

VERSES ON SOUL

Genesis 1:21 21 God created the great sea creatures and every living soul (נַפְשֵׁי הַחַיָּוִיִּם) that moves, with which the waters swarm, according to their kinds, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:24 24 God said, Let the earth bring forth living souls (נַפְשֵׁי הַחַיָּוִיִּם) according to their kinds—livestock, creeping things, and beasts of the earth according to their kinds. And it was so.

Genesis 2:7 7 Yahweh God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living soul (נַפְשֵׁי חַיָּוִי).

Genesis 2:19 19 Out of the ground Yahweh God had formed every beast of the field and every bird of the heavens and brought them to the man to see what he would call them. And whatever the man called every living soul (נַפְשֵׁי חַיָּוִי), that was its name.¹

Genesis 9:4-5 4 You shall not eat flesh with its soul (נַפְשֵׁי), that is, its blood. 5 And for your lifeblood (אֲדָמַתְךָ לְנַפְשֵׁי חַיָּוִיִּם) I will require a reckoning. From every beast I will require it and from man. From his fellow man I will require a reckoning for the soul (נַפְשֵׁי) of man.

Genesis 9:15-16 15 I will remember my covenant that is between me and you and every living soul (נַפְשֵׁי חַיָּוִי) of all flesh. And the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh. 16 When the bow is in the clouds, I will see it and remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living soul (נַפְשֵׁי חַיָּוִי) of all flesh that is on the earth.

Genesis 12:5 5 Abram took Sarai his wife, Lot his brother's son, all their possessions that they had gathered, and the souls (נַפְשֵׁי) that they had acquired in Haran, and they set out to go to the land of Canaan.

Genesis 14:21 21 The king of Sodom said to Abram, Give me the souls (נַפְשֵׁי), but take the goods for yourself.²

Genesis 19:17 17 Escape for your soul (נַפְשֵׁי). Do not look back or stop anywhere in the valley. Escape to the hills, lest you be swept away.

Genesis 32:30 30 Jacob called the name of the place Peniel saying, For I have seen God face to face, and yet my soul (נַפְשֵׁי) has been delivered.

Genesis 35:18 18 As [Rachel's] soul (נַפְשֵׁי) was departing (for she was dying), she called his name Ben-oni.

Genesis 44:30 30 [Jacob's] soul (נַפְשֵׁי) is bound up in the boy's [Benjamin's] soul (נַפְשֵׁי).

Genesis 46:26-27 26 All the persons belonging to Jacob who came into Egypt, who were his own descendants, not including Jacob's sons' wives, were sixty-six souls (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) in all. 27 And the sons of Joseph, who were born to him in Egypt, were two. All the souls (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) of the house of Jacob who came into Egypt were seventy.

Exodus 21:23-25 23 If there is harm, then you shall pay soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) for soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם), 24 eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, 25 burn for burn, wound for wound, stripe for stripe.

Exodus 23:9 9 You shall not oppress a sojourner. You know the soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) of a sojourner, for you were sojourners in the land of Egypt.

Exodus 30:12-15 12 When you take the census of the people of Israel, then each shall give a ransom for his soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) to Yahweh when you number them, that there be no plague among them when you number them. ... 15 The rich shall not give more, and the poor shall not give less, than the half shekel, when you give Yahweh's offering to make atonement for your souls (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם).

Leviticus 17:10-12 10 If any one of the house of Israel or of the strangers who sojourn among them eats any blood, I will set my face against that person who eats blood and will cut him off from among his people. 11 For the soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) of the flesh (בְּשָׂרָה) is in the blood (דָּם), and I have given it for you on the altar to make atonement for your souls (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם), for it is the blood that makes atonement by the soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם). 12 Therefore I have said to the people of Israel, No person among you shall eat blood, neither shall any stranger who sojourns among you eat blood.

Leviticus 24:17-18 17 Whoever takes a human soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) shall surely be put to death. 18 Whoever takes an animal's soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) shall make it good, soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) for soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם).

Leviticus 26:11 11 I [Yahweh] will make my dwelling among you [Israel], and my soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) shall not abhor you.

Leviticus 26:15 15 If you spurn my statutes, and if your soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) abhors my rules, so that you will not do all my commandments, but break my covenant....

