

VERSES ON THE TRUTH OF GOD

Numbers 23:19 19 God is not man, that he should lie, or a son of man, that he should change his mind. Has he said, and will he not do it? Or has he spoken, and will he not fulfill it?

2 Samuel 7:27-29 27 You, Yahweh of armies, the God of Israel, have made this revelation to your servant [David] saying, I will build you a house. Therefore your servant has found courage to pray this prayer to you. 28 And now, my Lord Yahweh, you are God, and your words are true, and you have promised this good thing to your servant. 29 Now therefore may it please you to bless the house of your servant so that it may continue forever before you. For you, my Lord Yahweh, have spoken, and with your blessing shall the house of your servant be blessed forever.

Psalms 12:6 6 The words of Yahweh are pure words, like silver refined in a furnace on the ground, purified seven times.

Psalms 89:14 14 Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne. Loyal love and truth (אֱמֻנָה) go before you.

Psalms 111:7-8 7 The works of [Yahweh's] hands are truth (אֱמֻנָה) and justice. All his precepts are trustworthy (אֱמֻנָה). 8 They are established forever and ever, to be performed with truth (אֱמֻנָה) and uprightness.

Psalms 117:2 2 [Yahweh's] loyal love is great toward us, and the truth of Yahweh is everlasting.

Psalms 119:142 142 Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and your law is truth.

Psalms 119:151 151 You are near, Yahweh, and all your commandments are truth.

Psalms 119:160 160 The sum of your word is truth, and every one of your righteous ordinances is everlasting.

Proverbs 12:22 22 Lying lips are an abomination to Yahweh, but those who deal faithfully are his delight.

Proverbs 30:5-6 5 Every word of God is tested. He is a shield to those who take refuge in him. 6 Do not add to his words or he will reprove you, and you will be proved a liar.

Isaiah 45:19 19 I did not speak in secret, in a land of darkness. I did not say to the seed of Jacob, Seek me in vain. I, Yahweh, speak the truth. I declare what is right.

Zechariah 8:17 17 Let none of you devise evil in your heart against another, and do not love perjury. For all these are what I hate, declares Yahweh.

John 3:33 33 He who has received [Jesus'] testimony has set his seal to this, that God is true.

John 7:18 18 The one who speaks on his own authority seeks his own glory, but the one [Jesus] who seeks the glory of [God] who sent him is true, and in him there is no falsehood.

John 14:6 6 Jesus said to [Thomas], I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father but through me.

John 17:3 3 This is eternal life, that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Messiah whom you have sent.

John 18:37-38 37 Pilate said to [Jesus], So you are a king? Jesus answered, You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world—to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice. 38 Pilate said to him, What is truth? After he had said this, he went back outside to the Jews and told them, I find no guilt in him.

Romans 3:3-4 3 If some did not believe, their unbelief will not nullify the faithfulness of God, will it? 4 Let God be true though every one were a liar, as it is written, That you may be justified in your words and prevail when you are judged.

Hebrews 6:17-19 17 God, desiring even more to show to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of his purpose, interposed with an oath, 18 so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us. 19 This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast and one that enters within the veil.

1 John 5:6 6 It is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth.

1 John 5:20 20 We know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding so that we may know him who is the true one. And we are in the true one, in his Son Jesus Messiah. This is the true God and eternal life.

Revelation 3:7 7 To the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: The words of the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David.

Revelation 21:5 5 [God] who sits on the throne said, Behold, I am making all things new. And He said, Write, for these words are faithful and true.
