

VERSES ON OBEDIENCE

Genesis 6:22 22 Noah did this. He did all that God commanded him.

Genesis 12:4 4 So Abram went, as Yahweh had told him....

Genesis 22:15-19 15 ...The angel of Yahweh called to Abraham a second time from heaven 16 and said, By myself I have sworn, declares Yahweh, because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your only son, 17 I will surely bless you, and I will surely multiply your seed as the stars of heaven and as the sand that is on the seashore. And your seed shall possess the gate of his enemies, 18 and in your seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed, because you have obeyed my voice.

Exodus 7:6 6 Moses and Aaron did so. They did just as Yahweh commanded them.

Exodus 15:26 26 ...If you will diligently listen to the voice of Yahweh your God, do that which is right in his eyes, give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am Yahweh, your healer.

Exodus 16:4 4 ...Yahweh said to Moses, Behold, I am about to rain bread from heaven for you, and the people shall go out and gather a day's portion every day, that I may test them, whether they will walk in my law or not.

Exodus 16:28 28 ...How long will you [Israel] refuse to keep my commandments and my laws?

Exodus 19:4-6 4 You [Israel] yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself. 5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine. 6 And you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.

Exodus 26:30 30 ...You shall erect the tabernacle according to the plan for it that you were shown on the mountain.

Exodus 39:42-43 42 According to all that Yahweh had commanded Moses, so the people of Israel had done all the work. 43 And Moses saw all the work, and behold, they had done it. As Yahweh had commanded, so had they done it. Then Moses blessed them.

Exodus 40:16 16 This Moses did. According to all that the Lord commanded him, so he did.

Leviticus 8:36 36 ...Aaron and his sons did all the things that Yahweh commanded by Moses.

Leviticus 18:4-5 4 You shall follow my rules, keep my statutes, and walk in them. I am Yahweh your God. 5 You shall therefore keep my statutes and my rules. If a person does them, he shall live by them. I am Yahweh.

Deuteronomy 4:1-2 1 ...Now, Israel, listen to the statutes and the rules that I am teaching you and do them, that you may live, go in, and take possession of the land that Yahweh, the God of your fathers, is giving you. 2 You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of Yahweh your God that I command you.

Deuteronomy 4:5-8 5 See, I [Moses] have taught you statutes and rules, as Yahweh my God commanded me, that you should do them in the land that you are entering to take possession of it. 6 Keep them and do them, for that will be your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples....

Deuteronomy 5:1 1 ...Hear, Israel, the statutes and the rules that I [Moses] speak in your hearing today. And you shall learn them and be careful to do them.

Deuteronomy 5:32-33 32 You shall be careful...to do as Yahweh your God has commanded you. You shall not turn aside to the right hand or to the left. 33 You shall walk in all the way that Yahweh your God has commanded you, that you may live, that it may go well with you, and that you may live long in the land that you shall possess.

Deuteronomy 10:12-13 12 ...Now, Israel, what does Yahweh your God require of you, but to fear Yahweh your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve Yahweh your God with all your heart and with all your soul, 13 and to keep the commandments and statutes of Yahweh, which I am commanding you today for your good?

Deuteronomy 11:26-28 26 ...I am setting before you today a blessing and a curse: 27 the blessing, if you obey the commandments of Yahweh your God that I command you today, 28 and the curse, if you do not obey the commandments of Yahweh your God, but turn aside from the way that I am commanding you today, to go after other gods that you have not known.

Deuteronomy 12:28-32 28 Be careful to obey all these words that I command you, that it may go well with you and with your children after you forever, when you do what is good and right in the sight of Yahweh your God. ...32 Everything that I command you, you shall be careful to do. You shall not add to it or take from it.

Deuteronomy 13:3-4 3 ...Yahweh your God is testing you, to know whether you love Yahweh your God with all your heart and with all your soul. 4 You shall walk after Yahweh your God, fear him, keep his commandments, and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him.

Deuteronomy 26:16 16 This day Yahweh your God commands you [Israel] to do these statutes and rules. You shall therefore be careful to do them with all your heart and with all your soul.

Deuteronomy 27:9-10 9 ...Moses and the Levitical priests said to all Israel, Keep silence and hear, Israel. This day you have become the people of Yahweh your God. 10 You shall therefore obey the voice of Yahweh your God, keeping his commandments and his statutes that I command you today.

Deuteronomy 27:26 26 Cursed be anyone who does not confirm the words of this law by doing them. And all the people [Israel] shall say, Amen.

Deuteronomy 28:1-2 1 ...If you faithfully obey the voice of Yahweh your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, Yahweh your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. 2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of Yahweh your God.

