

VERSES ON INTIMACY WITH GOD

Deuteronomy 10:20 20 You shall fear Yahweh your God. You shall serve him and hold fast to him, and by his name you shall swear.

1 Kings 6:12-13 12 Concerning this house that you are building, if you will walk in my statutes, obey my rules and keep all my commandments, and walk in them, then I will establish my word with you, which I spoke to David your father. 13 And I will dwell among the children of Israel and will not forsake my people Israel.

1 Chronicles 16:11 11 Seek Yahweh and his strength. Seek his presence continually!

2 Chronicles 15:1 1 The Spirit of God came upon Azariah the son of Oded, 2 and he went out to meet Asa and said to him, Hear me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin. Yahweh is with you while you are with him. If you seek him, he will be found by you. But if you forsake him, he will forsake you.

Psalms 16:8-9 8 I have set Yahweh always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken. 9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices. My flesh also dwells secure.

Psalms 24:3-5 3 Who shall ascend the hill of Yahweh? And who shall stand in his holy place? 4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully. 5 He will receive blessing from Yahweh and righteousness from the God of his salvation.

Psalms 25:14 14 The friendship of Yahweh is for those who fear him, and he makes known to them his covenant.

Psalms 26:8 8 Yahweh, I love the habitation of your house and the place where your glory dwells.

Psalms 27:4 4 One thing have I asked of Yahweh, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of Yahweh all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of Yahweh and to inquire in his temple.

Psalms 42:1-2 1 As a deer pants for flowing streams, so pants my soul for you, O God. 2 My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?

Psalms 61:4 4 Let me dwell in your tent forever! Let me take refuge under the shelter of your wings! Selah

Psalms 63:1-2 1 O God, you are my God. Earnestly I seek you. My soul thirsts for you. My flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water. 2 So I have looked upon you in the sanctuary, beholding your power and glory.

Psalm 73:25 25 Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you.

Psalm 73:28 28 For me it is good to be near God. I have made Lord Yahweh my refuge, that I may tell of all your works.

Psalm 84:1-4 1 How lovely is your dwelling place, Yahweh of hosts! 2 My soul longs, yes, faints for the courts of Yahweh. My heart and flesh sing for joy to the living God. 3 Even the sparrow finds a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young, at your altars, Yahweh of hosts, my King and my God. 4 Blessed are those who dwell in your house, ever singing your praise! Selah

Psalm 84:10 10 ...A day in your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of wickedness.

Psalm 91:14-16 14 Because he holds fast to me in love, I will deliver him. I will protect him, because he knows my name. 15 When he calls to me, I will answer him. I will be with him in trouble. I will rescue him and honor him. 16 With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation.

Psalm 145:18 18 Yahweh is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.

Proverbs 18:10 10 The name of Yahweh is a strong tower. The righteous man runs into it and is safe.

Isaiah 12:6 6 Shout and sing for joy, inhabitant of Zion, for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 55:6-9 6 Seek Yahweh while he may be found. Call upon him while he is near. 7 Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts. Let him return to Yahweh, that he may have compassion on him, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. 8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares Yahweh. 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Matthew 11:28-30 28 Come to me, all who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Matthew 12:49-50 49 And stretching out his hand toward his disciples, he said, Here are my mother and my brothers! 50 For whoever does the desire of my Father in heaven is my brother, sister, and mother.

John 8:29 29 And he [the Father] who sent me [Jesus] is with me. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him.

John 15:4-11 4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. 5 I am the vine. You are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. 6 If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers. And the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. 7 If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples. 9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. 10 If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

Romans 8:15 15 For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, Abba! Father!

Ephesians 2:18 18 For through [Jesus] we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.

Ephesians 3:11-12 11 This was according to the eternal purpose that [God] has realized in Messiah Jesus our Lord, 12 in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him.

Hebrews 4:16 16 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Hebrews 10:19-22 19 Therefore, brothers and sisters, because we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, 20 by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, 21 and because we have a great priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

James 2:22-23 22 ...And he [Abraham] was called a friend of God.

James 4:5-6 5 Or do you suppose it is to no purpose that the Scripture says, He yearns jealously over the spirit that he has made to dwell in us? 6 But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.

1 John 3:21-22 21 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence before God. 22 And whatever we ask we receive from him, because we keep his commandments and do what pleases him.