Leviticus 26:30 30 I will destroy your high places, cut down your incense altars, and cast your dead bodies upon the dead bodies of your idols, and my soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) will abhor you.

Numbers 15:30-31 30 The soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) who does anything with a high hand, whether he is native or a sojourner, reviles Yahweh, and that soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) shall be cut off from among his people. 31 Because he has despised the word of Yahweh and has broken his commandment, that soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) shall be utterly cut off. His iniquity shall be on him.

Deuteronomy 4:9 9 Only take care and keep your soul (שׂוֹפְרֹתַיִם) diligently, lest you forget the things that your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life.

Deuteronomy 4:29 29 From there [exile] you [Israel] will seek Yahweh your God, and you will find him, if you search after him with all your heart and with all your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ).

Deuteronomy 6:5 5 You shall love Yahweh your God with all your heart, with all your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ), and with all your might.

Deuteronomy 10:12 12 Now, Israel, what does Yahweh your God require of you but to fear Yahweh your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve Yahweh your God with all your heart and with all your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ).

Deuteronomy 11:18 18 You shall therefore lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ), and you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes.

Deuteronomy 26:16 16 This day Yahweh your God commands you to do these statutes and rules. You shall therefore be careful to do them with all your heart and with all your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ).

Deuteronomy 30:6 6 Yahweh your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your seed, so that you will love Yahweh your God with all your heart and with all your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ), that you may live.

Joshua 11:11 11 They struck with the sword all the souls (שׁוֹרֵץ) who were in it, devoting them to destruction; there was none left that breathed. And he burned Hazor with fire.

Joshua 22:5 5 Be very careful to observe the commandment and the law that Moses the servant of Yahweh commanded you, to love Yahweh your God, to walk in all his ways, to keep his commandments, to cling to him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ).

Joshua 23:14 14 I am about to go the way of all the earth, and you know in your hearts and souls (שׁוֹרֵץ), all of you, that not one word has failed of all the good things that Yahweh your God promised concerning you. All have come to pass for you; not one of them has failed.

Judges 5:21 21 March on, my soul (שׁוֹרֵץ), with might!

Ruth 4:15 15 He [Obed] shall be to you [Naomi] a restorer of your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) and a nourisher of your old age, for your daughter-in-law [Ruth] who loves you, who is more to you than seven sons, has given birth to him.

1 Samuel 1:15 15 Hannah answered, No, my lord [Eli], I am a woman troubled in spirit. I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but I have been pouring out my soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) before Yahweh.

1 Samuel 2:35 35 I [Yahweh] will raise up for myself a faithful priest, who shall do according to what is in my heart and in my soul (שׁוֹרֵף). And I will build him a sure house, and he shall go in and out before my anointed forever.

1 Samuel 18:1-3 1 The soul (שׁוֹרֵף) of Jonathan was knit to the soul (שׁוֹרֵף) of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul (שׁוֹרֵף). ...3 Then Jonathan made a covenant with David, because he loved him as his own soul (שׁוֹרֵף).

1 Samuel 19:5 5 [David] took his soul (שׁוֹרֵף) in his hand, he struck down the Philistine, and Yahweh worked a great salvation for all Israel. You saw it and rejoiced. Why then will you [Saul] sin against innocent blood by killing David without cause?

1 Samuel 20:17 17 Jonathan made David swear again by his love for him, for he loved him as he loved his own soul (שׁוֹרֵף).

1 Samuel 25:29 29 If men rise up to pursue you [David] and to seek your soul (שׁוֹרֵף), the soul (שׁוֹרֵף) of my lord shall be bound in the bundle of the living in the care of the Lord your God. And the souls (שׁוֹרֵף) of your enemies he shall sling out as from the hollow of a sling.

1 Samuel 26:24 24 As your [Saul's] soul (שׁוֹרֵף) was precious this day in my [David's] sight, so may my soul (שׁוֹרֵף) be precious in the sight of Yahweh, and may he deliver me out of all tribulation.

2 Samuel 4:9 9 Yahweh...has redeemed my [David's] soul (שׁוֹרֵף) out of every adversity,

2 Samuel 14:14 14 We must all die. We are like water spilled on the ground that cannot be gathered up again. But God will not take away the soul (שׁוֹרֵף), but he devises means so that the banished one will not remain an outcast.

