

VERSES ON THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD

Exodus 18:10-11 10 Jethro said, Blessed be Yahweh, who has delivered you [Israel] out of the hand of the Egyptians and out of the hand of Pharaoh and has delivered the people from under the hand of the Egyptians. 11 Now I know that Yahweh is greater than all gods, because in this affair [Egypt] dealt arrogantly with the people.

Deuteronomy 10:14 14 Behold, to Yahweh your God belong heaven and the heaven of heavens, the earth with all that is in it.

Deuteronomy 32:39 39 See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god beside me. I kill, and I make alive. I wound, and I heal. And there is none that can deliver out of my hand.

Joshua 2:11 11 As soon as we [Jericho] heard it, our hearts melted, and there was no spirit left in any man because of you, for Yahweh your God, he is God in the heavens above and on the earth beneath.

1 Samuel 2:6-8 6 Yahweh kills and brings to life. He brings down to Sheol and raises up. 7 Yahweh makes poor and makes rich. He brings low and he exalts. 8 He raises up the poor from the dust. He lifts the needy from the ash heap to make them sit with princes and inherit a seat of honor. For the pillars of the earth are Yahweh's, and on them he has set the world.

1 Chronicles 16:31 31 Let the heavens be glad, let the earth rejoice, and let them say among the nations, Yahweh reigns!

1 Chronicles 29:10-12 10 David blessed Yahweh in the presence of all the assembly. And David said: Blessed are you, Yahweh, the God of Israel our father, forever and ever. 11 Yours, Yahweh, is the greatness, the power, the glory, the victory, and the majesty, for all that is in the heavens and in the earth is yours. Yours is the kingdom, Yahweh, and you are exalted as head above all. 12 Both riches and honor come from you, and you rule over all. In your hand are power and might, and in your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all.

2 Chronicles 10:15 15 The king [Rehoboam] did not listen to the people, for it was a turn of affairs brought about by God that Yahweh might fulfill his word that he spoke by Ahijah the Shilonite to Jeroboam the son of Nebat.

2 Chronicles 11:4 4 Thus says Yahweh, You [Judah and Benjamin] shall not go up or fight against your relatives. Return every man to his home, for this thing is from me. So they listened to the word of Yahweh and returned and did not go against Jeroboam.

Job 12:14-25 14 If [God] tears down, none can rebuild. If he shuts a man in, none can open. 15 If he withholds the waters, they dry up. If he sends them out, they overwhelm the land. 16 With him are strength and sound wisdom. The deceived and the deceiver are his. 17 He leads counselors away stripped, and judges he makes fools. 18 He looses the bonds of kings and binds a waistcloth on their hips. 19 He leads priests away stripped and overthrows the mighty. 20 He deprives of speech those who are trusted and takes away the discernment of the elders.

21 He pours contempt on princes and loosens the belt of the strong. 22 He uncovers the deeps out of darkness and brings deep darkness to light. 23 He makes nations great, and he destroys them. He enlarges nations and leads them away. 24 He takes away understanding from the chiefs of the people of the earth and makes them wander in a trackless waste. 25 They grope in the dark without light, and he makes them stagger like a drunken man.

Psalm 22:27-28 27 All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to Yahweh, and all the families of the nations will worship before you. 28 For the kingdom is Yahweh's, and he rules over the nations.

Psalm 24:1-2 1 The earth is Yahweh's and the fullness thereof, the world and those who dwell therein, 2 for he has founded it upon the seas and established it upon the rivers.¹

Psalm 31:15 15 My times are in your hand. Rescue me from the hand of my enemies and from my persecutors!

Psalm 50:10-12 10 Every beast of the forest is mine, the cattle on a thousand hills. 11 I know all the birds of the hills, and all that moves in the field is mine. 12 If I were hungry, I would not tell you, for the world and its fullness are mine.

Psalm 83:16-18 16 Fill [your enemies'] faces with shame, that they may seek your name, Yahweh. 17 Let them be put to shame and dismayed forever. Let them perish in disgrace, 18 that they may know that you alone, whose name is Yahweh, are the Most High over all the earth.

Psalm 95:3-7 3 Yahweh is a great God, and a great King above all gods. 4 In his hand are the depths of the earth. The heights of the mountains are his also. 5 The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land. 6 Oh come, let us worship and bow down. Let us kneel before Yahweh, our Maker! 7 For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand.

Psalm 97:9 9 You, Yahweh, are Most High over all the earth. You are exalted far above all gods.

Psalm 103:19-22 19 Yahweh has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all. 20 Bless Yahweh, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word! 21 Bless Yahweh, all his hosts, his ministers, who do his will! 22 Bless Yahweh, all his works, in all places of his dominion. Bless Yahweh, O my soul!

Psalm 113:4-8 4 Yahweh is high above all nations, and his glory above the heavens! 5 Who is like Yahweh our God, who is seated on high, 6 who looks far down on the heavens and the earth? 7 He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap, 8 to make them sit with princes, with the princes of his people.

¹ The Creator gets to be the King. Let the Creator be the King.

Psalm 115:3 3 Our God is in the heavens. He does all that he pleases.

Psalm 135:5–6 5 I know that Yahweh is great, and that our Lord is above all gods. 6 Whatever Yahweh pleases, he does, in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all deeps.

