

VERSES ON KNOWLEDGE OF GOD

Exodus 7:5 5 The Egyptians shall know that I am Yahweh, when I stretch out my hand against Egypt and bring out the people of Israel from among them.

Judges 2:10 10 All that generation also were gathered to their fathers. And there arose another generation after them who did not know Yahweh or the work that he had done for Israel.

2 Kings 19:19 19 So now, Yahweh our God, save us, please, from [Sennacherib's] hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that you, Yahweh, are God alone.

2 Chronicles 33:13 13 [Manasseh] prayed to [Yahweh], and God was moved by his entreaty, heard his plea, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that Yahweh was God.

Job 11:7-9 7 Can you find out the deep things of God? Can you find out the limit of the Almighty? 8 It is higher than heaven—what can you do? Deeper than Sheol—what can you know? 9 Its measure is longer than the earth and broader than the sea.

Job 36:26 26 Behold, God is great, and we know him not. The number of his years is unsearchable.

Proverbs 2:1-5 1 My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you, 2 making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding. 3 Yes, if you call out for insight and raise your voice for understanding, 4 if you seek it like silver and search for it as for hidden treasures, 5 then you will understand the fear of Yahweh and find the knowledge of God.

Isaiah 45:5-6 5 I am Yahweh, and there is no other. Besides me there is no God. I equip you, though you do not know me, 6 that people may know, from the rising of the sun and from the west, that there is none besides me. I am Yahweh, and there is no other.

John 1:18 18 No one has ever seen God. The only God [Jesus], who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.

John 17:3 3 This is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Messiah whom you have sent.

John 17:6 6 I have manifested your name to the people [disciples] whom you gave me out of the world. Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word.

John 17:25-26 25 Righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me. 26 I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them.

Acts 17:26-28 26 [God] made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place, 27 that they should seek God, and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him. Yet he is actually not far from each one of us, 28 for, In him we live and move and have our being.

Romans 11:33-34 33 Oh, the depth of the riches, wisdom, and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! 34 For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?

Ephesians 1:7-10 7 In [Messiah] we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, 8 which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight 9 making known to us the mystery of his desire, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Messiah 10 as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.

Colossians 1:9-10 9 We have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of his desire in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, 10 so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him.

Hebrews 1:1-2 1 Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets. 2 But in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.

1 John 5:20 20 We know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Messiah. He is the true God and eternal life.

Jeremiah 9:23-24 23 Thus says Yahweh: Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, 24 but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am Yahweh who practices loyal love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares Yahweh.

Matthew 11:27 27 No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.

John 1:18 18 No one has ever seen God. The only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.

John 14:7 7 If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him.

John 15:15 15 No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing. But I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you.

John 16:13-15 13 When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth. For he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. 14 He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you. 15 All that the Father has is mine. Therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

John 17:3 3 This is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Messiah whom you have sent.

Romans 1:19-21 19 What can be known about God is plain to [men], because God has shown it to them. 20 For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse. 21 For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

1 Corinthians 13:12 12 Now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part. Then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.

Galatians 4:9 9 Now that you have come to know God, or rather to be known by God, how can you turn back again to the weak and worthless elementary principles of the world, whose slaves you want to be once more?

Philippians 3:8-15 8 I [Paul] count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Messiah Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Messiah 9 and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Messiah, the righteousness from God that depends on faith— 10 that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, 11 that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead. 12 Not that I have already obtained this or am already complete, but I press on to make it my own, because Messiah Jesus has made me his own. 13 Brothers and sisters, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Messiah Jesus. 15 Let those of us who are mature think this way, and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal that also to you. 16 Only let us hold true to what we have attained.

Colossians 1:9-10 9 We have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of [God's] desire in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, 10 so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God.

Colossians 1:25-28 25 Of [the church] I [Paul] became a minister according to the stewardship from God that was given to me for you, to make the word of God fully known, 26 the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints. 27 To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this

mystery, which is Messiah in you, the hope of glory. 28 Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Messiah.

Hebrews 8:10-11 10 This is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my laws into their minds and write them on their hearts, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. 11 And they shall not teach, each one his neighbor and each one his brother saying, Know the Lord, for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest.

2 Peter 1:2-3 2 May grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. 3 His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence.

1 John 2:3 3 By this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments.

1 John 2:13 13 I am writing to you, fathers, because you know him who is from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because you have overcome the evil one. I write to you, children, because you know the Father.

1 John 4:8 8 Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love.

1 John 5:20 20 We know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true. And we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Messiah. He is the true God and eternal life.
