\epsilon\lambda\pi\zeta\omega$) on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy.

Titus 2:11-13 11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, 12 training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, 13 waiting for our blessed hope ($\epsilon\lambda\pi\zeta$), the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Messiah....

Titus 3:7 7 ...So that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Hebrews 6:11-20 11 And we desire each one of you to show the same earnestness to have the full assurance of hope ($\epsilon\lambda\pi\zeta$) until the end, 12 so that you may not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises. ...17 So when God desired to show more convincingly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeable character of his purpose, he guaranteed it with an oath, 18 so that by two unchangeable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled for refuge might have strong encouragement to hold fast to the hope ($\epsilon\lambda\pi\zeta$) set before us. 19 We have this as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul, a hope ($\epsilon\lambda\pi\zeta$) that enters into the inner place behind the curtain, 20 where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf, having become a high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 9:28 28 ...Messiah, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting ($\alpha\pi\kappa\delta\epsilon\chi\mu\alpha\iota$) for him.

1 Peter 1:3-4 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Messiah! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope ($\epsilon\iota\zeta\epsilon\lambda\pi\iota\delta\alpha\zeta\omega$) through the resurrection of Jesus Messiah from the dead, 4 to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you....
