

## ***VERSES ON JESUS AS PROPHET***

**Numbers 12:6-8** 6 And [Yahweh] said, Hear my words: If there is a prophet among you, I, Yahweh, make myself known to him in a vision. I speak with him in a dream. 7 Not so with my servant Moses. He is faithful in all my house. 8 With him I speak mouth to mouth, clearly, and not in riddles, and he beholds the form of Yahweh. Why then were you not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?

**\*Deuteronomy 18:15-19** 15 Yahweh your God will raise up for you a prophet like me [Moses] from among you, from your brothers—it is to him you shall listen— 16 just as you desired of Yahweh your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly, when you said, Let me not hear again the voice of Yahweh my God or see this great fire any more, lest I die. 17 And Yahweh said to me, They are right in what they have spoken. 18 I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. 19 And whoever will not listen to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him.

**Deuteronomy 34:10-12** 10 And there has not arisen a prophet since in Israel like Moses, whom Yahweh knew face to face, 11 none like him for all the signs and the wonders that Yahweh sent him to do in the land of Egypt, to Pharaoh and to all his servants and to all his land, 12 and for all the mighty power and all the great deeds of terror that Moses did in the sight of all Israel.

**Matthew 5:1-2** 1 Seeing the crowds, [Jesus] went up on the mountain, and when he sat down, his disciples came to him. 2 And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying....

**Matthew 7:28-29** 28 And when Jesus finished these sayings, the crowds were astonished at his teaching, 29 for he was teaching them as one who had authority, and not as their scribes.

**Matthew 13:57-58** 57 And [the Nazirites] took offense at him. But Jesus said to them, A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown and in his own household. 58 And he did not do many mighty works there, because of their unbelief.

**Matthew 21:10-11** 10 When [Jesus] entered Jerusalem, the whole city was stirred up saying, Who is this? 11 And the crowds said, This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee.

**Mark 6:15** 15 Others said, He is a prophet, like one of the prophets of old.

**Luke 7:16** 16 Fear seized them all, and they glorified God saying, A great prophet has arisen among us!

**Luke 7:39** 39 Now when the Pharisee who had invited him saw this, he said to himself, If this man were a prophet, he would have known who and what sort of woman this is who is touching him, for she is a sinner.

**Luke 9:7-8** 7 Now Herod the tetrarch heard about all that was happening, and he was perplexed, because it was said by some that John had been raised from the dead, 8 by some that Elijah had appeared, and by others that one of the prophets of old had risen.

**Luke 9:18-20** 18 Now it happened that as he was praying alone, the disciples were with him. And he asked them, Who do the crowds say that I am? 19 And they answered, John the Baptist. But others say, Elijah, and others, that one of the prophets of old has risen. 20 Then he said to them, But who do you say that I am? And Peter answered, The Messiah of God.

**Luke 13:33** 33 I must go on my way today and tomorrow and the day following, for it cannot be that a prophet should perish away from Jerusalem.

**Luke 24:18-19** 18 One of them named Cleopas answered [Jesus], Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days? 19 And he said to them, What things? And they said to him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, a man who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people....”

**John 1:17** 17 For the Torah was given through Moses. Grace and truth came through Jesus Messiah.

**John 1:21** 21 And they asked [John], What then? Are you Elijah? He said, I am not. Are you the Prophet? And he answered, No.

**John 1:25** 25 They asked him, Then why are you baptising, if you are neither the Messiah, nor Elijah, nor the Prophet?

**John 4:17-19** 17 The woman [of Samaria] answered [Jesus], I have no husband. Jesus said to her, You are right in saying, I have no husband, 18 for you have had five husbands, and the one you now have is not your husband. What you have said is true. 19 The woman said to him, Sir, I perceive that you are a prophet.

**John 4:25** 25 The woman said to him, I know that Messiah is coming (he who is called Christ). When he comes, he will tell us all things.

**John 6:14** 14 When the people saw the sign that he had done, they said, This is indeed the Prophet who is to come into the world!

**John 7:40** 40 When they heard these words, some of the people said, This really is the Prophet.

**John 8:28** 28 So Jesus said to them, When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I Am, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me.

**John 9:17** 17 So [the Jewish leaders] said again to the blind man, What do you say about him, because he has opened your eyes? He said, He is a prophet.

**John 12:49-50** 49 For I have not spoken on my own authority, but the Father who sent me has himself given me a commandment—what to say and what to speak. 50 And I know that his commandment is eternal life. What I say, therefore, I say as the Father has told me.

**John 16:12-15** 12 I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. 13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. 14 He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you. 15 All that the Father has is mine. Therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

**John 17:8** 8 For I have given them the words that you gave me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you, and they have believed that you sent me.

**Acts 3:22-23** 22 Moses said, The Lord God will raise up for you a prophet like me from your brothers. You shall listen to him in whatever he tells you. 23 And it shall be that every soul who does not listen to that prophet shall be destroyed from the people.

**Acts 7:37** 37 This is the Moses who said to the Israelites, God will raise up for you a prophet like me from your brothers.
