

VERSES ON THE DAVIDIC COVENANT

Genesis 3:16 16 To the woman [Yahweh God] said, I will surely multiply your pain in conception. In sorrow you shall bring forth children. Yet your desire shall be for your man, and he shall rule over you.

Genesis 49:10 10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until tribute comes to him. And to him shall be the obedience of the peoples.

Ruth 4:14-17 14 The women [of Bethlehem] said to Naomi, Blessed be Yahweh, who has not left you this day without a redeemer, and may his name be renowned in Israel! 15 He shall be to you a restorer of life and a nourisher of your old age, for your daughter-in-law who loves you, who is more to you than seven sons, has given birth to him. 16 Then Naomi took the child and laid him on her lap and became his nurse. 17 And the women of the neighborhood gave him a name saying, A son has been born to Naomi. They named him Obed. He was the father of Jesse, the father of David.

2 Samuel 7:11-16 11 Yahweh declares to you [David] that Yahweh will make you a house. 12 When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your seed after you who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. 13 He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. 14 I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men, 15 but my loyal love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you. 16 And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.

2 Samuel 22:51 51 Yahweh is a tower of salvation (יְשׁוּעָה) to his king and shows loyal love to his Messiah, to David and his seed forever.

2 Samuel 23:3-5 3 The God of Israel has spoken. The Rock of Israel has said to me [David]: When one rules justly over men, ruling in the fear of God, 4 he dawns on them like the morning light, like the sun shining forth on a cloudless morning, like rain that makes grass to sprout from the earth. 5 For does not my house stand so with God? For he has made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things and secure.

1 Kings 2:4 4 If your sons pay close attention to their way, to walk before me in faithfulness with all their heart and with all their soul, you [David] shall not lack a man on the throne of Israel.

1 Kings 2:45 45 The throne of David shall be established before Yahweh forever.

1 Kings 11:35-36 35 I [Yahweh] will take the kingdom out of [Solomon's] son's hand and will give it to you [Jeroboam], ten tribes. 36 Yet to his son [Rehoboam] I will give one tribe, that David my servant may always have a lamp before me in Jerusalem, the city where I have chosen to put my name.

1 Kings 11:39 39 I will afflict the seed of David because of [Solomon's sin], but not forever.

2 Kings 8:19 19 Yahweh was not willing to destroy Judah for the sake of David his servant, because he promised to give a lamp to him and to his sons forever.

1 Chronicles 17:10-14 10 I [Nathan] declare to you [David] that Yahweh will build you a house. 11 When your days are fulfilled to walk with your fathers, I will raise up your seed after you, one of your own sons, and I will establish his kingdom. 12 He shall build a house for me, and I will establish his throne forever. 13 I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. I will not take my loyal love from him, as I took it from him who was before you, 14 but I will confirm him in my house and in my kingdom forever, and his throne shall be established forever.

Psalms 2:6-9 6 As for me, I [Yahweh] have set my King on Zion, my holy hill. 7 I will tell of the decree: Yahweh said to me, You are my Son. Today I have begotten you. 8 Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance and the ends of the earth your possession. 9 You shall break them with a rod of iron and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

Psalms 18:50 50 [Yahweh] is a tower of salvation to his king and shows loyal love to his Messiah, to David and his seed forever.

Psalms 78:67-70 67 [God] rejected the tent of Joseph. He did not choose the tribe of Ephraim, 68 but he chose the tribe of Judah, Mount Zion, which he loves. 69 He built his sanctuary like the high heavens, like the earth, which he has founded forever. 70 He chose David his servant and took him from the sheepfolds.

Psalms 89:3-4 3 You [Yahweh] have said, I have made a covenant with my chosen one. I have sworn to David my servant. 4 I will establish your seed forever and build your throne for all generations. Selah

