

VERSES ON THE FATHER AND THE SON

Matthew 3:17 17 ...Behold, a voice from heaven said, This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.

Mark 1:11 11 ...A voice came from heaven, You are my beloved Son. With you I am well pleased.

John 1:1-2 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God.

John 1:14 14 ...The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 1:18 18 No one has ever seen God. The only God, who is in the Father's chest, he has made him known.

John 2:16 16 ...[Jesus] told those who sold the pigeons, Take these things away. Do not make my Father's house a house of trade.

John 3:16-17 16 ...God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

John 3:35 35 The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand.

John 5:17-30 17 ...Jesus answered [the Jewish leaders], My Father is working until now, and I am working. 18 This was why the Jews were seeking all the more to kill him, because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God. 19 So Jesus said to them, Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise. 20 For the Father loves the Son and shows him all that he himself is doing. And greater works than these will he show him, so that you may marvel. 21 For as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so also the Son gives life to whom he desires. 22 For the Father judges no one, but has given all judgment to the Son, 23 that all may honour the Son, just as they honour the Father. Whoever does not honour the Son does not honour the Father who sent him. ...26 For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son also to have life in himself. 27 And he has given him authority to execute judgment, because he is the Son of Man. ...30 I can do nothing on my own. As I hear, I judge, and my judgment is just, because I seek not my own desire but the desire of him who sent me.

John 5:36-37 36 ...The testimony that I [Jesus] have is greater than that of John. For the works that the Father has given me to accomplish, the very works that I am doing, testify about me that the Father has sent me. 37 And the Father who sent me has himself testified about me.

John 6:38 38 ...I [Jesus] have come down from heaven, not to do my own desire but the desire of him who sent me.

John 10:30 30 I and the Father are one.

John 10:37-38 37 If I am not doing the works of my Father, then do not believe me. 38 But if I do them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, that you may know and understand that the Father is in me, and I am in the Father.

John 14:9-13 9 Jesus said to [Philip], Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, Show us the Father? 10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me does his works. 11 Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else believe on account of the works themselves. 12 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do. And greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father. 13 Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

John 14:20 20 In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.

John 14:31 31 ...I [Jesus] do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father.

John 15:24 24 If I [Jesus] had not done among [the Jewish leaders] the works that no one else did, they would not be guilty of sin, but now they have seen and hated both me and my Father.

John 17:4 4 I [Jesus] glorified you [the Father] on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do.

John 17:11 11 ...I [Jesus] am no longer in the world, but they [the disciples] are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one.

John 17:20-26 20 I [Jesus] do not ask for these [disciples] only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, 21 that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. 22 The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, 23 I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me. 24 Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world. 25 O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have

sent me. 26 I made known to them your name, and I will continue to make it known, that the love with which you have loved me may be in them, and I in them.

Colossians 1:15 15 [The Son] is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

Hebrews 1:3 3 [The Son] is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power.