2 Samuel 23:17 17 Shall I [David] drink the blood of the men who went at the risk of their souls (שׁוֹרֵף)? Therefore he would not drink [the water]. These things the three mighty men did.

1 Kings 2:4 4 If your sons pay close attention to their way, to walk before me in faithfulness with all their heart and with all their soul (שׁוֹרֵף), you [David] shall not lack a man on the throne of Israel.

1 Kings 8:48 48 If they [the Israelites] repent with all their heart and with all their soul (שׁוֹרֵף) in the land of their enemies who carried them captive, and pray to you toward their land that you gave to their fathers, the city that you have chosen, and the house that I have built for your name....

2 Kings 23:25 25 Before [Josiah] there was no king like him, who turned to Yahweh with all his heart, with all his soul (שׁוֹרֵף), and with all his might, according to all the Law of Moses, nor did any like him arise after him.

1 Chronicles 22:19 19 Now set your heart and soul (שׁוֹנֵה) to seek Yahweh your God. Arise and build the sanctuary of Yahweh God, so that the ark of the covenant of Yahweh and the holy vessels of God may be brought into a house built for the name of Yahweh.

Esther 8:11 11 The king allowed the Jews who were in every city to gather and defend their souls (שׁוֹנֵה), to destroy, to kill, and to annihilate any armed force of any people or province that might attack them, children and women included.

Job 2:6 6 Yahweh said to Satan, Behold, [Job] is in your hand. Only spare his soul (שׁוֹנֵה).

Job 7:11 11 I [Job] will not restrain my mouth. I will speak in the anguish of my spirit (רוּחִי). I will complain in the bitterness of my soul (שׁוֹנֵה).

Job 12:10 10 In [God's] hand is the soul (שׁוֹנֵה) of every living thing and the spirit (רוּחִי) of all mankind.

Job 23:13 13 [God] is unchangeable, and who can turn him back? What his soul (שׁוֹנֵה) desires, that he does.

Job 27:8 8 What is the hope of the godless when God cuts him off, when God takes away his soul (שׁוֹנֵה)?

Job 30:25 25 Did not I [Job] weep for him whose day was hard? Was not my soul (שׁוֹנֵה) grieved for the needy?

Psalms 6:3-4 3 My soul (שׁוֹנֵה) also is greatly troubled. But you, Yahweh, how long? 4 Turn, Yahweh, deliver my soul (שׁוֹנֵה). Save me for the sake of your loyal love.

Psalms 11:5 5 Yahweh tests the righteous, but his soul (שׁוֹנֵה) hates the wicked and the one who loves violence.

Psalms 16:10 10 You [Yahweh] will not abandon my [David's] soul (שׁוֹנֵה) to Sheol or let your holy one see corruption.

Psalms 19:7 7 The law of Yahweh is perfect, reviving the soul (שׁוֹנֵה). The testimony of Yahweh is sure, making wise the simple.

Psalms 23:3 3 [Yahweh] restores my soul (שׁוֹנֵה).

Psalms 25:1 1 To you, Yahweh, I lift up my soul (שׁוֹנֵה).

Psalms 25:12-13 12 Who is the man who fears Yahweh? Him will he instruct in the way that he should choose. 13 His soul (שׁוֹנֵה) shall abide in well-being, and his seed shall inherit the land.

Psalm 25:20 20 Oh, guard my soul (שׁוֹנֵן), and deliver me [David]! Let me not be put to shame, for I take refuge in you [Yahweh].

Psalm 30:3 3 Yahweh, you have brought up my soul (שׁוֹנֵן) from Sheol. You restored me to life from among those who go down to the pit.

Psalm 31:9 9 Be gracious to me, Yahweh, for I am in distress. My eye is wasted from grief. My soul (שׁוֹנֵן) and my body also.

Psalm 34:2 2 My soul (שׁוֹנֵן) makes its boast in Yahweh. Let the humble hear and be glad.

Psalm 34:22 22 Yahweh redeems (הִפָּדָה) the soul (שׁוֹנֵן) of his servants. None of those who take refuge in him will be condemned.