Psalms 89:19-37 19 I [Yahweh] have granted help to one who is mighty. I have exalted one chosen from the people. 20 I have found David, my servant. With my holy oil I have anointed him, 21 so that my hand shall be established with him. My arm also shall strengthen him. 22 The enemy shall not outwit him. The wicked shall not humble him. 23 I will crush his foes before him and strike down those who hate him. 24 My faithfulness and my loyal love shall be with him, and in my name shall his horn be exalted. 25 I will set his hand on the sea and his right hand on the rivers. 26 He shall cry to me, You are my Father, my God, and the Rock of my salvation. 27 And I will make him the firstborn, the highest of the kings of the earth. 28 My loyal love I will keep for him forever, and my covenant will stand firm for him. 29 I will establish his seed forever and his throne as the days of the heavens. 30 If his children forsake my law and do not walk according to my rules, 31 if they violate my statutes and do not keep my commandments, 32 then I will punish their transgression with the rod and their iniquity with stripes, 33 but I will not remove from him my loyal love or be false to my faithfulness. 34 I will not violate my covenant or alter the word that went forth from my lips. 35 Once for all I have sworn by my holiness. I will not lie to David. 36 His seed shall endure forever, his

throne as long as the sun before me. 37 Like the moon it shall be established forever, a faithful witness in the skies. Selah

Psalm 132:11-18 11 Yahweh swore to David a sure oath from which he will not turn back: One of the sons of your body I will set on your throne. 12 If your sons keep my covenant and my testimonies that I shall teach them, their sons also forever shall sit on your throne. 13 For Yahweh has chosen Zion. He has desired it for his dwelling place: 14 This is my resting place forever. Here I will dwell, for I have desired it. ...17 There I will make a horn to sprout for David. I have prepared a lamp for my anointed. 18 His enemies I will clothe with shame, but on him his crown will shine.

Isaiah 9:6-7 6 To us a child is born, to us a son is given. And the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. 7 Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of Yahweh of hosts will do this.

Isaiah 11:1-5 1 There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit. 2 And the Spirit of Yahweh shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of Yahweh. 3 And his delight shall be in the fear of Yahweh. He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide disputes by what his ears hear, 4 but with righteousness he shall judge the poor and decide with equity for the meek of the earth. And he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked. 5 Righteousness shall be the belt of his waist, and faithfulness the belt of his loins.

Isaiah 16:5 5 A throne will be established in loyal love, and on it will sit in faithfulness in the tent of David one who judges and seeks justice and is swift to do righteousness.

Jeremiah 23:5-6 5 Behold, the days are coming, declares Yahweh, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 6 In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely. And this is the name by which he will be called: Yahweh our righteousness (יהוה צדקתנו).

Jeremiah 30:8-9 8 It shall come to pass in that day, declares Yahweh of hosts, that I will break his yoke from off your neck, I will burst your bonds, and foreigners shall no more make a servant of [Israel]. 9 But they shall serve Yahweh their God and David their king, whom I will raise up for them.

Jeremiah 33:15-26 15 In those days and at that time I will cause a righteous Branch to spring up for David, and he shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 16 In those days Judah will be saved, and Jerusalem will dwell securely. And this is the name by which it will be called: Yahweh our righteousness. 17 For thus says Yahweh: David shall never lack a man to sit on the throne of the house of Israel, 18 and the Levitical priests shall never lack a man

in my presence to offer burnt offerings, to burn grain offerings, and to make sacrifices forever. 19 The word of Yahweh came to Jeremiah: 20 Thus says Yahweh, If you can break my covenant with the day and my covenant with the night, so that day and night will not come at their appointed time, 21 then also my covenant with David my servant may be broken, so that he shall not have a son to reign on his throne, and my covenant with the Levitical priests my ministers. 22 As the host of heaven cannot be numbered and the sands of the sea cannot be measured, so I will multiply the seed of David my servant and the Levitical priests who minister to me. 23 The word of Yahweh came to Jeremiah: 24 Have you not observed that these people are saying, Yahweh has rejected the two clans that he chose? Thus they have despised my people so that they are no longer a nation in their sight. 25 Thus says Yahweh: If I have not established my covenant with day and night and the fixed order of heaven and earth, 26 then I will reject the seed of Jacob and David my servant and will not choose one of his seed to rule over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Ezekiel 37:24-25 24 My servant David shall be king over [Judah and Israel], and they shall all have one shepherd. They shall walk in my rules and be careful to obey my statutes. 25 They shall dwell in the land that I gave to my servant Jacob, where your fathers lived. They and their children and their children's children shall dwell there forever, and David my servant shall be their prince forever.

Hosea 3:5 5 Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek Yahweh their God and David their king, and they shall come in fear to Yahweh and to his goodness in the latter days.

Amos 9:11-12 11 In that day I will raise up the booth of David that is fallen, repair its breaches, raise up its ruins, and rebuild it as in the days of old, 12 that they may possess the remnant of Edom and all the nations who are called by my name, declares Yahweh.

Micah 5:2 2 You, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days.
