

VERSES ON JESUS' DEITY

Psalm 2:7 7 I will tell of the decree: Yahweh said to me, You are my Son (בְּרִי). Today I have fathered (יִלַּד)¹ you.

Isaiah 7:14 14 Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel (עִמָּנוּאֵל).

Isaiah 9:6 6 To us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God (אֵל גִּבּוֹר), Everlasting Father (אָבִי עֹלָם), Prince of Peace.

Jeremiah 23:5-6 5 Behold, the days are coming, declares Yahweh, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 6 In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: Yahweh is our righteousness (יְהוָה צְדִיקֵנוּ).

Micah 5:2 2 But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days.

Matthew 1:22-23 22 All this took place to fulfil what the Lord had spoken by the prophet: 23 Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel (which means, God with us).

Matthew 9:6 6 ... That you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins—he then said to the paralytic—Rise, pick up your bed, and go home.

Matthew 11:27 27 All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

Matthew 22:41-46 41 While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question 42 saying, What do you think about the Messiah? Whose son is he? They said to him, The son of David. 43 He said to them, How is it then that David, in the Spirit, calls him Lord saying, 44 The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet? 45 If then David calls him Lord, how is he his son? 46 And no one was able to answer him a word, nor from that day did anyone dare to ask him any more questions.

Matthew 26:63-66 63 The high priest said to [Jesus], I adjure you by the living God, tell us if you are the Messiah, the Son of God. 64 Jesus said to him, You have said so. But I tell you, from now on you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power and coming on the clouds of heaven. 65 Then the high priest tore his robes and said, He has uttered

blasphemy. What further witnesses do we need? You have now heard his blasphemy. 66 What is your judgment? They answered, He deserves death.

Matthew 27:54 54 When the centurion and those who were with him, keeping watch over Jesus, saw the earthquake and what took place, they were filled with awe and said, Truly this was the Son of God!

Matthew 28:18-20 18 Jesus came and said to [the disciples], All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

Mark 4:39-41 39 ...Jesus awoke, rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, Peace! Be still! And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. 40 He said to them, Why are you so afraid? Have you still no faith? 41 And they were filled with great fear and said to one another, Who then is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?

Luke 4:41 41 ...Demons also came out of many crying, You are the Son of God! But [Jesus] rebuked them and would not allow them to speak, because they knew that he was the Messiah.

Luke 7:48-49 48 ...[Jesus] said to [the woman of the city], Your sins are forgiven. 49 Then those who were at table with him began to say among themselves, Who is this, who even forgives sins?

Luke 10:22 22 All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

John 1:1-4 1 In the beginning was the Word [Jesus], and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. 4 In him was life, and the life was the light of men.

John 1:14 14 ...The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:18 18 No one has ever seen God. The only God, who is in the Father's chest, he has made him known.

John 3:31 31 He who comes from above [Jesus] is above all. He who is of the earth is from the earth and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all.

John 5:18 18 This was why the Jews were seeking all the more to kill [Jesus], because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God.

John 5:21-23 21 As the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so also the Son gives life to whom he desires. 22 For the Father judges no one, but has given all judgment to the Son, 23 that all may honour the Son, just as they honour the Father. Whoever does not honour the Son does not honour the Father who sent him.

John 8:23-24 23 You are from below. I [Jesus] am from above. You are of this world. I am not of this world. 24 I told you that you would die in your sins, for unless you believe that I Am you will die in your sins.

John 8:57-59 57 The Jews said to [Jesus], You are not yet 50 years old, and have you seen Abraham? 58 Jesus said to them, Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I Am. 59 So they picked up stones to throw at him, but Jesus hid himself and went out of the temple.

John 10:17-18 17 For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life, that I may take it up again. 18 No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This charge I have received from my Father.

John 10:27-33 27 My sheep hear my voice, and I [Jesus] know them, and they follow me. 28 I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. 30 I and the Father are one. 31 The Jews picked up stones again to stone him. 32 Jesus answered them, I have shown you many good works from the Father. For which of them are you going to stone me? 33 The Jews answered him, It is not for a good work that we are going to stone you but for blasphemy, because you, being a man, make yourself God.

John 14:8-9 8 Philip said to [Jesus], Lord, show us the Father, and it is enough for us. 9 Jesus said to him, Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father.

John 16:15 15 All that the Father has is mine.

John 17:5 5 And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.

John 18:4-6 4 ...Jesus, knowing all that would happen to him, came forward and said to [the soldiers and Jewish officials], Whom do you seek? 5 They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus said to them, I Am. Judas, who betrayed him, was standing with them. 6 When Jesus said to them, I Am, they drew back and fell to the ground.

John 19:7 7 The Jews answered [Pilate], We have a law, and according to that law he [Jesus] ought to die, because he has made himself the Son of God.

John 20:28-31 28 Thomas answered [Jesus], My Lord and my God! 29 Jesus said to him, Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed. 30 Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book. 31 But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

Acts 2:21 21 ...It shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord [Jesus] shall be saved.²

Acts 3:14-15 14 ...You [Jewish leaders] denied the Holy and Righteous One [Jesus], and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, 15 and you killed the Author of life, whom God raised from the dead. To this we are witnesses.

Romans 1:4 4 ...And was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Messiah our Lord.

Romans 9:5 5 To [Israel] belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Messiah, who is God over all, blessed forever. Amen.

Romans 10:13 13 ...Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord [Jesus] will be saved.³

2 Corinthians 4:4-6 4 ...The god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Messiah, who is the [living] image (εἰκὼν) of God. 5 For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Messiah as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake. 6 For God, who said, Let light shine out of darkness, has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Messiah.

Philippians 2:5-8 5 Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Messiah Jesus, 6 who, though he was in the form (μορφή) of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied himself by taking the form (μορφή) of a servant, being born in the likeness (ὁμοίωμα) of men. 8 And being found in human form (σχήμα), he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Colossians 1:15-20 15 [Jesus] is the image (εἰκὼν) of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. 16 For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. 17 And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. 18 And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent. 19 For in him all the fulness (πλήρωμα) of God was pleased to dwell, 20 and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.

Colossians 2:9 9 ...In [Jesus] the whole fulness (πλήρωμα) of deity dwells bodily, 10 and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority.

1 Timothy 3:16 16 Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness: He [Jesus] was manifested in the flesh, vindicated by the Spirit, seen by angels, proclaimed among the nations, believed on in the world, taken up in glory.

Titus 2:13 13 ...Waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Saviour Jesus Messiah....

Hebrews 1:1-12 1 Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, 2 but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son [Jesus], whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. 3 He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, 4 having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs. 5 For to which of the angels did God ever say, You are my Son, today I have begotten you? Or again, I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son? 6 And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, Let all God's angels worship him. 7 Of the angels he says, He makes his angels winds, and his ministers a flame of fire. 8 But of the Son he says, Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, the sceptre of uprightness is the sceptre of your kingdom. 9 You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness. Therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness beyond your companions. 10 And, You, Lord, laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the work of your hands. 11 They will perish, but you remain. They will all wear out like a garment. 12 Like a robe you will roll them up, like a garment they will be changed. But you are the same, and your years will have no end.

1 John 5:20 20 ...We know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Messiah. He is the true God and eternal life.