Psalm 41:4 4 Yahweh, be gracious to me [David]. Heal my soul (שׁוֹנֵן), for I have sinned against you!

Psalm 42:1-5 1 As a deer pants for flowing streams, so pants my soul (שׁוֹנֵן) for you, God. 2 My soul (שׁוֹנֵן) thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God? 3 My tears have been my food day and night, while they say to me all the day long, Where is your God? 4 These things I remember, as I pour out my soul (שׁוֹנֵן). ...5 Why are you cast down, my soul (שׁוֹנֵן), and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God, for I shall again praise him.

Psalm 49:7-9 7 Truly no man can ransom another, or give to God the price of his life, 8 for the ransom of their soul (שׁוֹנֵן) is costly and can never suffice, 9 that he should live on forever and never see the pit.

Psalm 49:15 15 God will ransom my soul (שׁוֹנֵן) from the power of Sheol, for he will receive me.

Psalm 56:13 13 You have delivered my soul (שׁוֹנֵן) from death, yes, my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the light of life.

Psalm 57:1 1 Be merciful to me, God, be merciful to me, for in you my soul (שׁוֹנֵן) takes refuge. In the shadow of your wings I will take refuge, till the storms of destruction pass by.

Psalm 62:1 1 For God alone my soul (שׁוֹנֵן) waits in silence. From him comes my salvation.

Psalm 63:1 1 God, you are my God. Earnestly I seek you. My soul (שׁוֹנֵן) thirsts for you. My flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.

Psalm 63:5 5 My soul (שׁוֹנֵן) will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips.

Psalm 66:16 16 Come and hear, all you who fear God, and I will tell what he has done for my soul (שׁוֹנֵה).

Psalm 72:13-14 13 [God] has pity on the weak and the needy and saves the souls (שׁוֹנֵה) of the needy. 14 From oppression and violence he redeems their soul (שׁוֹנֵה), and precious is their blood in his sight.

Psalm 84:2 2 My soul (שׁוֹנֵה) longs, yes, faints for the courts of Yahweh. My heart (לֵב) and flesh (בָּשָׂר) sing for joy to the living God.

Psalm 86:13 13 Great is your loyal love toward me. You have delivered my soul (שׁוֹנֵה) from the depths of Sheol.

Psalm 97:10 10 [Yahweh] preserves the souls (שׁוֹנֵה) of his saints. He delivers them from the hand of the wicked.

Psalm 103:1-2 1 Bless Yahweh, my soul (שׁוֹנֵה), and all that is within me, bless his holy name! 2 Bless Yahweh, my soul (שׁוֹנֵה), and forget not all his benefits.

Psalm 107:9 9 [Yahweh] satisfies the longing soul (שׁוֹנֵה), and the hungry soul (שׁוֹנֵה) he fills with good things.

Psalm 116:7-8 7 Return, my soul (שׁוֹנֵה), to your rest, for Yahweh has dealt bountifully with you. 8 For you have delivered my soul (שׁוֹנֵה) from death, my eyes from tears, my feet from stumbling.

Psalm 119:20 20 My soul (שׁוֹנֵה) is consumed with longing for your rules at all times.

Psalm 119:25 25 My soul (שׁוֹנֵה) clings to the dust. Give me life (חַיִּים) according to your word!

Psalm 119:28 28 My soul (שׁוֹנֵה) melts away for sorrow. Strengthen me according to your word!

Psalm 119:81 81 My soul (שׁוֹנֵה) longs for your salvation. I hope in your word.

Psalm 119:167 167 My soul (שׁוֹנֵה) keeps your testimonies. I love them exceedingly.

Psalm 121:7 7 Yahweh will keep you from all evil. He will keep your soul (שׁוֹנֵה).

Psalm 130:5-6 5 I wait for Yahweh, my soul (שׁוֹנֵה) waits, and in his word I hope. 6 My soul (שׁוֹנֵה) waits for Yahweh more than watchmen for the morning, more than watchmen for the morning.

Psalm 131:2 2 I have calmed and quieted my soul (שׁוֹנֵה), like a weaned child with its mother. Like a weaned child is my soul (שׁוֹנֵה) within me.

Psalms 138:3-3 3 On the day I called, you answered me. My strength of soul (שׁוֹרָה) you increased.

