

VERSES ON THE NAME OF JESUS

John 14:13-14 13 Whatever you ask in my **name**, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask me anything in my **name**, I will do it.

John 15:21 21 All these things they will do to you on account of my **name**, because they do not know him who sent me.

Acts 3:6 6 Peter said, I have no silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you [the lame man]. In the **name** of Jesus Messiah of Nazareth, rise up and walk!

Acts 3:16 16 [Jesus'] **name**—by faith in his **name**—has made this [lame] man strong whom you see and know, and the faith that is through Jesus has given the man this perfect health in the presence of you all.

Acts 4:10 10 Let it be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel that by the **name** of Jesus Messiah of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead—by him this man is standing before you well.

Acts 4:12 12 There is salvation in no one else [but Jesus], for there is no other **name** under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.

Acts 4:17-18 17 In order that it may spread no further among the people, let us [the Jewish leaders] warn [Peter and John] to speak no more to anyone in this **name**. 18 So they called them and charged them not to speak or teach at all in the **name** of Jesus.

Acts 4:30 30 ... While you stretch out your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the **name** of your holy servant Jesus.

Acts 5:28 28 We [Jewish leaders] strictly charged you [apostles] not to teach in this **name**, yet here you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching.

Acts 5:40-41 40 When [the Jewish leaders] had called in the apostles, they beat them, charged them not to speak in the **name** of Jesus, and let them go. 41 Then they left the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the **name**.

Acts 8:12 12 When [the Samaritans] believed Philip as he preached good news about the kingdom of God and the **name** of Jesus Messiah, they were baptized, both men and women.

Acts 9:14 14 Here [in Damascus] [Paul] has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on your **name** [the name of Jesus].

Acts 9:27-28 27 Barnabas took [Saul], brought him to the apostles, and declared to them how on the road he had seen the Lord who spoke to him, and how at Damascus he had preached

boldly in the **name** of Jesus. 28 So he went in and out among them at Jerusalem, preaching boldly in the **name** of the Lord.

Acts 10:43 43 To [Jesus] all the prophets testify that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his **name**.

Acts 10:48 48 [Peter] commanded [the Gentile believers] to be baptized in the **name** of Jesus Messiah.

Acts 19:5 5 [The disciples of John the Baptist were baptized into the **name** of the Lord Jesus.

Acts 19:13-17 13 Then some of the itinerant Jewish exorcists undertook to invoke the **name** of the Lord Jesus over those who had evil spirits saying, I adjure you by the Jesus whom Paul proclaims. 14 Seven sons of a Jewish high priest named Sceva were doing this. 15 But the evil spirit answered them, Jesus I know, and Paul I recognize, but who are you? 16 And the man in whom was the evil spirit leaped on them, mastered all of them, and overpowered them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. 17 And this became known to all the residents of Ephesus, both Jews and Greeks. And fear fell upon them all, and the **name** of the Lord Jesus was extolled.

Acts 21:13 13 I [Paul] am ready not only to be imprisoned but even to die in Jerusalem for the **name** of the Lord Jesus.

Acts 22:16 16 Why do you [Saul] wait? Rise, be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on his **name**.

Acts 26:9 9 I myself [Paul] was convinced that I ought to do many things in opposing the **name** of Jesus of Nazareth.

Romans 1:5 5 We have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his **name** among all the nations.

1 Corinthians 1:2 2 To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Messiah Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the **name** of our Lord Jesus Messiah, both their Lord and ours.

1 Corinthians 6:11 11 You were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the **name** of the Lord Jesus Messiah and by the Spirit of our God.

Philippians 2:9-10 9 God has highly exalted [Jesus] and bestowed on him the **name** that is above every **name**, 10 so that at the **name** of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven, on earth, and under the earth.

Colossians 3:17 17 Whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the **name** of the Lord Jesus.

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 11 To this end we always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling and may fulfill every resolve for good and every work of faith by his power, 12 so that the **name** of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you.

2 Timothy 2:19 19 Let everyone who names the **name** of the Lord [Jesus] depart from iniquity.
