

VERSES ON JESUS' SESSION

***Psalm 110:1-4** 1 Yahweh says to my Lord: Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies your footstool. 2 Yahweh sends forth from Zion your mighty sceptre. Rule in the midst of your enemies! ...4 Yahweh has sworn and will not change his mind, You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.

Daniel 7:13-14 13 I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him. 14 And to him was given dominion, glory, and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.

Matthew 16:18 18 And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

Matthew 18:20 20 For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them.

Matthew 22:44 44 The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet....

Matthew 26:63-64 63 But Jesus remained silent. And the high priest said to him, "I adjure you by the living God, tell us if you are the Messiah, the Son of God. 64 Jesus said to him, You have said so. But I tell you, from now on you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power and coming on the clouds of heaven.

***Matthew 28:18-20** 18 And Jesus came and said to them, All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

Mark 12:36 36 David himself, in the Holy Spirit, declared, The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet.

Mark 16:19 19 So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.

Luke 20:42-43 42 For David himself says in the Book of Psalms, The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at my right hand, 43 until I make your enemies your footstool.

Luke 22:69 69 From now on the Son of Man shall be seated at the right hand of the power of God.

John 6:62 62 Then what if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before?

John 7:33 33 Jesus then said, I will be with you a little longer, and then I am going to him who sent me.

***John 14:1-3** 1 Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God. Believe also in me. 2 In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.

John 14:12-13 12 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do. And greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father. 13 Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

John 14:16-18 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Encourager, to be with you forever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you. 18 I will not leave you as orphans. I will come to you.

John 14:28 28 You heard me say to you, I am going away, and I will come to you. If you loved me, you would have rejoiced, because I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.

***John 16:5-7** 5 But now I am going to him who sent me, and none of you asks me, Where are you going? 6 But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your heart. 7 Nevertheless, I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away. For if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you.

John 16:10 10 ...Concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer....

John 16:28 28 I came from the Father and have come into the world, and now I am leaving the world and going to the Father.

John 17:5 5 And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.

John 17:11 11 And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one.

John 17:13 13 But now I am coming to you, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

***Acts 2:33-35** 33 Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, [Jesus] has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing. 34 For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at my right hand, 35 until I make your enemies your footstool.

***Acts 3:19-21** 19 Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out, 20 that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Messiah appointed for you, Jesus, 21 whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago.

Acts 5:30-31 30 The God of our fathers raised Jesus, whom you killed by hanging him on a tree. 31 God exalted him at his right hand as Leader and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.

***Romans 8:34** 34 Who is to condemn? Messiah Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.

***Ephesians 1:19-23** 19 ...And what is the immeasurable greatness of [God's] power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might 20 that he worked in Messiah when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule, authority, power, and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. 22 And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, 23 which is his body, the fulness of him who fills all in all.

Ephesians 4:9-10 9 In saying, He ascended, what does it mean but that [Jesus] had also descended into the lower regions, the earth? 10 He who descended is the one who also ascended far above all the heavens, that he might fill all things.

Philippians 2:9-11 9 Therefore God has highly exalted [Jesus] and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven, on earth, and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Messiah is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Philippians 3:20 20 But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Messiah....

Colossians 3:1 1 If then you have been raised with Messiah, seek the things that are above, where Messiah is, seated at the right hand of God.

***Hebrews 1:3-4** 3 [The Son] is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, 4 having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.

Hebrews 4:14-16 14 Because then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Hebrews 7:26 26 For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens.

Hebrews 8:1-2 1 Now the point in what we are saying is this: we have such a high priest, one who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, 2 a minister in the holy places, in the true tent that the Lord set up, not man.

Hebrews 9:24 24 For Messiah has entered, not into holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true things, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf.

Hebrews 10:12-13 12 But when Messiah had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, 13 waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet.

Hebrews 12:2 2 ...Looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

1 Peter 3:22 22 [Jesus Messiah] has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him.

Revelation 3:21 21 The one who conquers, I will grant him to sit with me on my throne, as I also conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne.