Psalms 139:14 14 I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works. My soul (שׁוֹרָה) knows it very well.

Psalms 143:6 6 I stretch out my hands to you. My soul (שׁוֹרָה) thirsts for you like a parched land.

Proverbs 6:16 16 There are six things that Yahweh hates, seven that are an abomination to his soul (שׁוֹרָה).

Proverbs 6:32 32 He who commits adultery lacks sense. He who does it destroys his soul (שׁוֹרָה).

Proverbs 8:36 36 He who fails to find me [wisdom] injures his soul (שׁוֹרָה). All who hate me love death.

Proverbs 11:30 30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and whoever captures souls (שׁוֹרָה) is wise.

Proverbs 12:10 10 Whoever is righteous has regard for the soul (שׁוֹרָה) of his beast, but the mercy of the wicked is cruel.

Proverbs 13:4 4 The soul (שׁוֹרָה) of the sluggard craves and gets nothing, while the soul (שׁוֹרָה) of the diligent is richly supplied.

Proverbs 14:25 25 A truthful witness saves souls (שׁוֹרָה), but one who breathes out lies is deceitful.

Proverbs 16:24 24 Gracious words are like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the body.

Proverbs 21:23 23 Whoever keeps his mouth and his tongue keeps his soul (שׁוֹרָה) out of trouble.

Proverbs 23:13-14 13 Do not withhold discipline from a child. If you strike him with a rod, he will not die. 14 If you strike him with the rod, you will save his soul (שׁוֹרָה) from Sheol.

Proverbs 24:12 12 If you say, Behold, we did not know this, does not he who weighs the heart (כֹּחַ) perceive it? Does not he who keeps watch over your soul (שׁוֹרָה) know it, and will he not repay man according to his work?

Ecclesiastes 6:7-9 7 All the toil of man is for his mouth, yet his soul (שׁוֹרָה) is not satisfied. 8 For what advantage has the wise man over the fool? And what does the poor man have who

knows how to conduct himself before the living? 9 Better is the sight of the eyes than the wandering of the soul (שׁוֹדֵד). This also is vanity and a striving after wind.

Song of Solomon 3:1-4 1 On my bed by night I sought him whom my soul (שׁוֹדֵד) loves. I sought him but found him not. 2 I will rise now and go about the city, in the streets and in the squares. I will seek him whom my soul (שׁוֹדֵד) loves. I sought him but found him not. 3 The watchmen found me as they went about in the city. Have you seen him whom my soul (שׁוֹדֵד) loves? 4 Scarcely had I passed them when I found him whom my soul (שׁוֹדֵד) loves. I held him and would not let him go....

Isaiah 1:14 14 Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul (שׁוֹדֵד) hates. They have become a burden to me. I am weary of bearing them.

Isaiah 10:18 18 The glory of [Assyria's] forest and of his fruitful land Yahweh will destroy, both soul (שׁוֹדֵד) and body, and it will be as when a sick man wastes away.

Isaiah 26:8-9 8 In the path of your judgments, Yahweh, we wait for you. Your name and remembrance are the desire of our soul (שׁוֹדֵד). 9 My soul (שׁוֹדֵד) yearns for you in the night. My spirit within me earnestly seeks you. For when your judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world learn righteousness.

Isaiah 38:17 17 Behold, it was for my welfare that I had great bitterness. But in love (קֶשֶׁת) you have delivered my soul (שׁוֹדֵד) from the pit of destruction, for you have cast all my sins behind your back.

Isaiah 42:1 1 Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul (שׁוֹדֵד) delights I have put my Spirit upon him. He will bring forth justice to the nations.

Isaiah 53:10-12 10 It was the desire of Yahweh to crush [his Servant]. He has put him to grief. When his soul (שׁוֹדֵד) makes an offering for guilt, he will see his seed. He will prolong his days. The desire of Yahweh will prosper in his hand. 11 Out of the anguish of his soul (שׁוֹדֵד) he will see and be satisfied. By his knowledge will the righteous one, my Servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities. 12 Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul (שׁוֹדֵד) to death and was numbered with the transgressors. Yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.