Deuteronomy 28:15 15 ...If you will not obey the voice of Yahweh your God or be careful to do all his commandments and his statutes that I command you today, then all these curses shall come upon you and overtake you.

Deuteronomy 30:11-14 11 ...This commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off. 12 It is not in heaven, that you should say, Who will ascend to heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it? 13 Neither is it beyond the sea, that you should say, Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it? 14 But the word is very near you. It is in your mouth and in your heart, so that you can do it.

Joshua 1:7-8 7 ...Be strong and very courageous, being careful to do according to all the law that Moses my servant commanded you. Do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may have good success wherever you go. 8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

Joshua 11:15 15 Just as Yahweh had commanded Moses his servant, so Moses commanded Joshua, and so Joshua did. He left nothing undone of all that Yahweh had commanded Moses.

Joshua 22:5 5 ...Be very careful to observe the commandment and the law that Moses the servant of Yahweh commanded you, to love Yahweh your God, to walk in all his ways, to keep his commandments, to cling to him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul.

Joshua 24:23-24 23 [Joshua] said, Then put away the foreign gods that are among you and incline your heart to Yahweh, the God of Israel. 24 And the people [Israel] said to Joshua, Yahweh our God we will serve, and his voice we will obey.

Judges 6:8-10 8 ...Thus says Yahweh, the God of Israel: I led you up from Egypt and brought you out of the house of slavery. 9 And I delivered you from the hand of the Egyptians and from the hand of all who oppressed you, drove them out before you, and gave you their land. 10 And I said to you, I am Yahweh your God. You shall not fear the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But you have not obeyed my voice.

1 Samuel 15:22-23 22 ...Samuel said, Has Yahweh as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of Yahweh? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to listen than the fat of rams. 23 For rebellion is as the sin of divination, and presumption is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of Yahweh, he has also rejected you [Saul] from being king.

1 Samuel 15:10-26 10 The word of Yahweh came to Samuel: 11 I regret that I have made Saul king, for he has turned back from following me and has not performed my commandments. And Samuel was angry, and he cried to Yahweh all night. 12 And Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning. And it was told Samuel, Saul came to Carmel, and behold, he set up a monument for himself and turned and passed on and went down to Gilgal. 13 And Samuel came to Saul, and Saul said to him, Blessed be you to Yahweh. I have performed the commandment of Yahweh. 14 And Samuel said, What then is this bleating of the sheep in my ears and the lowing of the oxen that I hear? 15 Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites, for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen to sacrifice to Yahweh your God, and the rest we have devoted to destruction. 16 Then Samuel said to Saul, Stop! I will tell you what Yahweh said to me this night. And he said to him, Speak. 17 And Samuel said, Though you are little in your own eyes, are you not the head of the tribes of Israel? Yahweh anointed you king over Israel. 18 And Yahweh sent you on a mission and said, Go, devote to destruction the sinners, the Amalekites, and fight against them until they are consumed. 19 Why then did you not obey the voice of Yahweh? Why did you pounce on the spoil and do what was evil in the sight of Yahweh? 20 And Saul said to Samuel, I have obeyed the voice of Yahweh. I have gone on the mission on which Yahweh sent me. I have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and I have devoted the Amalekites to destruction. 21 But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the best of the things devoted to destruction, to sacrifice to Yahweh your God in Gilgal. 22 And Samuel said, Has Yahweh as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of Yahweh? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to listen than the fat of rams. 23 For rebellion is as the sin of divination, and presumption is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of Yahweh, he has also rejected you from being king. 24 Saul said to Samuel, I have sinned, for I have transgressed the commandment of Yahweh and your words, because I feared the people and obeyed their voice. 25 Now therefore, please pardon my sin and return with me that I may bow before Yahweh. 26 And Samuel said to Saul, I will not return with you. For you have rejected the word of Yahweh, and Yahweh has rejected you from being king over Israel.

Psalms 40:6-8 6 In sacrifice and offering you have not delighted, but you have given me an open ear. Burnt offering and sin offering you have not required. 7 Then I said, Behold, I have

come. In the scroll of the book it is written of me. 8 I delight to do your desire, my God. Your law is within my heart.

Psalm 51:16-17 16 ...You will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it. You will not be pleased with a burnt offering. 17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit. A broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Psalm 103:20-21 20 Bless Yahweh, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word! 21 Bless Yahweh, all his hosts, his ministers, who do his desire!

Psalm 119:56 56 This blessing has fallen to me, that I have kept your precepts.

Psalm 119:60 60 I hasten and do not delay to keep your commandments.

