

VERSES ON RESURRECTION

Job 14:10-17 10 ...A man dies and is laid low. Man breathes his last, and where is he? 11 As waters fail from a lake and a river wastes away and dries up, 12 so a man lies down and rises not again. Till the heavens are no more he will not awake or be roused out of his sleep. 13 Oh that you would hide me [Job] in Sheol, that you would conceal me until your wrath be past, that you would appoint me a set time and remember me! 14 If a man dies, shall he live again? All the days of my service I would wait, till my renewal should come. 15 You would call, and I would answer you. You would long for the work of your hands. 16 For then you would number my steps. You would not keep watch over my sin. 17 My transgression would be sealed up in a bag, and you would cover over my iniquity.

Job 19:23-27 23 Oh that my words were written! Oh that they were inscribed in a book! 24 Oh that with an iron pen and lead they were engraved in the rock forever! 25 For I [Job] know that my Redeemer lives, and at the last he will stand upon the earth. 26 And after my skin has been thus destroyed, yet in my flesh I shall see God, 27 whom I shall see for myself, and my eyes shall behold, and not another. My heart faints within me!

Job 33:22-30 22 [Man's] soul draws near the pit, and his life to those who bring death. 23 If there be for him an angel, a mediator, one of the thousand, to declare to man what is right for him, 24 and he is merciful to him and says, Deliver him from going down into the pit. I have found a ransom. 25 Let his flesh become fresh with youth. Let him return to the days of his youthful vigour. 26 Then man prays to God, and he accepts him. He sees his face with a shout of joy, and he restores to man his righteousness. 27 He sings before men and says: I sinned and perverted what was right, and it was not repaid to me. 28 He has redeemed my soul from going down into the pit, and my life shall look upon the light. 29 Behold, God does all these things, twice, three times, with a man, 30 to bring back his soul from the pit, that he may be lighted with the light of life [Elihu].

Psalms 17:15 15 As for me, I [David] will behold your face in righteousness. When I awake, I will be satisfied with your likeness.

Psalms 49:14-15 14 Like sheep they are appointed for Sheol. Death will be their shepherd, and the upright will rule over them in the morning. Their form will be consumed in Sheol, with no place to dwell. 15 But God will ransom my soul from the power of Sheol, for he will receive me.

Psalms 71:20-21 20 You who have made me see many troubles and calamities will revive me again. From the depths of the earth you will bring me up again. 21 You will increase my greatness and comfort me again.

Isaiah 26:19 19 Your dead will live. Their bodies will rise. You who dwell in the dust, awake and sing for joy! For your dew is a dew of light, and the earth will give birth to the dead.

Ezekiel 37:1-14 1 The hand of Yahweh was upon me [Ezekiel], and he brought me out in the Spirit of Yahweh and set me down in the middle of the valley. It was full of bones. 2 And he

led me around among them, and behold, there were very many on the surface of the valley, and behold, they were very dry. 3 And he said to me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, Lord Yahweh, you know. 4 Then he said to me, Prophecy over these bones, and say to them, dry bones, hear the word of Yahweh. 5 Thus says Lord Yahweh to these bones: Behold, I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live. 6 And I will lay sinews upon you, and will cause flesh to come upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and you shall live, and you shall know that I am Yahweh. 7 So I prophesied as I was commanded. And as I prophesied, there was a sound, and behold, a rattling, and the bones came together, bone to its bone. 8 And I looked, and behold, there were sinews on them, and flesh had come upon them, and skin had covered them. But there was no breath in them. 9 Then he said to me, Prophecy to the Spirit (רוּחַ). Prophecy, son of man, and say to the Spirit (רוּחַ), Thus says Lord Yahweh: Come from the four winds, O Spirit, and breathe on these slain, that they may live. 10 So I prophesied as he commanded me, and the Spirit (רוּחַ) came into them, and they lived and stood on their feet, an exceedingly great army. 11 Then he said to me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. Behold, they say, Our bones are dried up, and our hope is lost. We are indeed cut off. 12 Therefore prophecy and say to them, Thus says Lord Yahweh: Behold, I will open your graves and raise you from your graves, my people. And I will bring you into the land of Israel. 13 And you shall know that I am Yahweh, when I open your graves, and raise you from your graves, my people. 14 And I will put my Spirit (רוּחַ) within you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I am Yahweh. I have spoken, and I will do it, declares Yahweh.

Daniel 12:2 2 Many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth will awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

Matthew 22:23 23 The same day Sadducees came to [Jesus], who say that there is no resurrection, and they asked him a question....

Matthew 22:30-32 30 For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven. 31 And as for the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was said to you by God: 32 I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? He is not God of the dead, but of the living.

Matthew 27:52-53 52 The tombs also were opened. And many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised, 53 and coming out of the tombs after [Jesus'] resurrection they went into the holy city and appeared to many.

Luke 14:14 14 ... You will be blessed, because they cannot repay you. For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the just.

Luke 20:35-38 35 Those who are considered worthy to attain to that age and to the resurrection from the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage, 36 for they cannot die anymore, because they are equal to angels and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection. 37 But that the dead are raised, even Moses showed, in the passage about the bush, where he calls the Lord the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. 38 Now he is not God of the dead, but of the living, for all live to him.

John 5:21 21 ...As the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so also the Son gives life to whom he desires.