Isaiah 55:2-3 2 Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Listen diligently to me, eat what is good, and delight your soul (שׁוֹדֵד) in rich food. 3 Incline your ear, and come to me. Hear, that your soul (שׁוֹדֵד) may live, and I will make with you an everlasting covenant, my loyal, sure love for David.

Isaiah 58:10-11 10 If you pour your soul (שׁוֹדֵד) out for the hungry and satisfy the soul (שׁוֹדֵד) of the afflicted, then shall your light rise in the darkness and your gloom be as the noonday. 11 And Yahweh will guide you continually and satisfy your soul (שׁוֹדֵד) in scorched places and

make your bones strong. And you shall be like a watered garden, like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail.

Jeremiah 6:16 16 Thus says Yahweh: Stand by the roads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is, and walk in it, and find rest for your souls (שׁוֹרֵץ). But they said, We will not walk in it.

Jeremiah 15:1 1 Yahweh said to me, Though Moses and Samuel stood before me, yet my soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) would not turn toward this people [Israel]. Send them out of my sight, and let them go!

Jeremiah 20:13 13 Sing to Yahweh. Praise Yahweh! For he has delivered the soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) of the needy from the hand of evildoers.

Jeremiah 31:14 14 I will feast the soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) of the priests with abundance, and my people shall be satisfied with my goodness, declares Yahweh.

Jeremiah 31:25 25 I [Yahweh] will satisfy the weary soul (שׁוֹרֵץ), and every languishing soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) I will replenish.

Jeremiah 32:41 41 I [Yahweh] will rejoice in doing [Israel] good, and I will plant them in this land in faithfulness, with all my heart and all my soul (שׁוֹרֵץ).

Jeremiah 38:16 16 King Zedekiah swore secretly to Jeremiah, As Yahweh lives, who made our souls (שׁוֹרֵץ), I will not put you to death or deliver you into the hand of these men who seek your life.

Jeremiah 39:18 18 I [Yahweh] will surely save you [Ebed-Melech, and you shall not fall by the sword, but you shall have your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) as a prize of war, because you have put your trust in me.

Jeremiah 45:5 5 Do you [Baruch] seek great things for yourself? Seek them not, for behold, I am bringing disaster upon all flesh, declares Yahweh. But I will give you your soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) as a prize of war in all places to which you may go.

Jeremiah 50:19 19 I will restore Israel to his pasture, and he shall feed on Carmel and in Bashan, and his soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) shall be satisfied on the hills of Ephraim and in Gilead.

Jeremiah 51:6 6 Flee from the midst of Babylon. Let every one save his soul (שׁוֹרֵץ)! Be not cut off in her punishment, for this is the time of Yahweh's vengeance, the repayment he is rendering her.

Jeremiah 51:45 45 Go out of the midst of [Babylon], my people! Let every one save his soul (שׁוֹרֵץ) from the fierce anger of Yahweh!

Ezekiel 3:19-21 19 If you warn the wicked, and he does not turn from his wickedness, or from his wicked way, he shall die for his iniquity, but you will have delivered your soul (שׂוּפָהּ).
...21 But if you warn the righteous person not to sin, and he does not sin, he shall surely live, because he took warning, and you will have delivered your soul (שׂוּפָהּ).

Ezekiel 18:4 4 Behold, all souls (שׂוּפָהּ) are mine. The soul (שׂוּפָהּ) of the father as well as the soul (שׂוּפָהּ) of the son is mine. The soul (שׂוּפָהּ) who sins shall die.

Ezekiel 18:20 20 The soul (שׂוּפָהּ) who sins shall die. The son shall not suffer for the iniquity of the father, nor the father suffer for the iniquity of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself.

Ezekiel 18:27 27 When a wicked person turns away from the wickedness he has committed and does what is just and right, he shall save his soul (שׂוּפָהּ).

Ezekiel 22:27 27 [Israel's] princes in her midst are like wolves tearing the prey, shedding blood, destroying souls (שׂוּפָהּ) to get dishonest gain.

Ezekiel 47:9 9 Wherever the river goes, every living soul (שׂוּפָהּ) that swarms will live, and there will be very many fish. For this water goes there, that the waters of the sea may become fresh. So everything will live where the river goes.

