

VERSES ON THE OMNIPRESENCE OF GOD

Genesis 16:13-14 13 [Hagar] called the name of Yahweh who spoke to her, You are a God who sees me (אֱלֹהֵי רֹאִי), for she said, Truly here I have seen (רָאִיתִי) him who sees (רֹאִהוּ) me. 14 Therefore the well was called Beer-lahai-roi (“Well of the living one who sees (רֹאִהוּ) me”).

Exodus 13:21-22 21 Yahweh went before [Israel] by day in a pillar of cloud to lead them along the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, that they might travel by day and by night. 22 The pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night did not depart from before the people.

Exodus 20:24 24 In every place where I cause my name to be remembered I will come to you and bless you.

Deuteronomy 4:7 7 What great nation is there that has a god so near to it as Yahweh our God is to us, whenever we call upon him?

1 Kings 8:39 39 Hear in heaven your dwelling place, forgive, act, and render to each whose heart you know, according to all his ways (for you, you only, know the hearts of all the children of mankind).

1 Kings 20:28 28 A man of God came near and said to the king of Israel [Ahab], Thus says Yahweh, Because the Syrians have said, Yahweh is a god of the hills but he is not a god of the valleys, therefore I will give all this great multitude into your hand, and you shall know that I am Yahweh.¹

1 Chronicles 28:9 9 You, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a whole heart and with a willing mind, for Yahweh searches all hearts and understands every plan and thought.

2 Chronicles 6:30 30 ... Then hear from heaven your dwelling place, forgive, and render to each whose heart you know, according to all his ways, for you, you only, know the hearts of the children of mankind.

2 Chronicles 16:9 9 The eyes of Yahweh run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose heart is blameless toward him.

Job 9:11 11 Behold, he passes by me, and I see him not. He moves on, but I do not perceive him.

Job 23:8-10 8 Behold, I go forward, but he is not there, and backward, but I do not perceive him. 9 On the left hand when he is working, I do not behold him. He turns to the right hand, but I do not see him. 10 But he knows the way that I take.

Job 28:24 24 [God] looks to the ends of the earth and sees everything under the heavens.

Job 34:21-22 21 ...[God's] eyes are on the ways of a man, and he sees all his steps. 22 There is no gloom or deep darkness where evildoers may hide themselves.

Psalm 33:13-16 13 Yahweh looks down from heaven. He sees all the children of man. 14 From where he sits enthroned he looks out on all the inhabitants of the earth, 15 he who fashions the hearts of them all and observes all their deeds.

Psalm 34:15-18 15 The eyes of Yahweh are toward the righteous and his ears toward their cry. 16 The face of Yahweh is against those who do evil, to cut off the memory of them from the earth. 17 When the righteous cry for help, Yahweh hears and delivers them out of all their troubles. 18 Yahweh is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit.

Psalm 44:20-21 20 If we had forgotten the name of our God or spread out our hands to a foreign god, 21 would not God discover this? For he knows the secrets of the heart.

Psalm 66:7 7 ...[God's] eyes keep watch on the nations....

Psalm 94:8-11 8 Understand, O dullest of the people! Fools, when will you be wise? 9 He who planted the ear, does he not hear? He who formed the eye, does he not see? 10 He who disciplines the nations, does he not rebuke? He who teaches man knowledge— 11 Yahweh— knows the thoughts of man, that they are but a breath.

Psalm 119:151 151 ...You are near, Yahweh, and all your commandments are true.

Psalm 119:168 168 I keep your precepts and testimonies, for all my ways are before you.

Psalm 121 1 I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come? 2 My help comes from Yahweh, who made heaven and earth. 3 He will not let your foot be moved. He who keeps you will not slumber. 4 Behold, he who keeps Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. 5 Yahweh is your keeper. Yahweh is your shade on your right hand. 6 The sun shall not strike you by day, nor the moon by night. 7 Yahweh will guard you from all evil. He will guard your life. 8 Yahweh will guard your going out and your coming in from this time forth and forevermore.

Psalm 139:1-18 1 Yahweh, you have searched me and known me! 2 You know when I sit down and when I rise up. You discern my thoughts from afar. 3 You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways. 4 Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, Yahweh, you know it altogether. 5 You hem me in, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me. 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me. It is high. I cannot attain it. 7 Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? 8 If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there! 9 If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, 10 even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me. 11 If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night, 12 even the darkness is not dark to you. The night is bright as the

day, for darkness is as light with you. ... 15 My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. 16 Your eyes saw my unformed substance. In your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them. 17 How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! 18 If I would count them, they are more than the sand. I awake, and I am still with you.

Proverbs 15:3 3 The eyes of Yahweh are in every place, keeping watch on the evil and the good.

Proverbs 15:11 11 Sheol and Abaddon lie open before Yahweh. How much more the hearts of the children of man!

Isaiah 1:16 16 Wash yourselves. Make yourselves clean. Remove the evil of your deeds from before my eyes. Cease to do evil!

Isaiah 57:15 15 ... Thus says the One who is high and lifted up, who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and lowly spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly, and to revive the heart of the contrite.

Jeremiah 12:3 3 ... You, Yahweh, know me. You see me and test my heart toward you.

Jeremiah 17:10 10 I, Yahweh, search the heart and test the mind, to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his deeds.

Jeremiah 23:23-24 23 Am I a God at hand, declares Yahweh, and not a God far away? 24 Can a man hide himself in secret places so that I cannot see him? declares Yahweh. Do I not fill heaven and earth? declares Yahweh.

Amos 9:2-4 2 If [the people of Israel] dig into Sheol, from there shall my hand take them. If they climb up to heaven, from there I will bring them down. 3 If they hide themselves on the top of Carmel, from there I will search them out and take them. And if they hide from my sight at the bottom of the sea, there I will command the serpent, and it shall bite them. 4 And if they go into captivity before their enemies, there I will command the sword, and it shall kill them.

Zechariah 4:10 10 These seven are the eyes of Yahweh that range through the whole earth.

Matthew 6:7-8 7 When you pray, do not heap up empty phrases as the nations do, for they think that they will be heard for their many words. 8 Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

Matthew 10:29-30 29 Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? And not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. 30 But even the hairs of your head are all numbered.

Matthew 28:20 20 Behold, I [Jesus] am with you [disciples] always, to the end of the age.

Luke 16:15 15 You [Pharisees] are those who justify yourselves before men, but God knows your hearts.

Acts 17:24-28 24 The God who made the world and everything in it, being Lord of heaven and earth, does not live in temples made by man, 25 nor is he served by human hands, as though he needed anything, because he himself gives to all mankind life, breath, and everything. 26 And he made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place, 27 that they should seek God and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him. Yet he is actually not far from each one of us, 28 for, In him we live and move and have our being.

Romans 8:35-39 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Messiah? Shall tribulation, distress, persecution, famine, nakedness, danger, or sword? ...38 I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Messiah Jesus our Lord.

Ephesians 4:4-6 6 ...One God and Father of all, who is over all, through all, and in all.

Hebrews 4:13 13 No creature is hidden from [God's] sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

Hebrews 13:5-6 5 Keep your life free from love of money and be content with what you have. For he has said, I will never leave you nor forsake you. 6 So we can confidently say, The Lord is my helper. I will not fear. What can man do to me?

1 John 3:20 20 Whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and he knows everything.

Revelation 2:23 23 I will strike [Jezebel's] children dead. And all the churches will know that I am he who searches mind and heart, and I will give to each of you according to your works.