John 5:25-29 25 Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and is now here, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live. 26 For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son also to have life in himself. ...28 Do not marvel at this, for an hour is coming when all who are in the tombs will hear his voice 29 and come out, those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil to the resurrection of judgment.

John 6:39-40 39 ...This is the desire of [the Father] who sent me [Jesus], that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day. 40 For this is the desire of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

John 6:44 44 No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day.

John 6:54 54 Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

John 11:25-26 25 Jesus said to [Martha], I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, 26 and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?

Acts 4:1-2 1 ...As [the apostles] were speaking to the people, the priests, the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees came upon them, 2 greatly annoyed because they were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead.

Acts 24:14-15 14 I [Paul] worship the God of our fathers, believing everything laid down by the Law and written in the Prophets, 15 having a hope in God...that there will be a resurrection of both the just and the unjust.

Acts 26:8 8 Why is it thought incredible by any of you that God raises the dead?

Romans 6:4-13 4 We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Messiah was *raised* from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. 5 For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a *resurrection* like his. ...8 Now if we have died with Messiah, we believe that we will also *live* with him. 9 We know that Messiah, being *raised* from the dead, will never die again. Death no longer has dominion over him. 10 For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the *life* he *lives* he *lives* to God. 11 So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and *alive* to God in Messiah Jesus. 12 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. 13 Do not present your members to sin as

instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to *life*, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.

1 Corinthians 6:14 14 God *raised* the Lord [Jesus] and will also *raise* us up by his power.

1 Corinthians 15:12-19 12 Now if Messiah is proclaimed as *raised* from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no *resurrection* of the dead? 13 But if there is no *resurrection* of the dead, then not even Messiah has been *raised*. 14 And if Messiah has not been *raised*, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain. 15 We are even found to be misrepresenting God, because we testified about God that he *raised* Messiah, whom he did not *raise* if it is true that the dead are not *raised*. 16 For if the dead are not *raised*, not even Messiah has been *raised*. 17 And if Messiah has not been *raised*, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. 18 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Messiah have perished. 19 If in Messiah we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied.

1 Corinthians 15:20-26 20 But in fact Messiah has been *raised* from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. 21 For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the *resurrection* of the dead. 22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Messiah shall all be made *alive*. 23 But each in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits, then at his [second] coming those who belong to Messiah.

1 Corinthians 15:30-32 30 Why are we in danger every hour? 31 I protest, brothers and sisters, by my pride in you, which I have in Messiah Jesus our Lord, I die every day! 32 What do I gain if, humanly speaking, I fought with beasts at Ephesus? If the dead are not *raised*, Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die.

1 Corinthians 15:35-49 35 But someone will ask, How are the dead *raised*? With what kind of body do they come? 36 You foolish person! What you sow does not come to life unless it dies. 37 And what you sow is not the body that is to be, but a bare kernel, perhaps of wheat or of some other grain. 38 But God gives it a body as he has chosen, and to each kind of seed its own body. 39 For not all flesh is the same, but there is one kind for humans, another for animals, another for birds, and another for fish. 40 There are heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the glory of the heavenly is of one kind, and the glory of the earthly is of another. 41 There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars, for star differs from star in glory. 42 So is it with the *resurrection* of the dead. What is sown is perishable. What is *raised* is imperishable. 43 It is sown in dishonour. It is *raised* in glory. It is sown in weakness. It is *raised* in power. 44 It is sown a natural body. It is *raised* a spiritual body. If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. 45 Thus it is written, The first man Adam became a living being. The last Adam became a life-giving spirit. 46 But it is not the spiritual that is first but the natural, and then the spiritual. 47 The first man was from the earth, a man of dust. The second man is from heaven. 48 As was the man of dust, so also are those who are of the dust, and as is the man of heaven, so also are those who are of heaven. 49 Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven.

1 Corinthians 15:50-57 50 I tell you this, brothers and sisters: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. 51 Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. 53 For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. 54 When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written: Death is swallowed up in victory. 55 O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting? 56 The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the Torah. 57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Messiah.

Philippians 3:20-21 20 Our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Saviour, the Lord Jesus Messiah, 21 who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.

Colossians 2:12-15 12 ...Having been buried with [Jesus] in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead. 13 And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses.... 15 [God] disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in [Jesus].

Colossians 3:1 1 If then you have been raised with Messiah [and you have], seek the things that are above, where Messiah is, seated at the right hand of God.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 13 ...We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. 14 For because we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep. 15 For this we declare to you by a word from the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. 16 For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Messiah will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore encourage one another with these words.

2 Timothy 2:11 11 If we have died with him, we will also live with him.

1 John 3:2 2 Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared. But we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is.

Revelation 11:11 11 But after the three and a half days a breath of life from God entered [the two witnesses], and they stood up on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them.

Revelation 20:4-6 4 ...I [John] saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to *life* and reigned with Messiah for a thousand years. 5 The rest of the dead did not come to *life* until the thousand years were ended. This is the first *resurrection*. 6 Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first *resurrection*! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Messiah, and they will reign with him for a thousand years.

Revelation 21:3-5 3 ...I [John] heard a loud voice from the throne saying, Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. 4 He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away. 5 And he who was seated on the throne said, Behold, I am making all things new.
