

## ***VERSES ON THE OMNIPOTENCE OF GOD***

**Genesis 1:1-3** 1 In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. 3 And God said, Let there be light, and there was light.

**Genesis 18:14** 14 Is anything too hard for Yahweh? At the appointed time I will return to you, about this time next year, and Sarah shall have a son.

**Exodus 9:15-16** 15 By now I [Yahweh] could have put out my hand and struck you [Pharaoh] and your people with pestilence, and you would have been cut off from the earth. 16 But for this purpose I have raised you up, to show you my power, so that my name may be proclaimed in all the earth.

**Exodus 14:31-15:11** 31 Israel saw the great power that Yahweh used against the Egyptians, so the people feared Yahweh, and they believed in Yahweh and in his servant Moses. 1 Then Moses and the people of Israel sang this song to Yahweh saying, I will sing to Yahweh, for he has triumphed gloriously. The horse and his rider he has thrown into the sea. 2 Yahweh is my strength and my song, and he has become my salvation. This is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him. 3 Yahweh is a man of war. Yahweh is his name. 4 Pharaoh's chariots and his host he cast into the sea, and his chosen officers were sunk in the Red Sea. 5 The floods covered them. They went down into the depths like a stone. 6 Your right hand, Yahweh, glorious in power, your right hand, Yahweh, shatters the enemy. 7 In the greatness of your majesty you overthrow your adversaries. You send out your fury. It consumes them like stubble. 8 At the blast of your nostrils the waters piled up. The floods stood up in a heap. The deeps congealed in the heart of the sea. 9 The enemy said, I will pursue. I will overtake. I will divide the spoil. My desire shall have its fill of them. I will draw my sword. My hand shall destroy them. 10 You blew with your wind. The sea covered them. They sank like lead in the mighty waters. 11 Who is like you, Yahweh, among the gods? Who is like you, majestic in holiness, awesome in glorious deeds, doing wonders?

**Numbers 11:21-23** 21 Moses said, The people among whom I am number six hundred thousand on foot, and you have said, I will give them meat, that they may eat a whole month! 22 Shall flocks and herds be slaughtered for them and be enough for them? Or shall all the fish of the sea be gathered together for them and be enough for them? 23 And Yahweh said to Moses, Is Yahweh's hand shortened? Now you shall see whether my word will come true for you or not.

**Deuteronomy 3:24** 24 Lord Yahweh, you have only begun to show your servant your greatness and your mighty hand. For what god is there in heaven or on earth who can do such works and mighty acts as yours?

**Joshua 4:23-24** 23 Yahweh your God dried up the waters of the Jordan for you until you passed over, as Yahweh your God did to the Red Sea, which he dried up for us until we passed over, 24 so that all the peoples of the earth may know that the hand of Yahweh is mighty, that you may fear Yahweh your God forever.

**Joshua 10:12-14** 12 At that time Joshua spoke to Yahweh in the day when Yahweh gave the Amorites over to the sons of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand still at Gibeon, and moon, in the Valley of Aijalon. 13 And the sun stood still, and the moon stopped, until the nation took vengeance on their enemies. Is this not written in the Book of Jashar? The sun stopped in the midst of heaven and did not hurry to set for about a whole day. 14 There has been no day like it before or since, when Yahweh heeded the voice of a man, for Yahweh fought for Israel.

**1 Samuel 14:6** 6 Jonathan said to the young man who carried his armor, Come, let us go over to the garrison of these uncircumcised. It may be that Yahweh will work for us, for nothing can hinder Yahweh from saving by many or by few.

**1 Chronicles 29:12** 12 In your hand are power and might, and in your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all.

**2 Chronicles 20:6** 6 Yahweh, God of our fathers, are you not God in heaven? You rule over all the kingdoms of the nations. In your hand are power and might so that none is able to withstand you.<sup>1</sup>

**Job 37:23-24** 23 The Almighty—we cannot find him. He is great in power. Justice and abundant righteousness he will not violate.