Psalm 145:13 13 Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures throughout all generations. The Lord is faithful in all his words and kind in all his works.

Psalm 147:15-18 15 [Yahweh] sends out his command to the earth. His word runs swiftly. ... 18 He sends out his word, and melts [snow, ice, and frost]. He makes his wind blow and the waters flow.

Isaiah 14:24-27 24 Yahweh of armies has sworn: As I have planned, so shall it be, and as I have purposed, so shall it stand, 25 that I will break the Assyrian in my land, and on my mountains trample him underfoot. And his yoke shall depart from them, and his burden from their shoulder. 26 This is the purpose that is purposed concerning the whole earth, and this is the hand that is stretched out over all the nations. 27 For Yahweh of armies has purposed, and who will annul it? His hand is stretched out, and who will turn it back?

Isaiah 37:15-20 15 Hezekiah prayed to Yahweh: 16 Yahweh of armies, God of Israel, enthroned above the cherubim, you are the God, you alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth. 17 Incline your ear, Yahweh, and hear. Open your eyes, Yahweh, and see. And hear all the words of Sennacherib that he has sent to mock the living God. 18 Truly, Yahweh, the kings of Assyria have laid waste all the nations and their lands, 19 and have cast their gods into the fire. For they were no gods, but the work of men's hands, wood and stone. Therefore they were destroyed. 20 So now, Yahweh our God, save us from his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that you alone are Yahweh.

Isaiah 43:10-13 10 You [Israel] are my witnesses, declares Yahweh, and my servant whom I have chosen, that you may know, believe me, and understand that I am he. Before me no god was formed, nor shall there be any after me. 11 I, I am Yahweh, and besides me there is no savior. 12 I declared, saved, and proclaimed when there was no strange god among you. And you are my witnesses, declares Yahweh, and I am God. 13 Also henceforth I am he. There is none who can deliver from my hand. I work, and who can turn it back?

Isaiah 44:24-28 24 I am Yahweh, who made all things, who alone stretched out the heavens, who spread out the earth by myself, 25 who frustrates the signs of liars and makes fools of diviners, who turns wise men back and makes their knowledge foolish, 26 who confirms the word of his servant and fulfills the counsel of his messengers, who says of Jerusalem, She shall be inhabited, and of the cities of Judah, They shall be built, and I will raise up their ruins, 27 who says to the deep, Be dry. I will dry up your rivers, 28 who says of Cyrus, He is my shepherd, and he shall fulfill all my purpose, saying of Jerusalem, She shall be built, and of the temple, Your foundation shall be laid.

Jeremiah 27:5 5 It is I who by my great power and my outstretched arm have made the earth, with the men and animals that are on the earth, and I give it to whomever it seems right to me.

Lamentations 5:19 19 You, Yahweh, reign forever. Your throne endures to all generations.

Daniel 2:44 44 In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that shall never be destroyed, nor shall the kingdom be left to another people. It shall break in pieces all these kingdoms and bring them to an end, but it shall stand forever.

Daniel 4:1-3 1 King Nebuchadnezzar to all peoples, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth. Peace be multiplied to you! 2 It has seemed good to me to show the signs and wonders that the Most High God has done for me. 3 How great are his signs, how mighty his wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and his dominion endures from generation to generation.

Daniel 4:25-26 25 You [Nebuchadnezzar] shall be driven from among men, and your dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field. You shall be made to eat grass like an ox, you shall be wet with the dew of heaven, and seven periods of time shall pass over you, till you know that the Most High rules the kingdom of men and gives it to whom he will. 26 And as it was commanded to leave the stump of the roots of the tree, your kingdom shall be confirmed for you from the time that you know that Heaven rules.

Daniel 4:34-37 34 At the end of the days I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted my eyes to heaven, and my reason returned to me, and I blessed the Most High and praised and honored him who lives forever, for his dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom endures from generation to generation. 35 All the inhabitants of the earth are accounted as nothing, and he does according to his will among the host of heaven and among the inhabitants of the earth. And none can stay his hand or say to him, What have you done? ...37 Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise, extol, and honor the King of heaven, for all his works are right and his ways are just. And those who walk in pride he is able to humble.

Daniel 6:26 26 I [Darius] make a decree, that in all my royal dominion people are to tremble and fear before the God of Daniel, for he is the living God, enduring forever. His kingdom shall never be destroyed, and his dominion shall be to the end.

Ephesians 1:3-12 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Messiah, who has blessed us in Messiah with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, 4 even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love 5 he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Messiah, according to the purpose of his desire, 6 to the praise of his glorious grace with which he has blessed us in the Beloved. 7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our offenses, according to the riches of his grace 8 that he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight 9 making known to us the mystery of his desire, according to his purpose that he set forth in Messiah 10 as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth. 11 In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been

predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his desire, 12 so that we who were the first to hope in Messiah might be to the praise of his glory.

2 Peter 3:9 9 The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing (βούλωμαι, pres.) that any should perish, but that all should move (χωρέω, aor.) into repentance (εἰς μετάνοιαν).

Jude 25 25 To the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Messiah our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority before all time, now, and forever. Amen.
