

VERSES ON TEACHABILITY

Deuteronomy 29:4 4 ... To this day Yahweh has not given you [Israel] a heart to understand, eyes to see, or ears to hear.

Psalms 25:4-12 4 Make me to know your ways, Yahweh. Teach me your paths. 5 Lead me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation. For you I wait all the day long. ... 8 Good and upright is Yahweh. Therefore he instructs sinners in the way. 9 He leads the humble in what is right, and teaches the humble his way. ... 12 Who is the man who fears Yahweh? Him will he instruct in the way that he should choose.

Psalms 32:8-9 8 I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go. I will counsel you with my eye upon you. 9 Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding, which must be curbed with bit and bridle, or it will not stay near you.

Psalms 85:8 8 Let me hear what God, Yahweh, will speak, for he will speak peace to his people, to his saints. But let them not turn back to folly.

Psalms 86:11 11 Teach me your way, Yahweh, that I may walk in your truth. Unite my heart to fear your name.

Psalms 94:12 12 Blessed is the man whom you discipline, Yahweh, and whom you teach out of your law....

Psalms 119:18 18 Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law.

Psalms 119:26-27 26 When I told of my ways, you answered me. Teach me your statutes! 27 Make me understand the way of your precepts, and I will meditate on your wondrous works.

Psalms 119:33-35 33 Teach me, Yahweh, the way of your statutes, and I will keep it to the end. 34 Give me understanding, that I may keep your law and observe it with my whole heart. 35 Lead me in the path of your commandments, for I delight in it.

Psalms 119:40 40 Behold, I long for your precepts. In your righteousness give me life!

Psalms 119:66 66 Teach me good judgment and knowledge, for I believe in your commandments.

Psalms 119:71-72 71 It is good for me that I was afflicted, that I might learn your statutes. 72 The law of your mouth is better to me than thousands of gold and silver pieces.

Psalms 119:77 77 Let your mercy come to me, that I may live, for your law is my delight.

Psalms 119:98-102 98 Your commandment makes me wiser than my enemies, for it is ever with me. 99 I have more understanding than all my teachers, for your testimonies are my meditation. 100 I understand more than the aged, for I keep your precepts. 101 I hold back

my feet from every evil way, in order to keep your word. 102 I do not turn aside from your rules, for you have taught me.

Psalm 119:108 108 Accept my freewill offerings of praise, Yahweh, and teach me your rules.

Psalm 119:12 12 Blessed are you, Yahweh. Teach me your statutes!

Psalm 119:18 18 Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of your law.

Psalm 119:124 124 Deal with your servant according to your loyal love, and teach me your statutes.

Psalm 119:131 131 I open my mouth and pant, because I long for your commandments.

Psalm 119:135 135 Make your face shine upon your servant, and teach me your statutes.

Psalm 119:169 169 Let my cry come before you, Yahweh. Give me understanding according to your word!

Psalm 143:10 10 Teach me to do your desire, for you are my God! Let your good Spirit lead me on level ground!

Proverbs 4:1-6 1 Hear, O sons, a father's instruction, and be attentive, that you may gain insight, 2 for I give you good precepts. Do not forsake my teaching. 3 When I was a son with my father, tender, the only one in the sight of my mother, 4 he taught me and said to me, Let your heart hold fast my words. Keep my commandments and live. 5 Get wisdom! Get insight! Do not forget, and do not turn away from the words of my mouth. 6 Do not forsake her, and she will keep you. Love her, and she will guard you.

Isaiah 2:3 3 ...Many peoples shall come and say: Come, let us go up to the mountain of Yahweh, to the house of the God of Jacob, that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths. For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of Yahweh from Jerusalem.

Isaiah 30:9-11 9 ...They [Israel] are a rebellious people, lying children, children unwilling to hear the instruction of Yahweh, 10 who say to the seers, Do not see, and to the prophets, Do not prophesy to us what is right. Speak to us smooth things, prophesy illusions, 11 leave the way, turn aside from the path, let us hear no more about the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 48:17-18 17 ...I am Yahweh your God, who teaches you to profit, who leads you in the way you should go. 18 Oh that you had paid attention to my commandments! Then your peace would have been like a river, and your righteousness like the waves of the sea.

Acts 10:33 33 ...I [Cornelius] sent for you [Peter] at once, and you have been kind enough to come. Now therefore we are all here in the presence of God to hear all that you have been commanded by the Lord.

Hebrews 5:11-14 11 About this we have much to say, and it is hard to explain because you have become dull of hearing. 12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the basic principles of the oracles of God. You need milk, not solid food. 13 For everyone who lives on milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, because he is a child. 14 But solid food is for the mature, for those who have their powers of discernment trained by constant practice to distinguish good from evil.

James 1:21 21 ...Put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

Revelation 3:6 6 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.