**Job 42:2** 2 I [Job] know that you [Yahweh] can do all things and that no purpose of yours can be thwarted.

**Psalms 24:8** 8 Who is this King of glory? Yahweh, strong and mighty, Yahweh, mighty in battle!

**Psalms 68:34-35** 34 Ascribe power to God, whose majesty is over Israel, and whose power is in the skies. 35 Awesome is God from his sanctuary. The God of Israel—he is the one who gives power and strength to his people. Blessed be God!

**Psalms 111:2-4** 2 Great are the works of Yahweh, studied by all who delight in them. 3 Full of splendor and majesty is his work, and his righteousness endures forever. 4 He has caused his wondrous works to be remembered.

**Psalms 147:5** 5 Great is our Lord and abundant in power.

**Isaiah 40:12-31** 12 Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, marked off the heavens with a span, enclosed the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance? ...21 Do you not know? Do you not hear? Has it not been told you from the beginning? Have you not understood from the foundations of the earth? 22 It is he who sits above the circle of the earth, and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers, who

stretches out the heavens like a curtain and spreads them like a tent to dwell in, 23 who brings princes to nothing and makes the rulers of the earth as emptiness. 24 Scarcely are they planted, scarcely sown, scarcely has their stem taken root in the earth, when he blows on them, and they wither, and the tempest carries them off like stubble. 25 To whom then will you compare me, that I should be like him? says the Holy One. 26 Lift up your eyes on high and see. Who created these? He who brings out their host by number, calling them all by name. By the greatness of his might and because he is strong in power, not one is missing. ... 28 Have you not known? Have you not heard? Yahweh is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary. His understanding is unsearchable. 29 He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength. 30 Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted. 31 But they who wait for Yahweh shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings like eagles. They shall run and not be weary. They shall walk and not faint.

**Isaiah 45:7** 7 I form light and create darkness. I make well-being and create calamity. I am Yahweh who does all these things.

**Jeremiah 32:17** 17 Aha, Lord Yahweh! It is you who have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and by your outstretched arm! Nothing is too hard for you.

**Jeremiah 32:27** 27 Behold, I am Yahweh, the God of all flesh. Is anything too hard for me?

**Jeremiah 51:15** 15 It is [Yahweh] who made the earth by his power, who established the world by his wisdom, and by his understanding stretched out the heavens.<sup>2</sup>

**Matthew 8:26-27** 26 [Jesus] said to [the disciples], Why are you afraid, O you of little faith? Then he rose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm. 27 And the men marveled saying, What sort of man is this, that even winds and sea obey him?

**Matthew 19:26** 26 Jesus looked at [the disciples] and said, With man [salvation] is impossible, but with God all things are possible.

**Mark 10:27** 27 Jesus looked at [the disciples] and said, With man [salvation] is impossible, but not with God. For all things are possible with God.

**Luke 1:37** 37 Nothing will be impossible with God.

**1 Corinthians 1:18** 18 The message of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

**1 Corinthians 1:25** 25 The “weakness” of God is stronger than men.

**2 Corinthians 6:18** 18 I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to me, says the Lord Almighty (παντοκράτωρ).

**Ephesians 1:18-20** 18 ...That you [believers] may know what is the hope to which [the Father] has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might 20 that he worked in Messiah when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places.

**Ephesians 3:14-21** 14 I [Paul] bow my knees before the Father, ...16 that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being.... 20 Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, 21 to him be glory in the church and in Messiah Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

**Philippians 4:13** 13 I can do all things through [Messiah] who strengthens me.

**Hebrews 1:3** 3 [The Son] is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power.

**Revelation 1:8** 8 I am the Alpha and the Omega, says the Lord God, who is, who was, and who is to come, the Almighty (ὁ παντοκράτωρ).

**Revelation 19:6** 6 Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder crying out, Hallelujah! For the Lord our God the Almighty (ὁ παντοκράτωρ) reigns.
