

VERSES ON THE OMNISCIENCE OF GOD

Deuteronomy 29:29 29 The secret things belong to Yahweh our God, but the things that are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law.

1 Samuel 2:3 3 Talk no more so very proudly. Let not arrogance come from your mouth. For Yahweh is a God of knowledge (הַיָּדוּת), and by him actions are weighed.

Job 9:4 4 [God] is wise in heart and mighty in strength—who has hardened himself against him and succeeded?

Job 12:13 13 With God are wisdom and might. He has counsel and understanding.

Job 28:12-28 12 Where shall wisdom be found? And where is the place of understanding? 13 Man does not know its worth, and it is not found in the land of the living. ...20 From where, then, does wisdom come? And where is the place of understanding? 21 It is hidden from the eyes of all living and concealed from the birds of the air. 22 Abaddon and Death say, We have heard a rumor of it with our ears. 23 God understands the way to it, and he knows its place. 24 For he looks to the ends of the earth and sees everything under the heavens. 25 When he gave to the wind its weight and apportioned the waters by measure, 26 when he made a decree for the rain and a way for the lightning of the thunder, 27 then he saw it and declared it. He established it and searched it out. 28 And he said to man, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, and to turn away from evil is understanding.

Job 37:16 16 Do you know the balancings of the clouds, the wondrous works of him who is perfect in knowledge?

Psalms 92:5 5 How great are your works, Yahweh! Your thoughts are very deep!

Psalms 104:24 24 Yahweh, how manifold are your works! In wisdom have you made them all. The earth is full of your creatures.

Psalms 139:17-18 17 How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! 18 If I would count them, they are more than the sand.

Psalms 147:5 5 Great is our Lord, and abundant in power. His understanding is beyond measure.

Proverbs 3:19-20 19 Yahweh by wisdom founded the earth. By understanding he established the heavens. 20 By his knowledge the deeps broke open, and the clouds drop down the dew.

Proverbs 8:22-31 22 Yahweh possessed me [wisdom] at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of old. 23 Ages ago I was set up, at the first, before the beginning of the earth. 24 When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no springs abounding with water. 25 Before the mountains had been shaped, before the hills, I was brought forth, 26 before he had made the earth with its fields or the first of the dust of the world. 27 When he

established the heavens, I was there. When he drew a circle on the face of the deep, 28 when he made firm the skies above, when he established the fountains of the deep, 29 when he assigned to the sea its limit, so that the waters might not transgress his command, when he marked out the foundations of the earth, 30 then I was beside him like a master workman, and I was daily his delight, rejoicing before him always, 31 rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the children of man.

Proverbs 9:10 10 The fear of Yahweh is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight.

Proverbs 21:30 30 No wisdom, no understanding, no counsel can avail against Yahweh.

Isaiah 28:29 29 Yahweh of hosts...is wonderful in counsel and excellent in wisdom.

Isaiah 40:13-14 13 Who has measured the Spirit of the Lord, or what man shows him his counsel? 14 Whom did he consult, and who made him understand? Who taught him the path of justice, taught him knowledge, and showed him the way of understanding?

Isaiah 40:28 28 Have you not known? Have you not heard? Yahweh is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary. His understanding is unsearchable.

Isaiah 42:9 9 Behold, the former things have come to pass, and new things I now declare. Before they spring forth I tell you of them.

Isaiah 46:9-10 9 I am God, and there is no other. I am God, and there is none like me, 10 declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose.

Isaiah 55:8-9 8 My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares Yahweh. 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Jeremiah 51:15 15 It is [Yahweh] who made the earth by his power, who established the world by his wisdom, and by his understanding stretched out the heavens.

Daniel 2:20-22 20 Daniel answered and said: Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, to whom belong wisdom and might. 21 He changes times and seasons. He removes kings and sets up kings. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding. 22 He reveals deep and hidden things. He knows what is in the darkness, and the light dwells with him.

Romans 8:29 29 Those whom [God] foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

Romans 11:33-36 33 Oh, the depth of the riches, wisdom, and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! 34 For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor? 35 Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid? 36 For from him, through him, and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.

Romans 16:27 27 To the only wise God be glory forevermore through Jesus Messiah! Amen

1 Corinthians 1:18-30 18 The word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart. 20 Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? 21 For because, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, it pleased God through the folly of what we preach to save those who believe. 22 For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, 23 but we preach Messiah crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, 24 but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Messiah the power of God and the wisdom of God. 25 For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men. 26 For consider your calling, brothers. Not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth. 27 But God chose what is foolish in the world to shame the wise. God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong. 28 God chose what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are, 29 so that no human being might boast in the presence of God. 30 And because of him you are in Messiah Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness, sanctification, and redemption.

1 Corinthians 2:10-11 10 The Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God. 11 For who knows a person's thoughts except the spirit of that person that is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God.

Ephesians 3:8-10 8 To me [Paul], though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the nations the unsearchable riches of Messiah 9 and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the mystery hidden for ages in God who created all things, 10 so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.

Colossians 2:2-3 2 ... That their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and the knowledge of God's mystery, which is Messiah, 3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

James 1:5 5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.

James 3:17 17 The wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial, and sincere.