Jonah 2:5-7 5 The waters closed in over me to take my soul (שׂוּפָהּ). The deep surrounded me. Weeds were wrapped about my head 6 at the roots of the mountains. I went down to the land whose bars closed upon me forever. Yet you brought up my life from the pit, Yahweh my God. 7 When my soul (שׂוּפָהּ) was fainting away, I remembered Yahweh, and my prayer came to you, into your holy temple.

Habakkuk 2:4 4 Behold, his soul (שׂוּפָהּ) is puffed up. It is not upright within him. But the righteous shall live by his faith.

Matthew 6:25 25 Do not be anxious about your soul (ψυχή), what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not the soul (ψυχή) more than food, and the body more than clothing?

Matthew 10:28 28 Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul (ψυχή). Rather fear him who can destroy both soul (ψυχή) and body in hell.

Matthew 10:39 39 Whoever finds his soul (ψυχή) will lose it, and whoever loses his soul (ψυχή) for my sake will find it.

Matthew 11:29 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls (ψυχή).

Matthew 12:18 18 Behold, my servant whom I have chosen, my beloved with whom my soul (ψυχή) is well pleased. I will put my Spirit upon him, and he will proclaim justice to the Gentiles.

Matthew 16:25-26 25 Whoever would save his soul (ψυχή) will lose it, but whoever loses his soul (ψυχή) for my sake will find it. 26 For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul (ψυχή)? Or what shall a man give in return for his soul (ψυχή)?

Matthew 20:28 28 The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his soul (ψυχή) as a ransom for many.

Matthew 22:37 37 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul (ψυχή), and with all your mind.

Matthew 26:38 38 My soul (ψυχή) is very sorrowful, even to death. Remain here, and watch with me [Jesus].

Mark 8:35-37 35 Whoever would save his soul (ψυχή) will lose it, but whoever loses his soul (ψυχή) for my sake and the gospel's will save it. 36 For what does it profit a man to gain the whole world and forfeit his soul (ψυχή)? 37 For what can a man give in return for his soul (ψυχή)?

Luke 12:19-23 19 I will say to my soul (ψυχή), Soul (ψυχή), you have ample goods laid up for many years Relax, eat, drink, be merry. 20 But God said to him, Fool! This night your soul (ψυχή) is required of you, and the things you have prepared, whose will they be? 21 So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God. 22 And he said to his disciples, Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your soul (ψυχή), what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on. 23 For the soul (ψυχή) is more than food and the body more than clothing.

Luke 14:26 26 If anyone comes to me and does not hate his own father, mother, wife, children, brothers, and sisters, yes, and even his own soul (ψυχή), he cannot be my disciple.

Luke 17:33 33 Whoever seeks to preserve his soul (ψυχή) will lose it, but whoever loses his soul (ψυχή) will keep it.

Luke 21:19 19 By your endurance you will gain your souls (ψυχή).

John 10:11 11 I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his soul (ψυχή) for the sheep.

John 10:15 15 I [Jesus lay down my soul (ψυχή) for the sheep.

John 10:17 17 For this reason the Father loves me [Jesus], because I lay down my soul (ψυχή) that I may take it up again.

John 12:25 25 Whoever loves his soul (ψυχή) loses it, and whoever hates his soul (ψυχή) in this world will keep it for eternal life.

John 12:27 27 Now is my soul (ψυχή) troubled. And what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour? But for this purpose I have come to this hour.

John 13:37-38 37 Peter said to [Jesus], Lord, why can I not follow you now? I will lay down my soul (ψυχή) for you. 38 Jesus answered, Will you lay down your soul (ψυχή) for me? Truly, truly, I say to you, the rooster will not crow till you have denied me three times.

John 15:13 13 Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his soul (ψυχή) for his friends.

Acts 2:41 41 So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls (ψυχή).

Acts 3:23 23 It shall be that every soul (ψυχή) who does not listen to that prophet [Jesus] shall be destroyed from the people [Israel].

Acts 4:32 32 The full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul (ψυχή), and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common.

Acts 14:2 2 The unbelieving Jews stirred up the Gentiles and poisoned their souls (ψυχή) against the brothers.