Psalm 119:112 112 I incline my heart to perform your statutes forever, to the end.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 13 The end of the matter. All has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man.

Isaiah 1:11-15 11 What to me is the multitude of your sacrifices? says Yahweh. I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams and the fat of well-fed beasts. I do not delight in the blood of bulls, of lambs, or of goats. 12 When you come to appear before me, who has required of you this trampling of my courts? 13 Bring no more vain offerings. Incense is an abomination to me. New moon and Sabbath and the calling of convocations—I cannot endure iniquity and solemn assembly. 14 Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hates. They have become a burden to me. I am weary of bearing them. 15 When you spread out your hands, I will hide my eyes from you. Even though you make many prayers, I will not listen. Your hands are full of blood.

Jeremiah 7:22-23 22 ...In the day that I brought [Israel] out of the land of Egypt, I did not speak to your fathers or command them concerning burnt offerings and sacrifices. 23 But this command I gave them: Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be my people. And walk in all the way that I command you, that it may be well with you.

Micah 6:6-8 6 With what shall I come before Yahweh and bow myself before God on high? Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves a year old? 7 Will Yahweh be pleased with thousands of rams, with ten thousands of rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul? 8 He has told you, O man, what is good. And what does Yahweh require of you but to do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?

Matthew 6:24 24 No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money.

Matthew 23:23 23 Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint, dill, and cumin but have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice, mercy, and faithfulness. These you ought to have done, without neglecting the others.

Mark 14:36 36 ...Abba, Father, all things are possible for you. Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I desire, but what you desire.

Luke 6:46-49 46 Why do you call me Lord, Lord, and not do what I tell you? 47 Everyone who comes to me and hears my words and does them, I will show you what he is like. 48 He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. 49 But the one who hears and does not do them is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great.

Luke 8:19-21 19 ...[Jesus'] mother and his brothers came to him, but they could not reach him because of the crowd. 20 And he was told, Your mother and your brothers are standing outside, desiring to see you. 21 But he answered them, My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and do it.

Luke 11:27-28 27 ...A woman in the crowd raised her voice and said to him, Blessed is the womb that bore you, and the breasts at which you nursed! 28 But he said, Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and keep it!

Luke 17:7-10 7 Will any one of you who has a servant plowing or keeping sheep say to him when he has come in from the field, Come at once and recline at table? 8 Will he not rather say to him, Prepare supper for me, dress properly, and serve me while I eat and drink, and afterward you will eat and drink? 9 Does he thank the servant because he did what was commanded? 10 So you also, when you have done all that you were commanded, say, We are unworthy servants. We have only done what was our duty.

John 4:34 34 My food is to do the desire of [the Father] who sent me and to accomplish his work.

John 7:17 17 If anyone's desire is to do God's desire, he will know whether the teaching is from God or whether I [Jesus] am speaking on my own authority.

John 8:29 29 ...He who sent me [the Father] is with me [Jesus]. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him.

John 14:15-17 15 If you love me, you will keep my commandments. 16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, 17 even the Spirit of truth....

John 14:21 21 Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him.

John 14:23-24 23 ...If anyone loves me [Jesus], he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. 24 Whoever does not love me does not keep my words.

John 14:31 31 ...I [Jesus] do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father.

John 15:10-11 10 If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

John 15:14 14 You are my friends if you do what I command you.

Acts 5:29 29 ...Peter and the apostles answered, We must obey God rather than men.

Romans 1:5 5 ...We have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his name among all the nations....

Romans 5:19 19 ...As by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous.

Romans 16:26 26 ...To bring about the obedience of faith....

Galatians 1:10 10 ...Am I [Paul] now seeking the approval of man or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Messiah.

1 Corinthians 7:19 19 ...Neither circumcision counts for anything nor uncircumcision, but keeping the commandments of God.

Philippians 2:8 8 ...[Jesus] humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Philippians 2:12-13 12 ...As you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, 13 for it is God who works in you, both to desire and to work for his good pleasure.

Hebrews 10:7 7 ...I [Jesus] said, Behold, I have come to do your desire, O God, as it is written of me in the scroll of the book.

James 1:22-25 22 ...Be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. 23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. 24 For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. 25 But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing.

James 4:17 17 ...Whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin.

1 Peter 1:1-2 1 Peter, an apostle of Jesus Messiah, to those who are elect exiles of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, 2 according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in the sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Messiah and for sprinkling with his blood....

1 Peter 1:22 22 Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart....

1 John 2:3-6 3 ...By this we know that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments. 4 Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him. 5 But whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. By this we may know that we are in him: 6 whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.

1 John 5:2-3 2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments. 3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome.
