

## ***VERSES ON MESSIANIC PROPHECY***

**Matthew 26:53-56** 53 Do you think that I [Jesus] cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of angels? 54 But how then should the Scriptures be fulfilled, that it must be so? 55 At that hour Jesus said to the crowds, Have you come out as against a robber, with swords and clubs to capture me? Day after day I sat in the temple teaching, and you did not seize me. 56 But all this has taken place that the Scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled.

**Luke 4:20-21** 20 ...[Jesus] rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant, and sat down. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. 21 And he began to say to them, Today this Scripture [Isaiah 61:1-2] has been fulfilled in your hearing.

**Luke 18:31-33** 31 ...Taking the twelve, [Jesus] said to them, See, we are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written about the Son of Man by the prophets will be accomplished. 32 For he will be delivered over to the Gentiles and will be mocked, shamefully treated, and spit upon. 33 And after flogging him, they will kill him, and on the third day he will rise.

**Luke 22:37** 37 ...I [Jesus] tell you [disciples] that this Scripture must be fulfilled in me: And he was numbered with the transgressors. For what is written about me has its fulfillment.

**Luke 24:25-27** 25 [Jesus] said to [the two disciples], O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! 26 Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and enter into his glory? 27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the [Old Testament] Scriptures the things concerning himself.

**Luke 24:32** 32 [The disciples] said to each other, Did not our hearts burn within us while he [Jesus] talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the [Old Testament] Scriptures?

**Luke 24:44-47** 44 Then [Jesus] said to [the disciples], These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the Torah of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms must be fulfilled. 45 Then he opened their minds to understand the [Old Testament] Scriptures. 46 And said to them, Thus it is written that the Messiah should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, 47 and that a change of heart for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem.

**John 1:45** 45 Philip found Nathanael and said to him, We have found him of whom Moses in the Torah and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

**John 5:39** 39 You [Jewish leaders] search the [Old Testament] Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life, and it is they that testify about me [Jesus].

**John 5:45-46** 45 Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father. There is one who accuses you: Moses, on whom you have set your hope. 46 For if you believed Moses, you would believe me, for he wrote of me [Jesus].

**John 12:16** 16 [Jesus'] disciples did not understand these things at first, but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written about him [in the Old Testament] and had been done to him.

**Acts 3:24** 24 ...All the prophets who have spoken, from Samuel and those who came after him, also proclaimed these days [of Messiah].

**Acts 26:22-23** 22 ...I [Paul] stand here testifying both to small and great, saying nothing but what the prophets and Moses said would come to pass: 23 that the Messiah must suffer and that, by being the first to rise from the dead, he would proclaim light both to our people and to the Gentiles.

**1 Corinthians 15:3-4** 3 ...I [Paul] delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Messiah died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures....

**1 Peter 1:10-12** 10 Concerning this salvation, the [Old Testament] prophets who prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and inquired carefully, 11 inquiring what person or time the Spirit of Messiah in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Messiah and the subsequent glories. 12 It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you....