Acts 14:21-22 21 [Paul and Barnabas] returned to Lystra, to Iconium, and to Antioch, 22 strengthening the souls (ψυχή) of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in the faith, and saying that through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God.

Acts 15:25-26 25 It has seemed good to us, having come to one accord, to choose men and send them to you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul, 26 men who have risked their soul (ψυχή) for the name of our Lord Jesus Messiah.

Acts 20:10 10 Paul went down and bent over [Eutychus], and taking him in his arms said, Do not be alarmed, for his soul (ψυχή) is in him.

Acts 20:24 24 I do not account my soul (ψυχή) of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.

Romans 2:9 9 There will be tribulation and distress for every human soul (ψυχή) who does evil, the Jew first and also the Greek.

Romans 13:1 1 Let every soul (ψυχή) be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God.

Romans 16:3-4 3 Greet Prisca and Aquila, my co-workers in Messiah Jesus, 4 who risked their necks for my soul (ψυχή), to whom not only I give thanks but all the churches of the Gentiles give thanks as well.

1 Corinthians 15:45 45 The first man Adam became a living soul (ψυχή). The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

2 Corinthians 12:15 15 I [Paul] will most gladly spend and be spent for your souls (ψυχή).

Ephesians 6:6 6 ...Not by the way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but as bondservants of Messiah, doing the desire of God from the soul (ψυχή)....

Philippians 1:27 27 Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Messiah, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one soul (ψυχή) striving side by side for the faith of the gospel.

Philippians 2:30 30 [Epaphroditus] nearly died for the work of Messiah, risking his soul (ψυχή) to complete what was lacking in your service to me.

1 Thessalonians 2:8 8 So, being affectionately desirous of you, we were ready to share with you not only the gospel of God but also our own souls (ψυχή), because you had become very dear to us.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 23 Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit, soul (ψυχή), and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Messiah.

Hebrews 4:12 12 The word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul (ψυχή) and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Hebrews 6:19-20 19 We have [God's promises] as a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul (ψυχή), a hope that enters into the inner place behind the curtain, 20 where Jesus has gone as a forerunner on our behalf, having become a high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 10:38-39 38 My righteous one shall live by faith, and if he shrinks back, my soul (ψυχή) has no pleasure in him. 39 But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed but of those who have faith and preserve their souls (ψυχή).

Hebrews 13:17 17 Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls (ψυχή), as those who will have to give an account.

James 1:21 21 Put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls (ψυχή).

James 5:20 20 Let him know that whoever brings back a sinner from his wandering will save his soul (ψυχή) from death and will cover a multitude of sins.

1 Peter 1:8-9 8 Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, 9 obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls (ψυχή).

1 Peter 2:11 11 Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul (ψυχή).

1 Peter 2:25 25 You were straying like sheep but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls (ψυχή).

1 Peter 4:19 19 Let those who suffer according to God's desire entrust their souls (ψυχή) to a faithful Creator while doing good.

2 Peter 2:8 8 As that righteous man [Lot] lived among them day after day, he was tormenting his righteous soul (ψυχή) over their lawless deeds that he saw and heard.

2 Peter 2:14 14 [These false teachers] have eyes full of adultery, insatiable for sin. They entice unsteady souls (ψυχή). They have hearts trained in greed. Accursed children!

1 John 3:16 16 By this we know love, that he laid down his soul (ψυχή) for us, and we ought to lay down our souls (ψυχή) for the brothers.

3 John 2 2 Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul (ψυχή).

Revelation 6:9 9 When [Jesus] opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls (ψυχή) of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne.

Revelation 8:9 9 A third of the living souls (ψυχή) in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

Revelation 12:11 11 [Our brothers and sisters] have conquered [Satan] by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their souls (ψυχή) even unto death.

Revelation 16:3 3 The second angel poured out his bowl into the sea, and it became like the blood of a corpse, and every living soul (ψυχή) died that was in the sea.

Revelation 18:11-13 11 The merchants of the earth weep and mourn for [Babylon], because no one buys their cargo anymore, ...13 incense, myrrh, frankincense, wine, oil, fine flour, wheat, cattle and sheep, horses and chariots, and slaves, that is, human souls (ψυχή).

Revelation 20:4 4 I saw the souls (ψυχή) of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Messiah for a thousand years.
